


Haddo House - **Undercover**



Temair Express - Silver Box

- Follow the shields to the Main Entrance.
- In Main Entrance, find letter from Johnny and Wedding Invite.
- Johnny's letter says "start at the top".
- If the group is slow on the uptake, you say you wondered why you were given the keys to the Attic this morning!
- Prepare the group for quite a few stairs. And a reminder that we're going to the unseen parts of the house, so it's really important to watch your step and not to touch things. There is a broken floorboard at the entrance of the attic which we must not step in.
- Go to Attic.
- Find the small picture on the easel.
- On the back is a pocket watch, stopped at 7:30. Refer to map - time code. 7:30 = The Square.
- Head down to the Square.
- The riddle in the map will lead them to the candles. Put on the gloves and lift the candle snuffers one by one until you find the tiny timetable. ****possibly have magnifying glass to hand****
- Team connect 7:30am post box to the post train on the timetable. Head down the main stair to the post box and find the postcard.
- The clue about morning light should send them to the morning room (marked on map).
- Find train ticket and solve the anagram. (Scots Mile is on the map)
- Head to Drawing room, find family tree clue as book mark in "More Cracks" book by the window.
- Refer to map to solve. Leads us to Archie's Corner.
- Find the double - there's a double book which has a map in it.
- Solve the clue to go to the old fire extinguisher in the corridor near the chapel.
- Find the fridge magnet, which then leads us to Giles.
- Find Fyvie and get the diary entry. She mentions needing to go to Gordon first via the LNER.
- In Gordon room, spot clue next to the LNER train. Then (or before) find the locket on the model.
- Solve the clue (it spells out Here Comes The Bride!)
- Head to the chapel. Find the box under the bride's seat. The combination is the clue from Gordon by the train.
- The Temair Express has been found!
- Enjoy the treats and wish everyone well... asking them to act "normal" and not tell anyone about what they've been up to.
