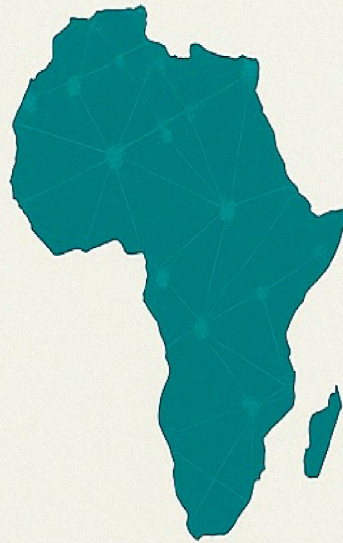

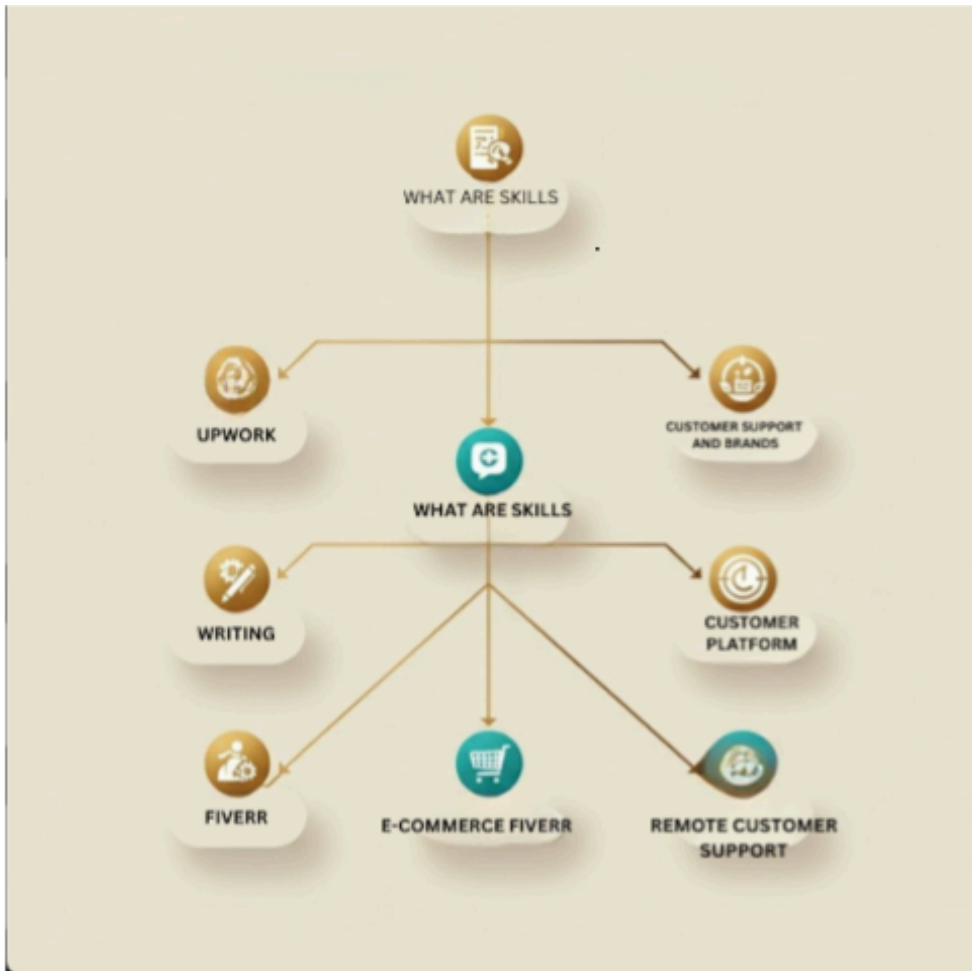


Figure 1: This diagram illustrates the different pathways to earning online by leveraging various skills and platforms. At the core of online work are skills, which can be applied across multiple digital platforms.

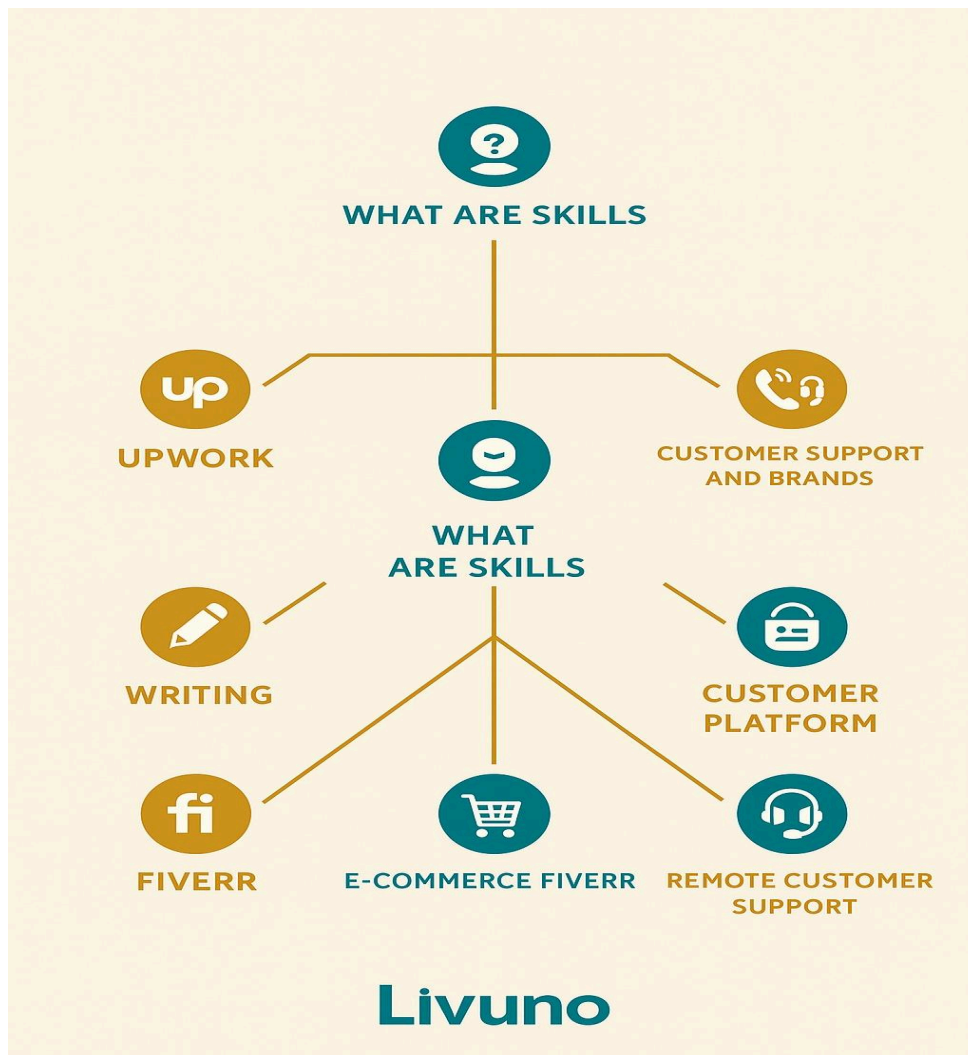


Figure 4: showing different kinds of skills that are necessary for a successful online digital pathway.

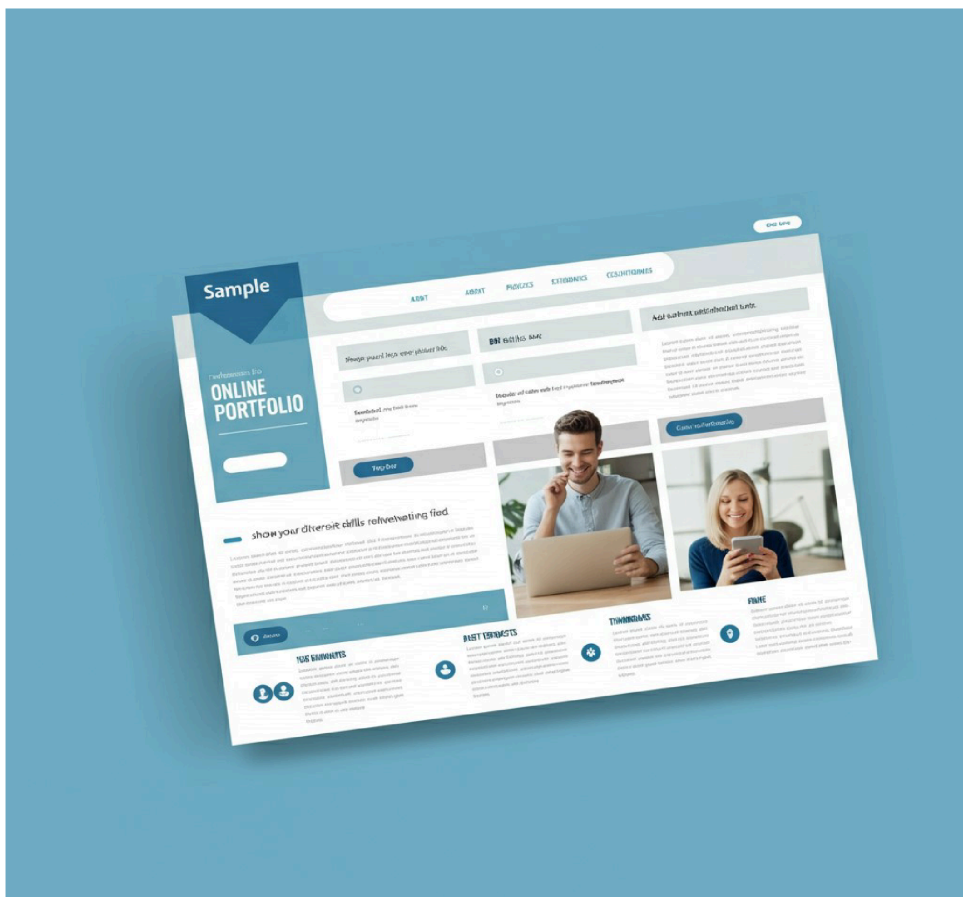

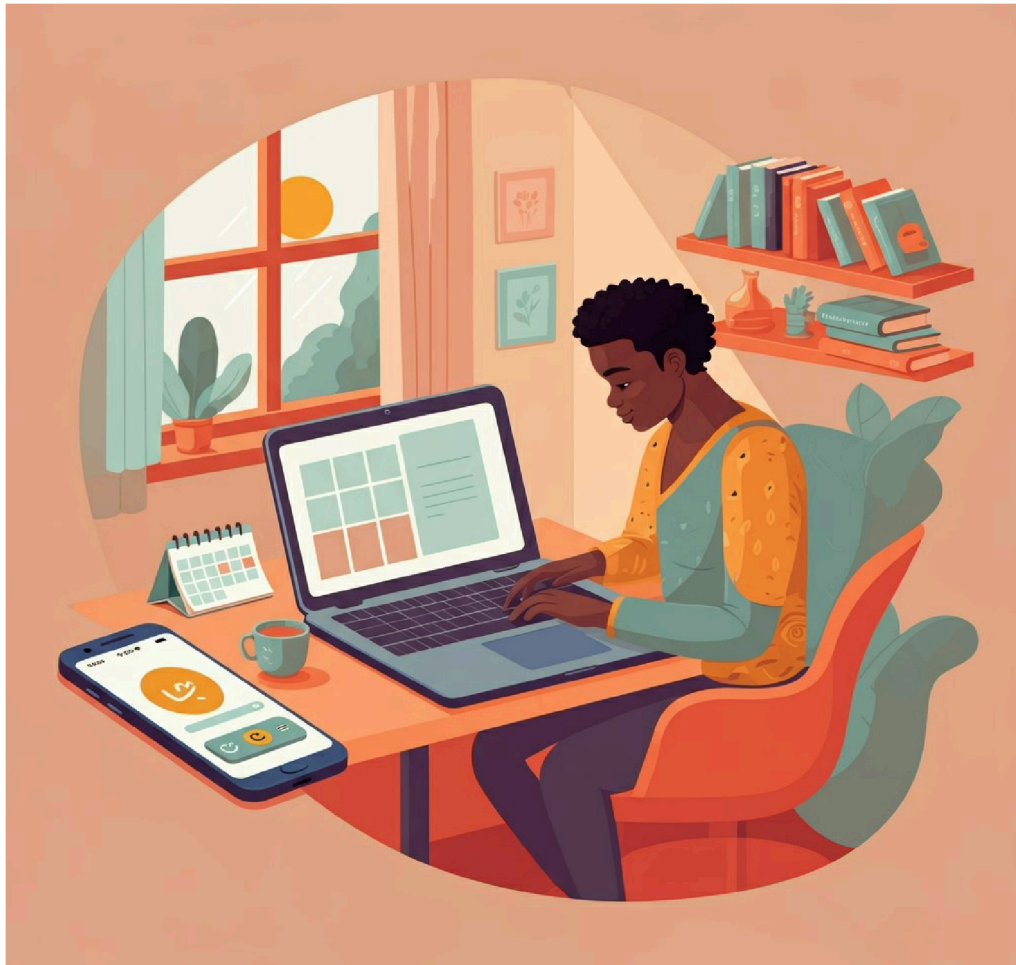

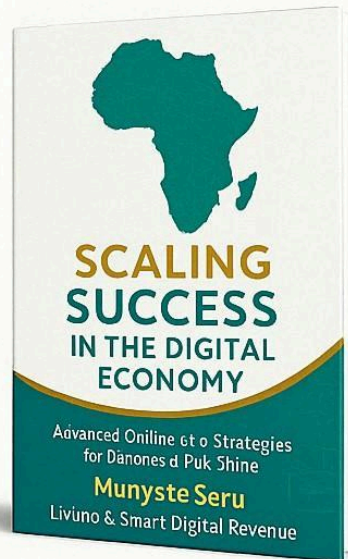
