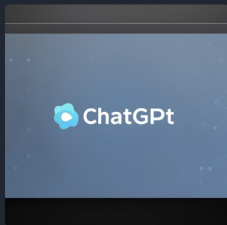
✗ Lie #4: "You Need a Huge Following to Earn"

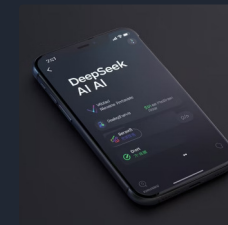
Google Gemini

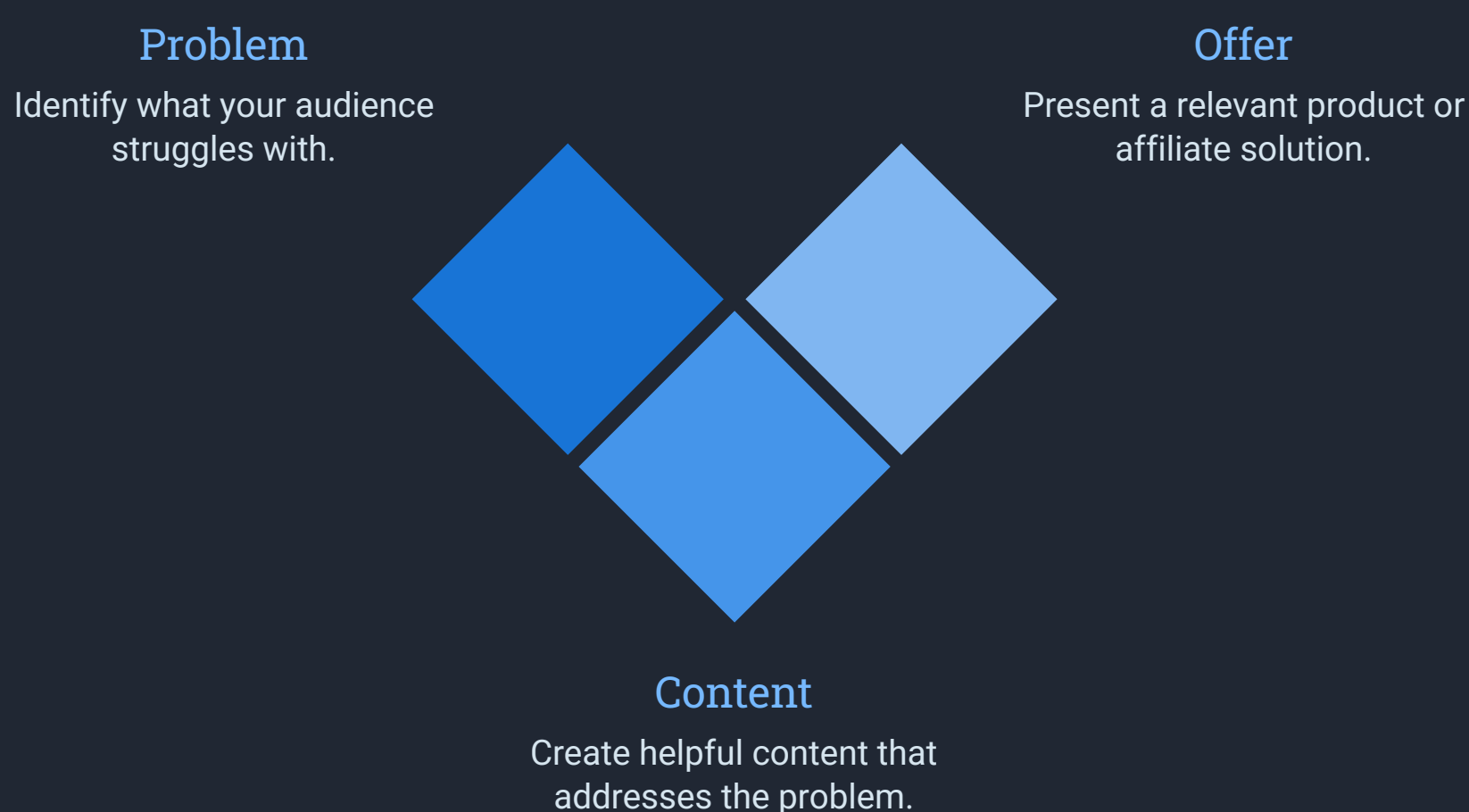

Anyone promising otherwise is selling you a dream — while taking your money.
