- **Fill Gaps:** Look for any empty spaces and add delicate sprigs of greenery or tiny blooms to achieve a polished appearance.
- Adjust Symmetry: Step back and examine your arrangement from all angles. Make minor adjustments to ensure balance and flow.

6 Secure the Arrangement

- **Reinforce Stems:** If necessary, use floral tape or twine to bundle stems together before placing them in the vase.
- **Trim Excess Stems:** Ensure that all stems fit comfortably within the vase and are not too long or bulky.

7 Final Touches

- **Mist the Flowers:** Lightly spray the arrangement with water to keep the blooms hydrated and fresh.
- Choose a Spot: Display your posy in a cool location, away from direct sunlight, heat sources, or drafts. Replace the water every two days and re-trim stems as needed.
