**Category:** Red Wine;

**Alcohol:** 14%

**Bottle Size:** 0.75 L

**Vineyard:** Granite sand hill

**Variable:** Native red grape

**Altitude:** 520 m above sea level

**Harvest:** Late "OVER-RIPE GRAPES»

**Vinification:** Obtained through whole-bunch fermentation in stainless steel vats, layering part of the destemmed and crushed must and part of the whole bunch.

**Aging:** Aged in stainless steel vats for 8 months and then in bottle for at least 3 months.

## SENSORY NOTES OF THE PRODUCT

**Nose:** Seductive with a persistent aroma, accompanied by delicate notes of violet that blend with hints of jammy red berries and subtle sweet spices from overripe grapes.

**Taste:** Elegant, structured, and fresh on the palate, characterized by persistent, elegant tannins and a light minerality.
