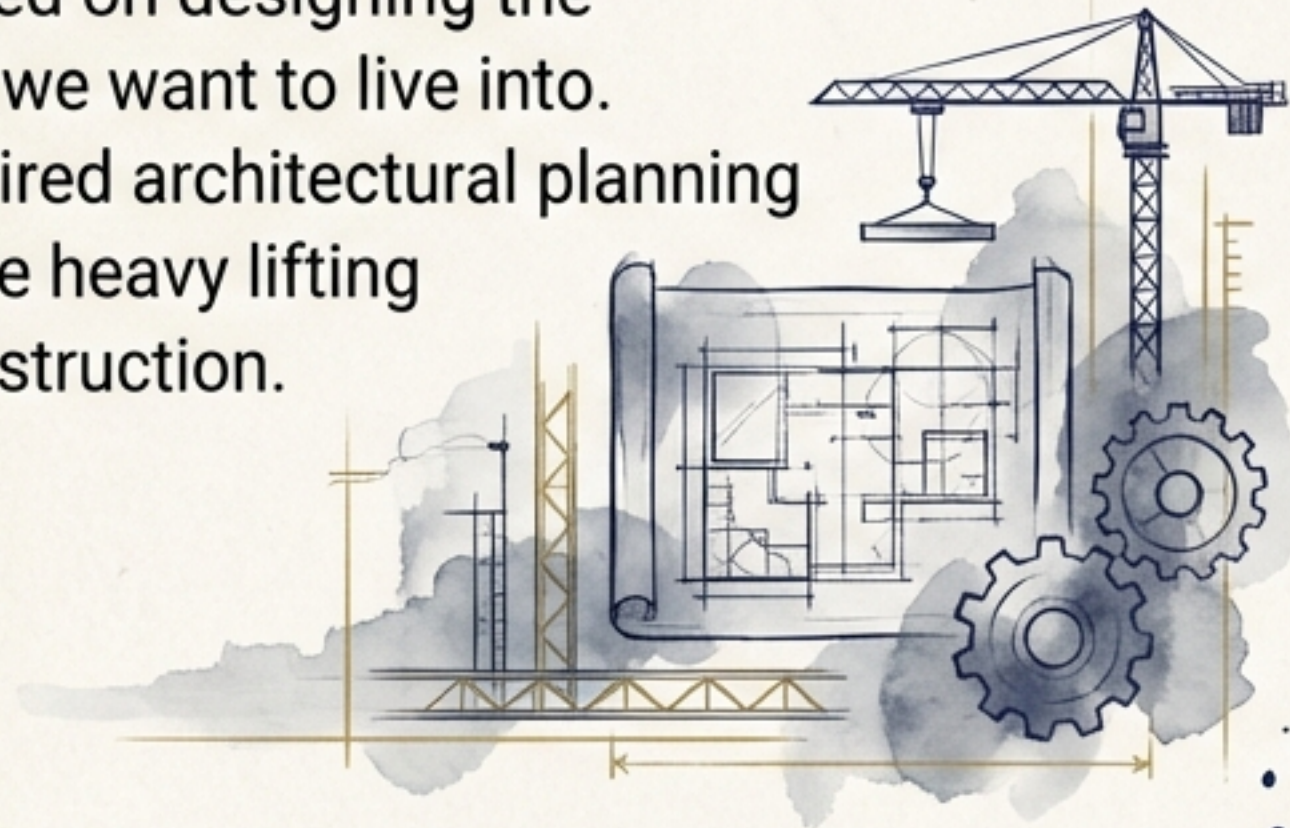

The Shift from Hard-Nosed Force to Fluid Capacity

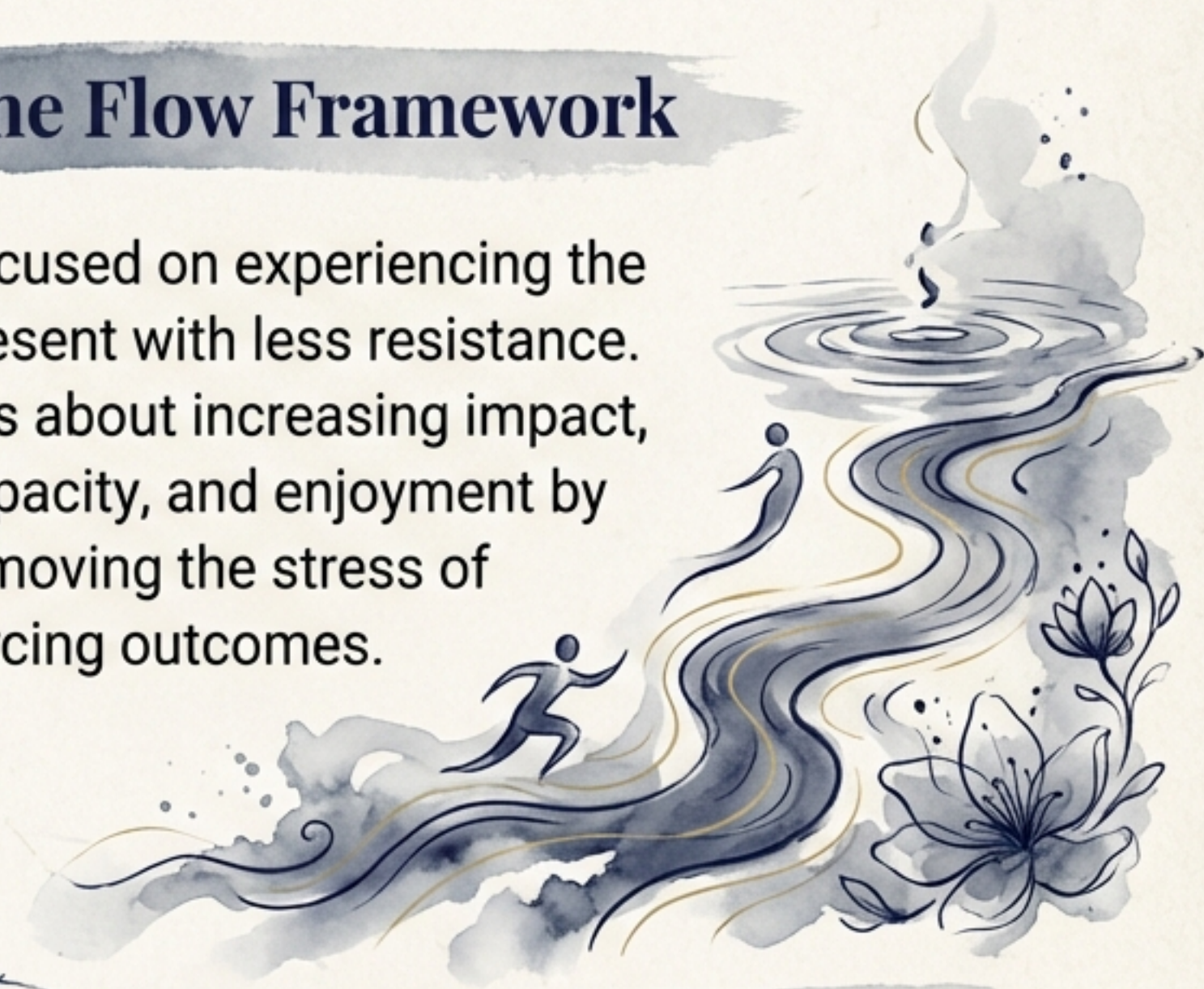
The Create Framework

Focused on designing the future we want to live into. It required architectural planning and the heavy lifting of construction.



The Flow Framework

Focused on experiencing the present with less resistance. It is about increasing impact, capacity, and enjoyment by removing the stress of forcing outcomes.



Key Insight: Trying to 'hard-nose' everything creates unnecessary stress. Flow is about how we relate to the opportunities we have right now.

We Are Co-Conspirators in Our Own Limitations

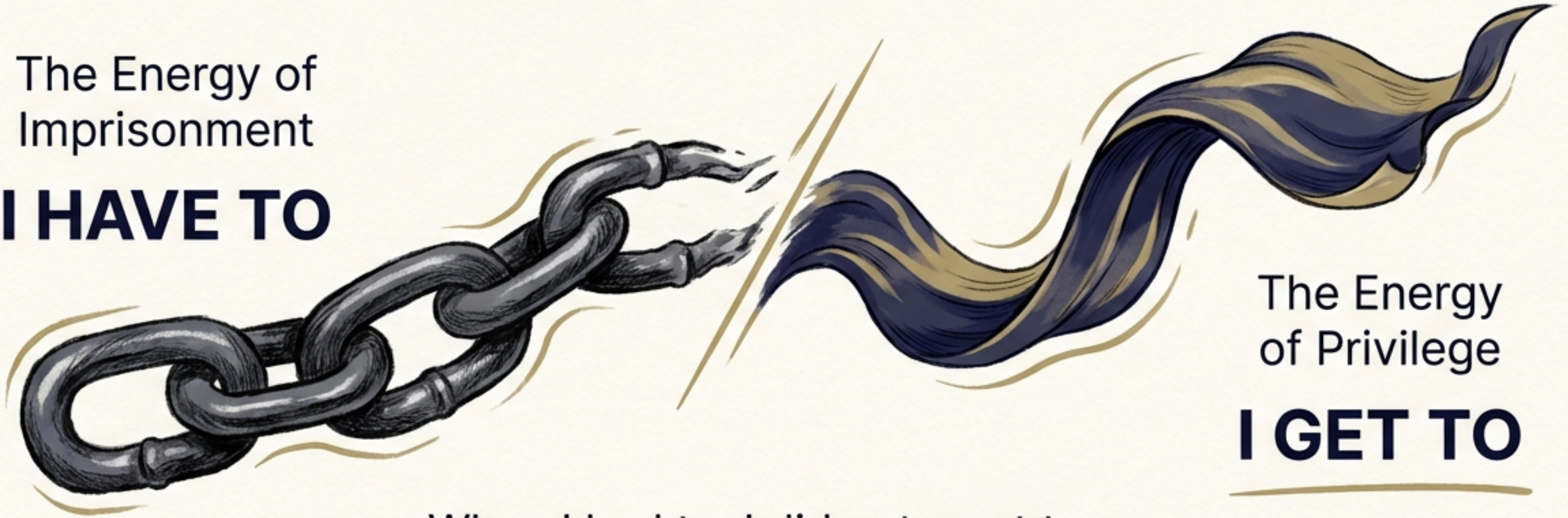

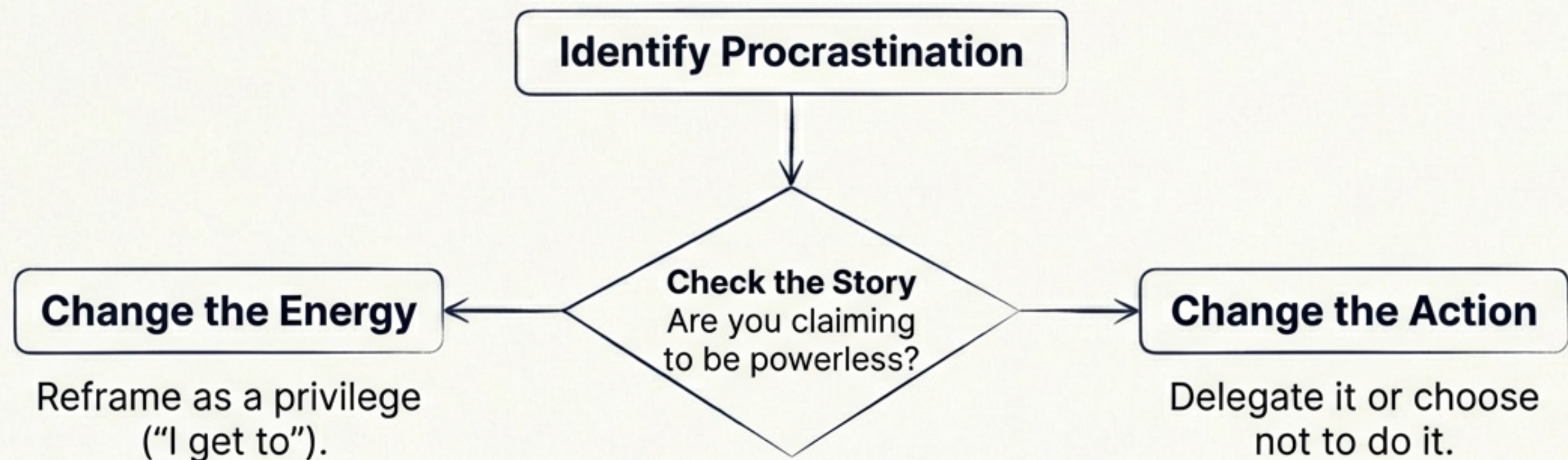

Audit Your Energy to Dissolve Resistance

The Hoarding Metaphor

Physical and emotional clutter blocks flow. We hold on due to attachment to memories ("treasure"), but it consumes space.



The Bankruptcy Lesson

Facing the 'monster' often reveals the fear of judgment was a lie.

Reality brings relief and support rather than the predicted doom.

The Universal Law: If a problem is a catalyst for your growth, the Universe will not give you a pass. You cannot hide; you must eat the problem piece by piece.

To be or not to be.

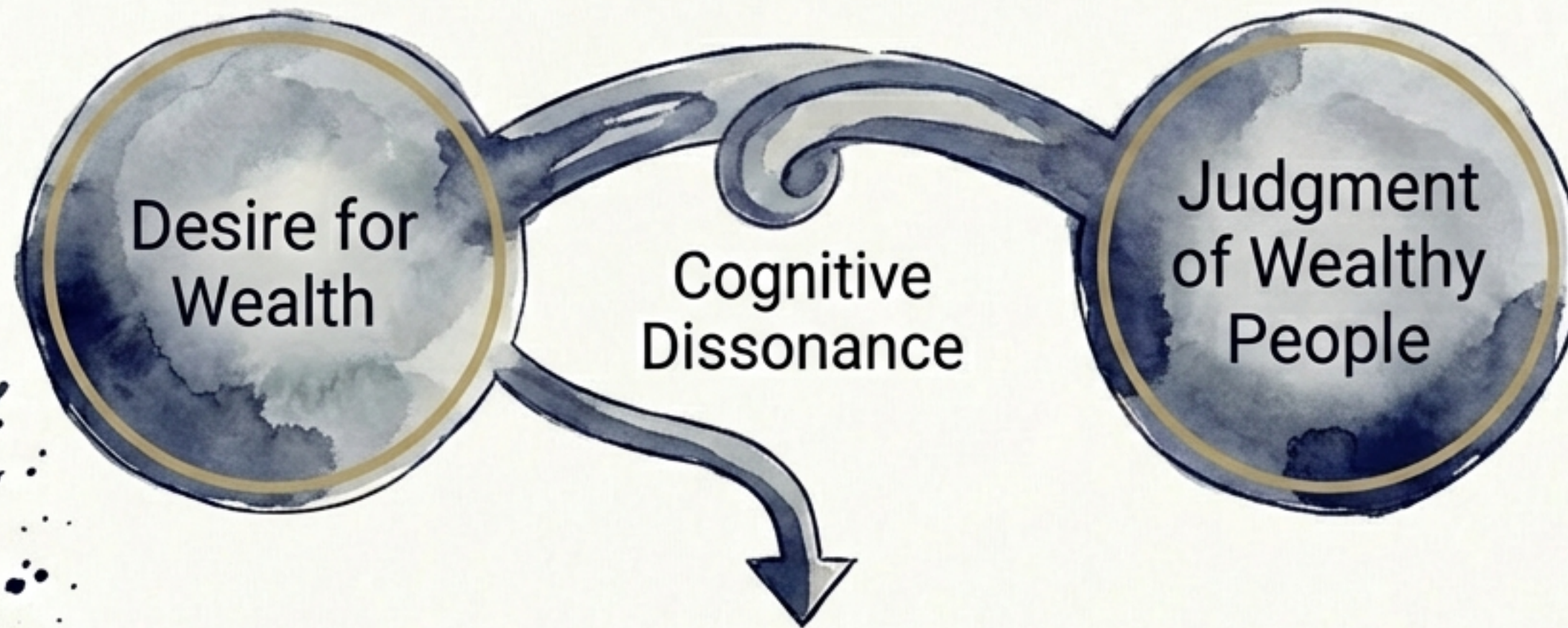
Self-sabotage
