

TWO TONE BABY SHOES



SKILL LEVEL - BEGINNER TO INTERMEDIATE

Pattern is available for sizes:

0-3 months (9 cm/3.5 inches)

3-6 months (10 cm/4 inches)

6-9 months (11cm/4.33 inches)

Gauge: :

12 sc x 12 rows = 5 x 5 cm (2 x 2 inches)

Materials

Crochet 2.5 mm hook (for size 0-3, 3-6 months)

Crochet 3 mm hook (for size 6-9 months)

You could let the sole length guide you. Use bigger or smaller hooks if the instructions don't match the sizes.

Yarn - any sportweight yarn. My favourite yarns are:

DMC Natura Yarn, 100% Cotton,

Yarn art Jeans 55% Cotton - 45% Acrylic

Alize Cotton Gold Yarn - 55% Cotton 45% Acrylic

Scissors, Yarn needle, Eva foam or rubber material (optional)

Elastic band 5mm - 30 cm

Stickpins - markers - you can use a small amount of yarn to mark your stitches where necessary.

Stitch guide:

lp/lps – loop/loops

yo – yarn over

st/sts – stitch/ stitches

ch - chain

slst – slip stitch

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

sc2tog -single crochet two together

dc2tog - double crochet two together

BLO - back loop - work only over the back part of the stitch

rep - repeat

R 1- round 1 or row 1

Inv join or False Stitch = Invisible join

*You can find detailed pictures of some stitches throughout the pattern.

Stitches

both loops on a stitch



front loops on a stitch



back loops on a stitch



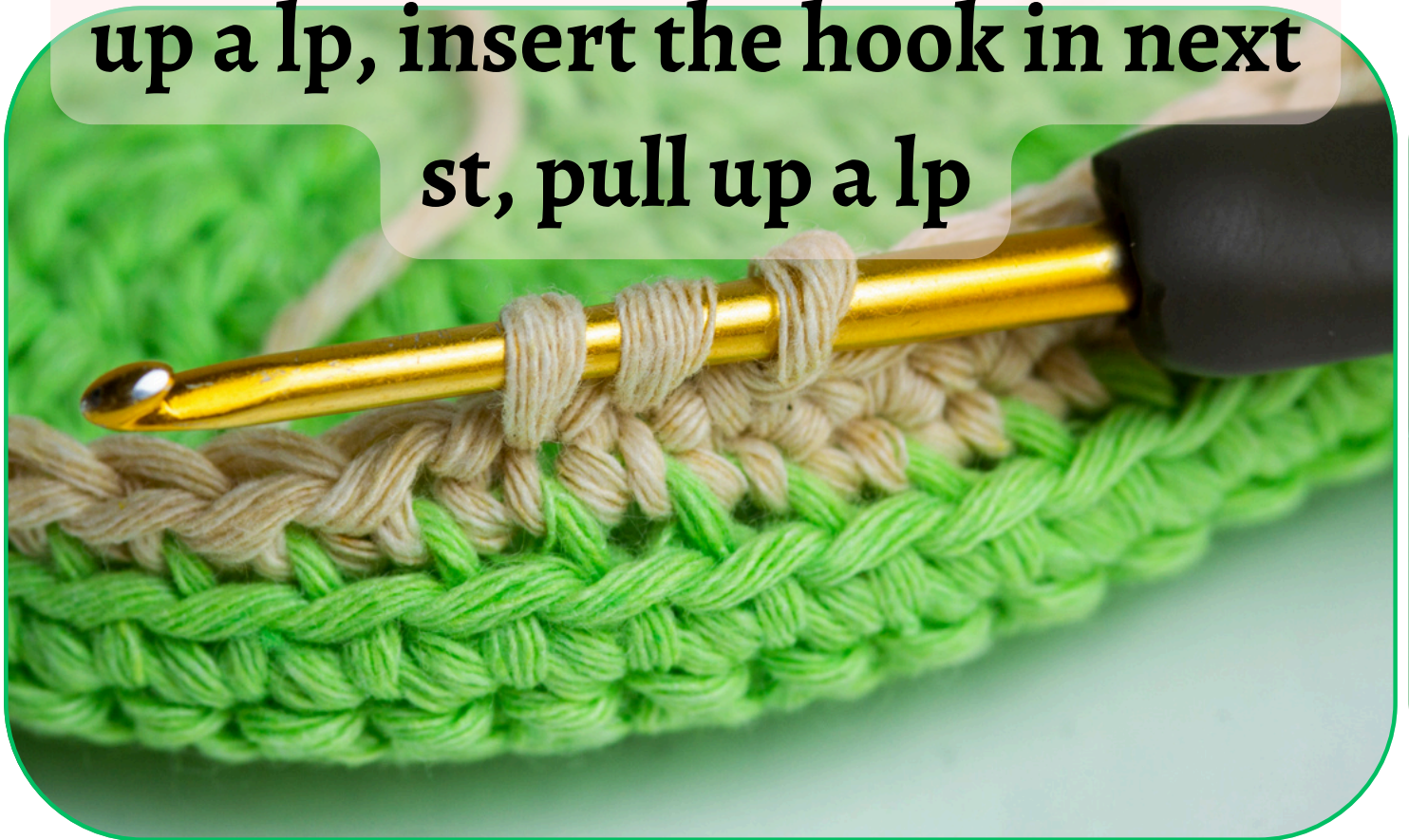
1st st after ch



2nd st after ch

Sc2tog

Insert the hook in next st, pull up a lp, insert the hook in next st, pull up a lp



Once you have 3 loops on hook, yo and pull through all 3 loops on hook



Dc2tog

Yo, insert the hook in next st, pull up a loop, yo, pull up a loop through 1st two loops on hook, yo, insert the hook in next st, yo, pull up a loop, yo pull up a loop through 1st two lps on hook, yo, pull through all 3 loops on hook.



NOTES - HOW TO READ THE INSTRUCTIONS:

- The numbers with slashes (e.g., 54/60/62) in different colors represent the number of stitches for different sizes. Each color corresponds to a specific size, with the color indicating which size it refers to. For example:
 - **0-3 months** / **3-6 months** / **6-9 months**. If the sizes are not indicated in different colors, the pattern applies the same way for all sizes.
- After completing each row, double-check the stitch count to avoid any mistakes. The number in brackets at the end of each row indicates the total stitch count after joining.
- For every row that begins with a chain followed by a single crochet (sc) or double crochet (dc), the first stitch is always made in the **same stitch** as the chain unless stated otherwise. The chain does **not** count as a stitch.
- If the sc or dc is placed into the next stitch after the chain, the instructions will explicitly say, "Skip the first stitch." In this case, the stitch count at the end of the row will be written as (ch + ...number of stitches).
- When you finish a row and turn your work, if the pattern does not instruct you to make a chain, the last stitch before turning becomes the first stitch after turning. If the pattern says "skip the first stitch," skip the turning stitch and begin working into the next one.
- After finishing the row, the slst does **not** count as a stitch.
- If you finish the row with a false stitch, the false stitch **does** count as a stitch.
- All rows should be joined with a slip stitch (slst) to the first stitch of the row, NOT to the chain (whether the first stitch is in the chain or the stitch after the chain). As shown in the pictures, use a stitch marker to mark the first stitch. This is very important to avoid mistakes. You will find reminders of this throughout the pattern.
- When you see a number followed by a stitch, work the stitch over the number of stitches. For example,
 - "5 dc" means that you have to make 1 dc into each of the next 5 sts.
- When the pattern says "**6 dc in a stitch**," make all 6 double crochets in that one stitch. If it says "**2 dc in each of the next 2 stitches**," make 2 dc in the first stitch and 2 dc in the second stitch.
- All pictures in the pattern are based on the 0–3 months size.

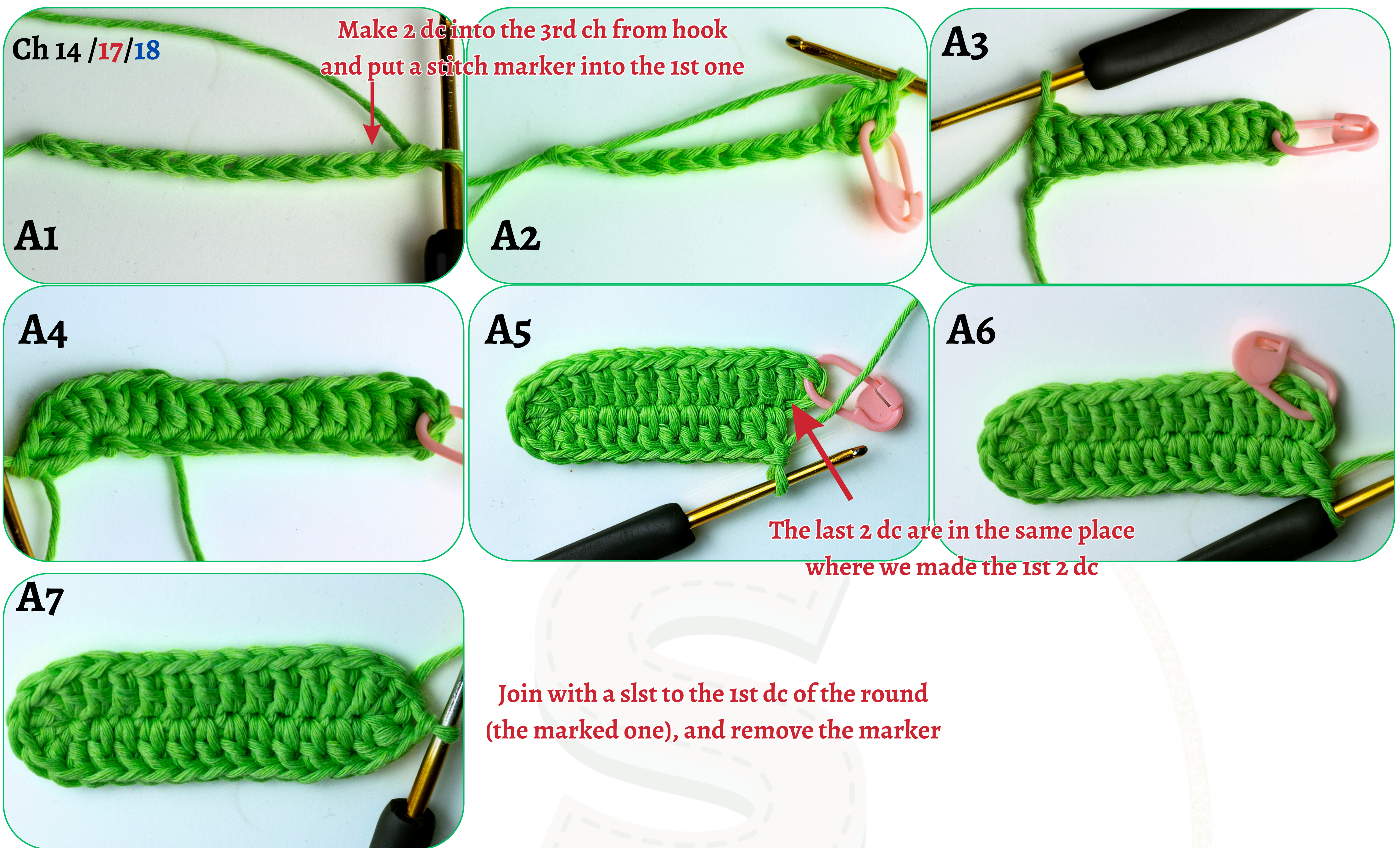
INSTRUCTIONS

Shoe sole:

Chain 14/17/18 (pic A1)

R 1 (Pics A2 - A7)

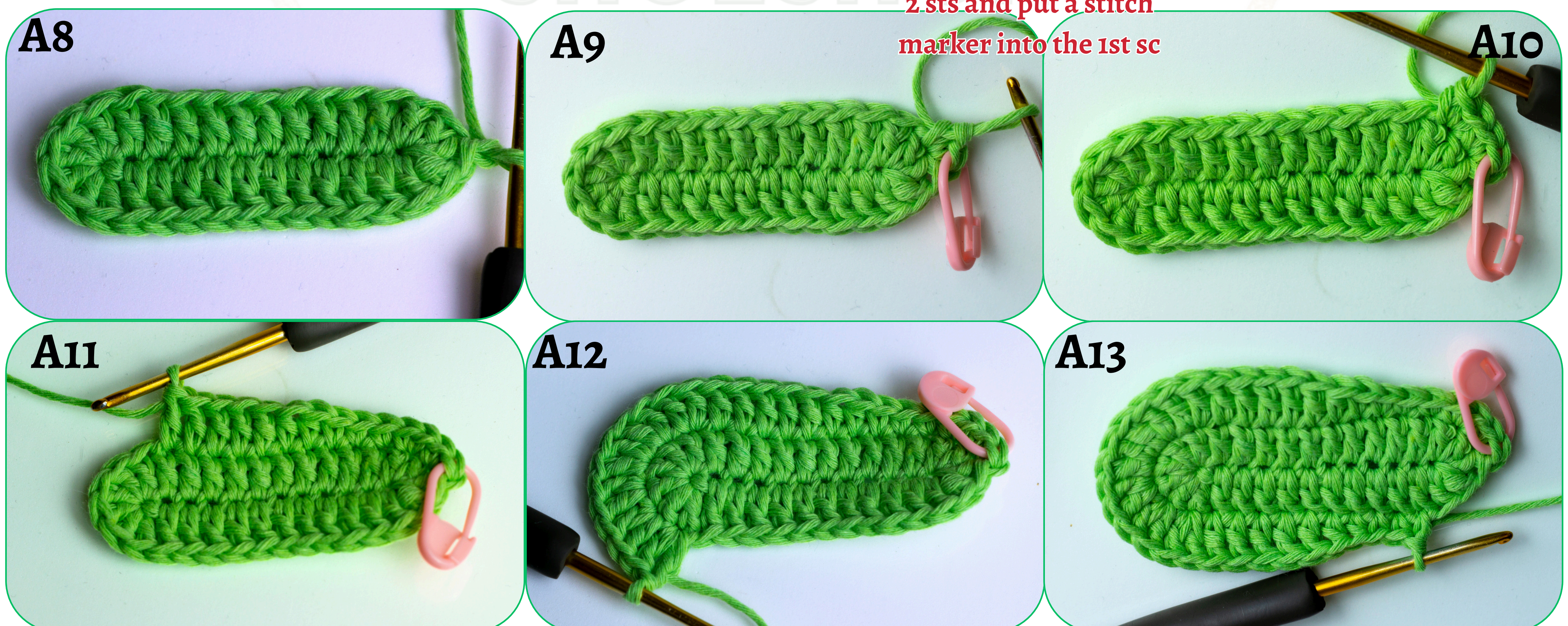
2 dc in 3rd ch from hook, 10/13/14 dc, 6 dc in the last ch, continue working along the other side of the foundation chain, 10/13/14 dc, 2 dc in last ch, slst. (All 30/36/38 sts)

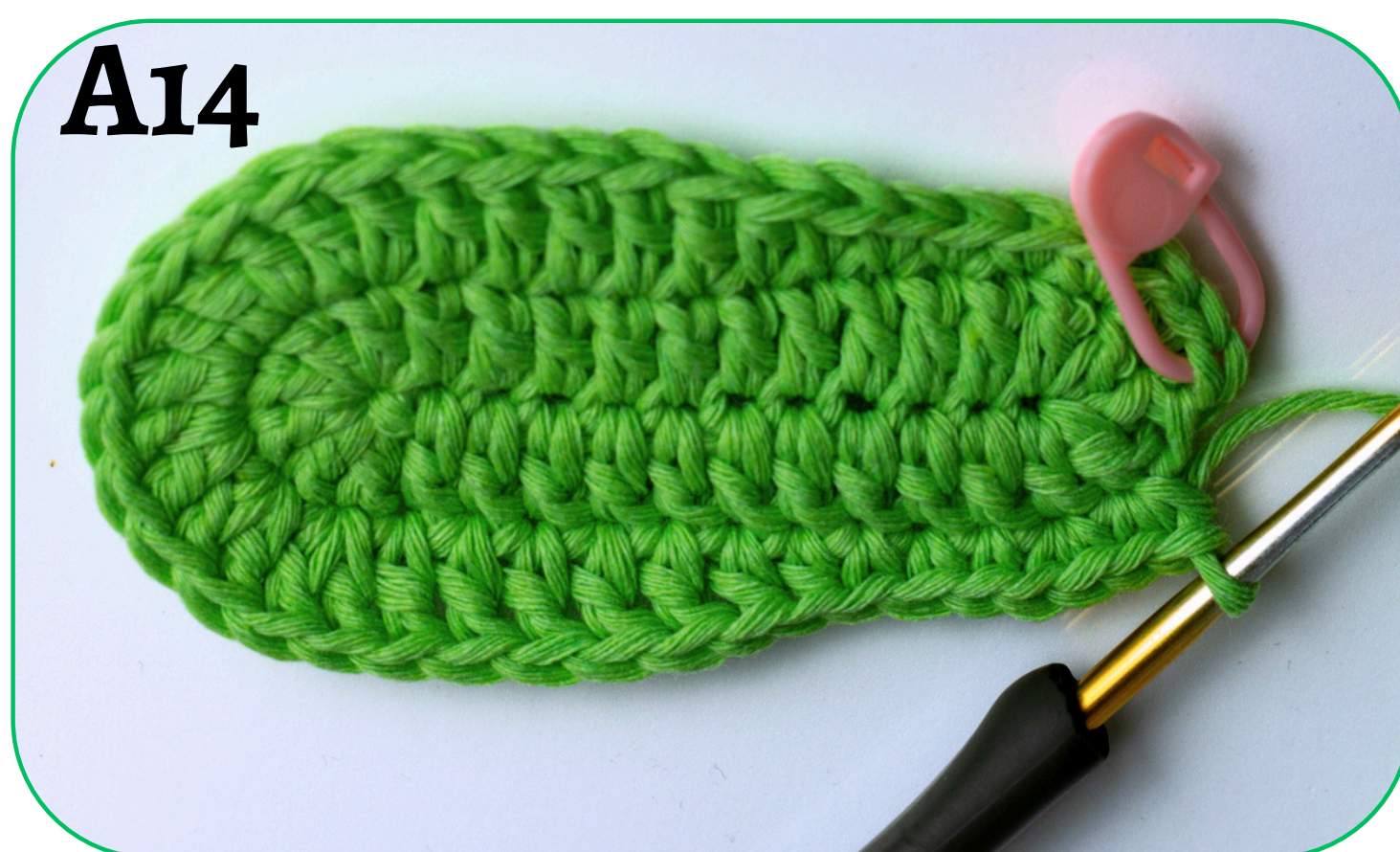


R 2 (Pics A8 - A15)

Ch 1, 2 sc into each of first 2 sts, 3/5/5 sc, 2 hdc, 5/6/7 dc, 2 dc in each of next 6 sts, 5/6/7 dc, 2 hdc, 3/5/5 sc, 2 sc into each of last 2 sts, slst. (All 40/46/48 sts)

Make 2 sc into each of first 2 sts and put a stitch marker into the 1st sc





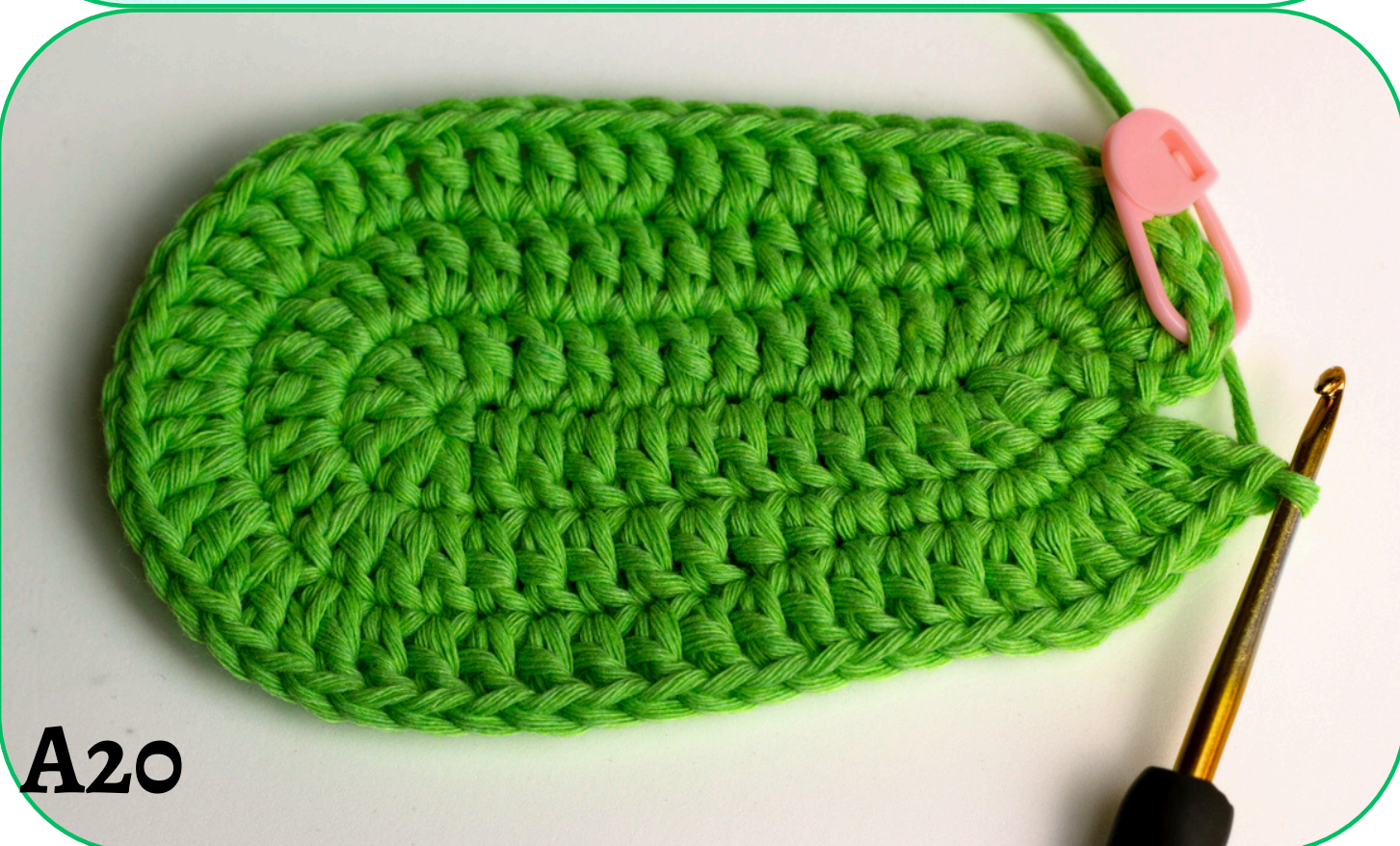
Join with a slst to the 1st sc of the round (the marked one), and remove the marker

R 3 (Pics A16 - A21)

Ch 2, 2 dc into each of the **first 3 sts**, 13/16/17 dc, 2 dc in each of the **next 8 sts**, 13/16/17 dc, 2 dc into each of **last 3 stst**, do not finish with a slst, leave the round open. (All 54/60/62 sts)

Leave about 1.5 meters of yarn, cut it, and pull the yarn tail through. Do not fasten off. Make 2 soles like this — these will be the inner soles.

Make 2 dc into each of first 3 sts and put a stitch marker into the 1st dc



Now make another 2 soles, but do not stop at R 3:

Finish Round 3 with a slst, place a stitch marker into the slst (pic A22), and continue to R4.

R 4 (Pics A22 - A26)

Turn the sole to work on the wrong side. (From the wrong side, the slst from the previous round counts as your first stitch.)

Ch 2, skip the 1st st, 11/13/14 dc, 2 hdc, 28/30/30 sc, 2 hdc, 11/13/14 dc, slst (All 54/60/62 sts)

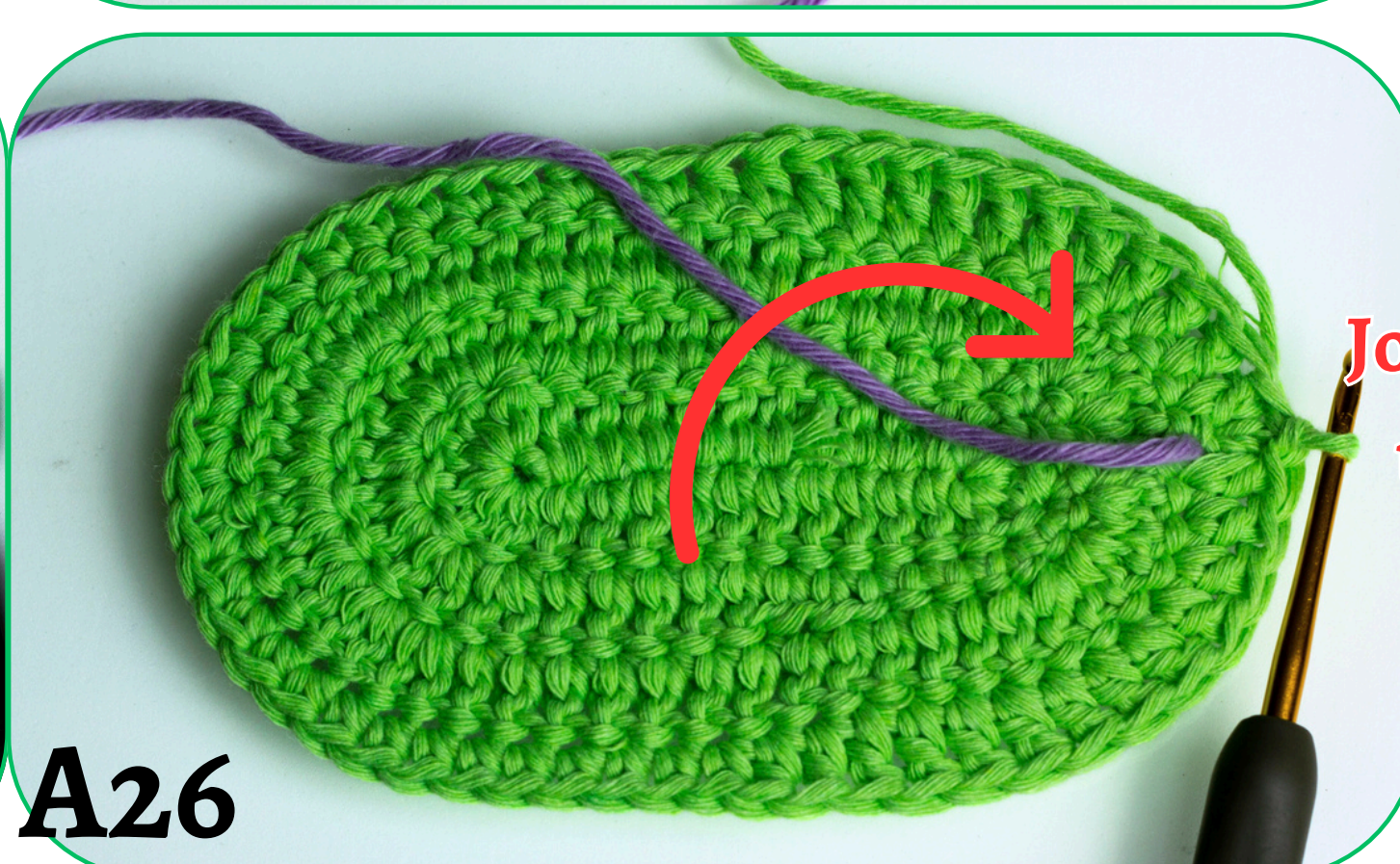
After you make a slst to finish R 3, remove the marker and place a piece of yarn into the slst.



Make ch2, on 1st DC put a st marker.



Turn the sole to work on the wrong side



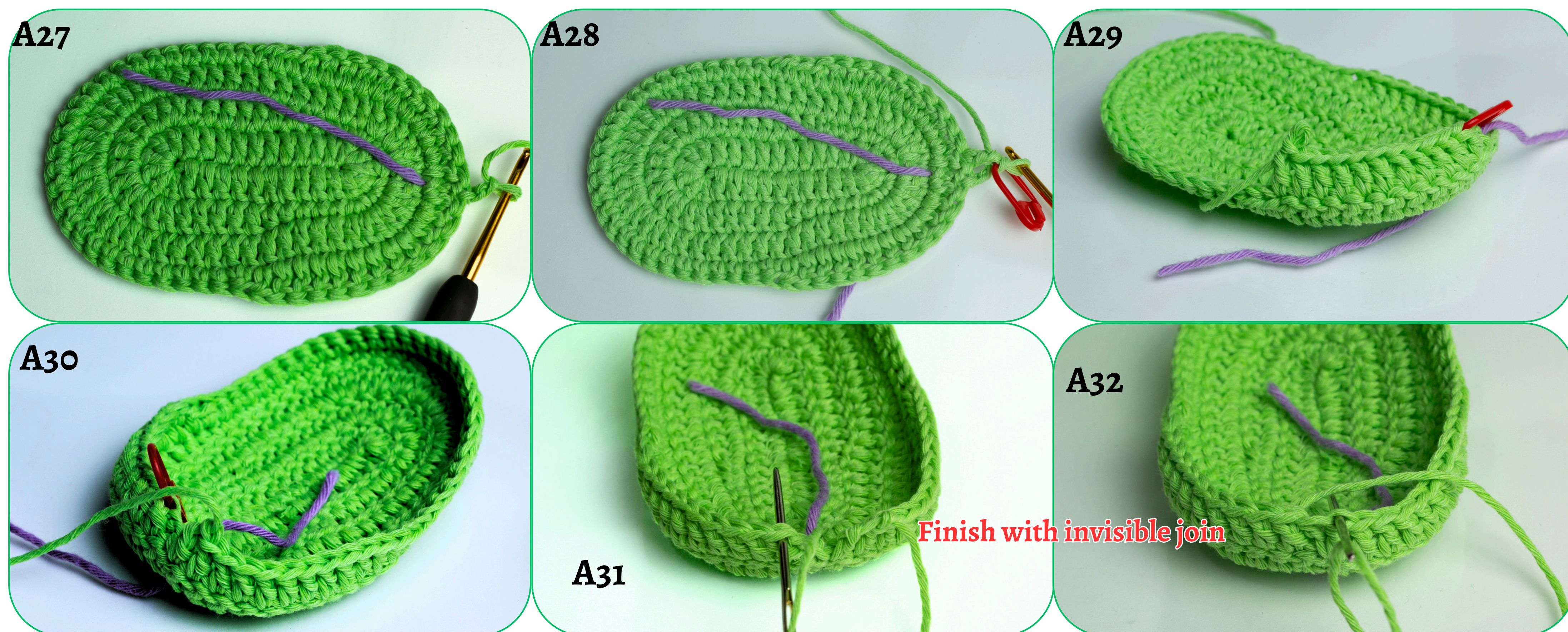
Join with a slst and turn the sole to work over the right side

The last DC is in the 1st st from the right side or the same as ch2

R 5 (Pics A27 - A32)

Turn the sole to work on the right side. (From the right side, the slst from the previous round counts as your first stitch.)

Ch 2, skip the 1st st, 11/13/14 dc, 2 hdc, 28/30/30 sc, 2 hdc, 11/13/14 dc, inv join. (All 55/61/63 sts)



Mark the invisible join—this will be your starting point for the upper part of the shoe.

How to make invisible join:

- Thread the yarn tail onto a needle.
- Insert the needle under both loops of the first stitch of the round and gently pull the yarn through—do not pull too tightly.
- Next, insert the needle down through the center of the last stitch you made and pull it to the back.
- Adjust the yarn to form a stitch that blends in and looks like the others—it should sit neatly on top.
- Fasten off by weaving in the ends securely on the wrong side, unless otherwise instructed.



Connecting the Soles:

(pics B1 - B9)

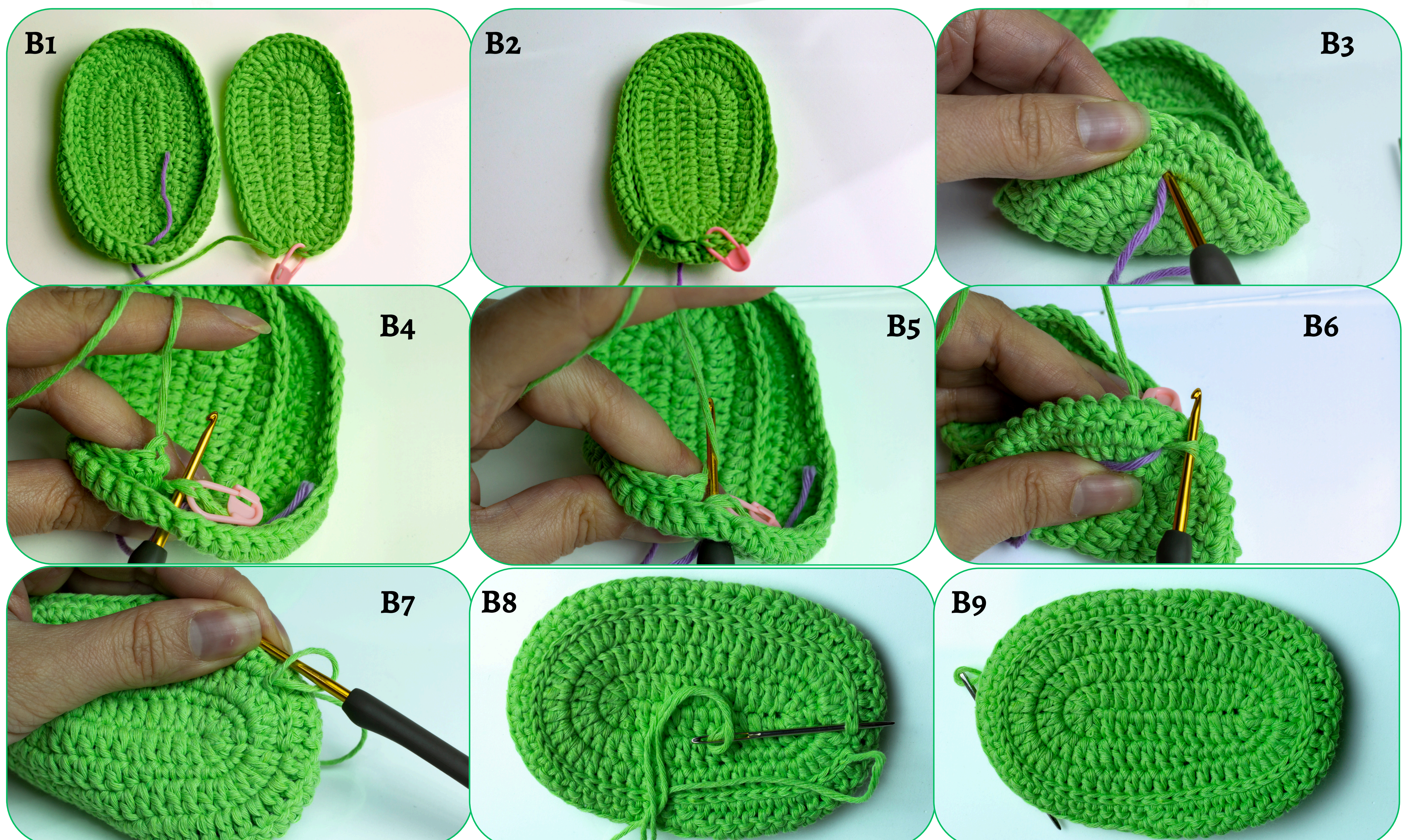
- Take one sole with the yarn tail and one with the two additional rounds (see Pic B2).
- Place the smaller sole inside the larger one, with the wrong sides facing each other.
- Insert your hook into the marked space of the larger sole (Pic B3), and then into the marked stitch of the smaller sole (Pic B4).
- Pull up a loop using the yarn tail from the inner sole (see Pics B5, B6).
- Begin working slip stitches (sl sts) through the corresponding stitches of both soles all the way around.
- Continue making slip stitches to securely close the soles.
- When you reach the last stitch, finish with an invisible join for a seamless finish, or simply join with a slst.
- Fasten off and weave in the ends securely.

Optional Sole Assembly:

Feel free to skip these steps if you'd prefer only to make the outer sole and continue with the upper part.

If you choose the double sole option, you can keep just the double sole or add EVA foam between the two soles for extra cushioning.

To do this, cut two insoles from the Eva foam in the shape of the sole and place one between the two parts while joining the parts before closing them.



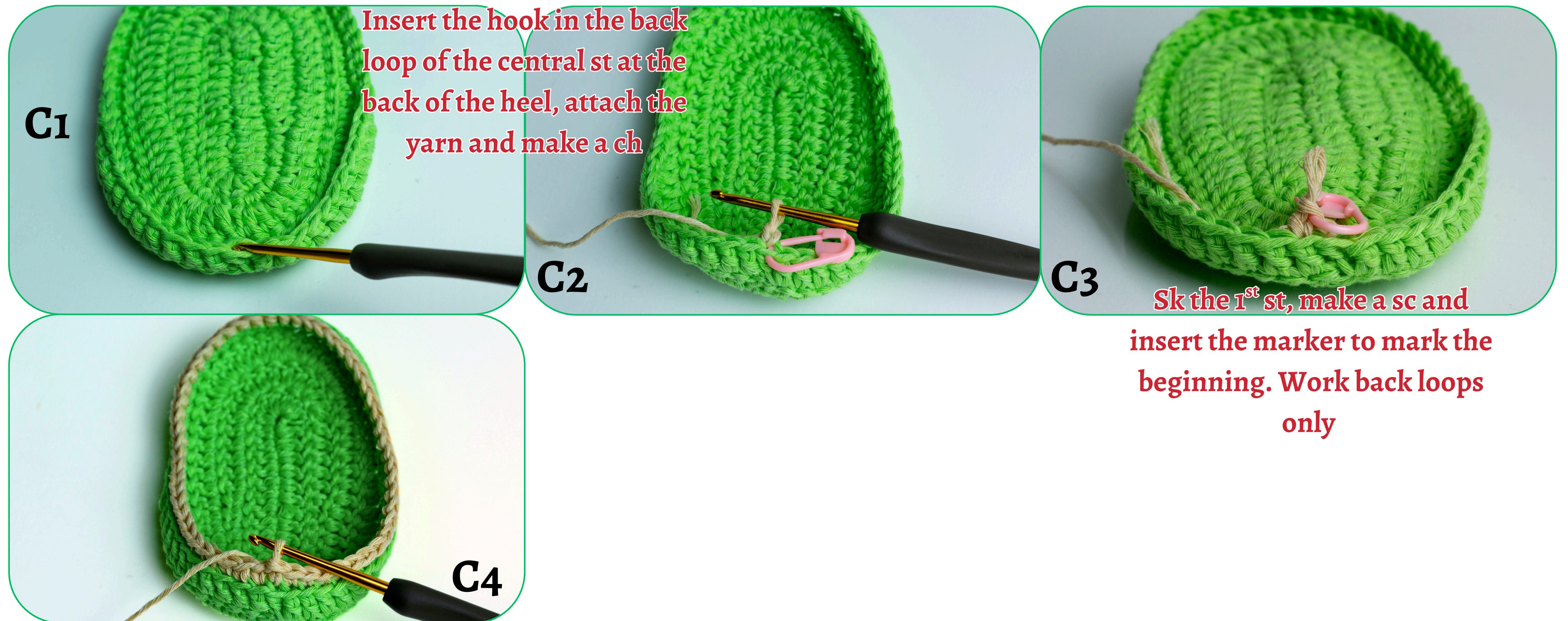
Upper part:

To begin the shoe's upper part, start in the center stitch at the back of the heel (*the false stitch - pic C1*). For the first row, work in the **back loops only** (BLO)

R 1 - (pics C1 - C4)

Attach a new yarn in a different color.

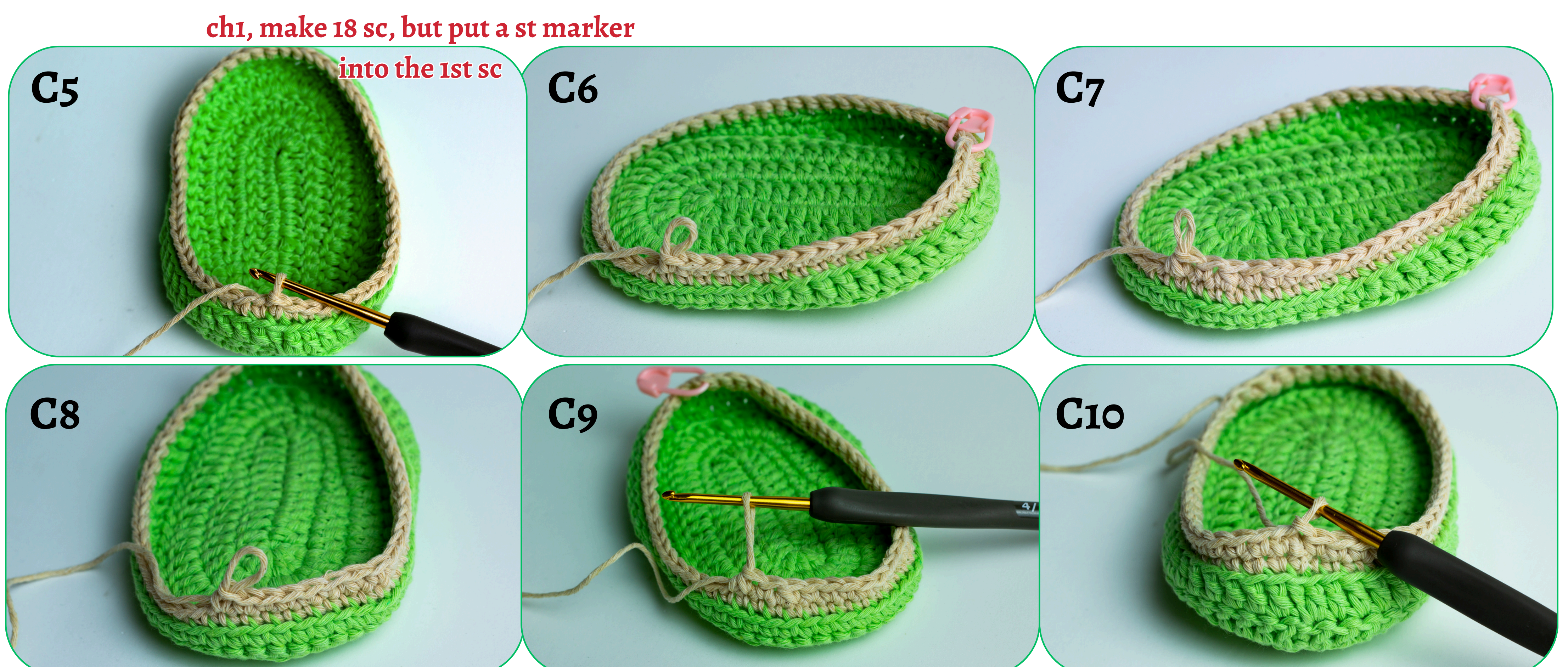
Ch 1, skip the 1st stitch, make **54/60/62** sc, sls (all ch1 + **54/60/62**)



Work both loops on all next rows:

R 2 - (pics C5 - C10)

Ch 1, **19/22/23** sc, 1 sc2tog, 1sc, 1 sc2tog, 6sc, 1 sc2tog, 1sc, 1 sc2tog, **19/22/23** sc, slst (all **50/56/58**)



R 3 - (pics C11 - C15)

Ch 1, 20/23/24 sc, 1 sc2tog, 7 sc, 1 sc2tog, 19/22/23 sc, slst (all ch1 + 48/54/56)

R 4 (pic C16 - C20)

Ch 1, make 15/18/19 sc, 9 dc2tog, 15/18/19 sc, slst (total 39/45/47 sts)

R 5 (pic C21 - C22)

Ch 1, make 39/45/47 sc, slst

R 6 (pic C23 - C25)

Ch 2, 1 dc2tog, 2dc, 2hdc, 9/10/11 sc, 5/7/7 dc2tog, 9/10/11 sc, 2hdc, 3dc, slst (total 33/37/39 sts)

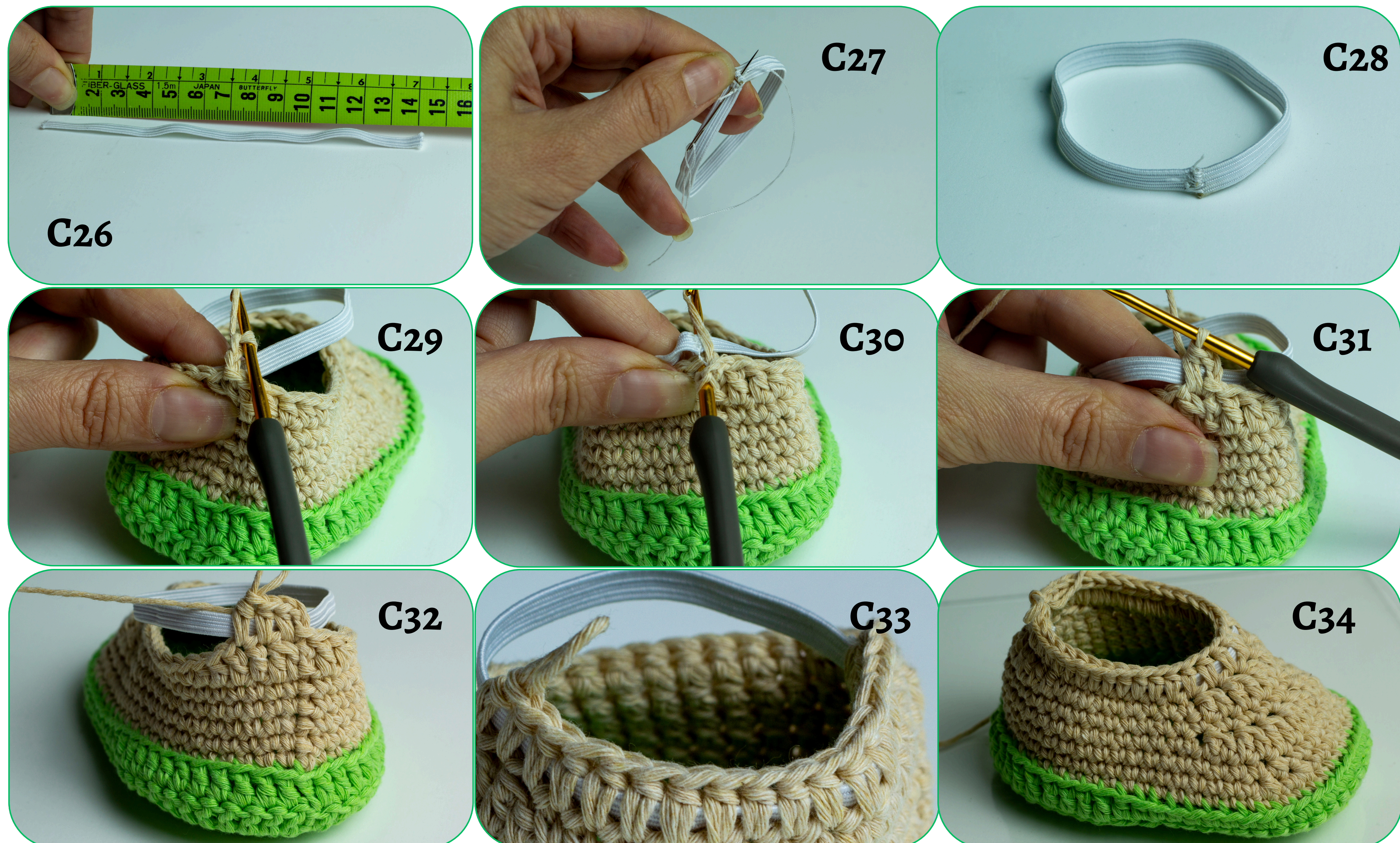


R 7 (pic C26 - C34)

Take an elastic band approximately 14–16 cm long (adjust to the preferred fit).

Sew the ends together, as shown in the pictures, to form a circle.

Ch 2, then begin making hdc stitches around the elastic, placing the band between the stitches as you work. Continue this process throughout the entire round. Slst to join. (all 33/37/39 sts)



Tongue (Pics D1 - D35)

0-3 months (Pics D1 - D11)

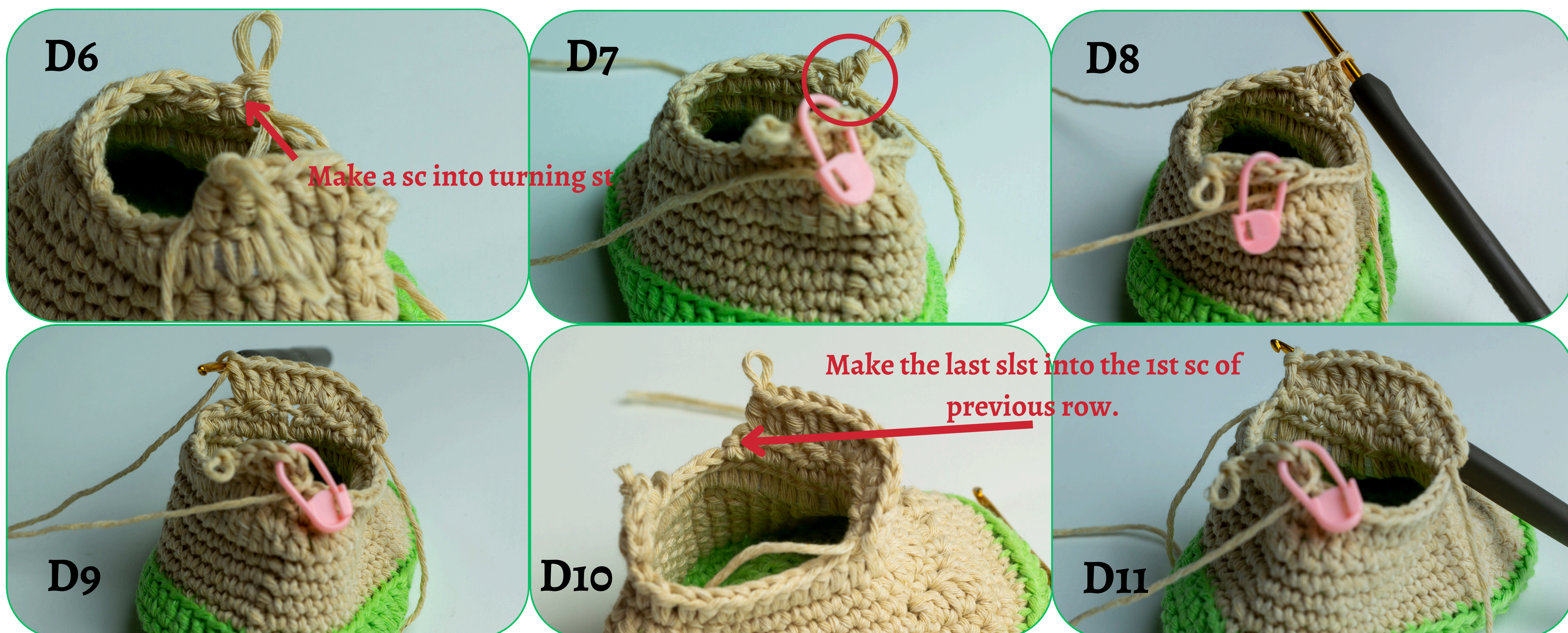
R 8

Ch 2, 3dc, 2hdc, sk 5 sts. Do not cut the yarn you were working with. (pic C35)

8.1 Take another yarn in the same color and attach it to the sixth st after the skipped ones, ch 1, sk, sc, 2hdc, 1 dc2tog, 1 dc, 1 dc2tog, 2hdc, 2 sc, turn, (pics D1 - D15)

8.2 sc into turning st, 2hdc, 2dc into each of next 4 sts, 2hdc, slst (pics D6 - D11)





... Continue R 8 (pic C36 - C43)

Go back to the skipped stitches and work: 5 sc into the skipped stitches (pic C36), 2 sc around the side of the tongue (pic C37), 2 hdc, 8 dc, 2 hdc, 2 sc around the other side of the tongue (pic C40), 5 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 2dc in last st, slst (pics C42, C43).



3-6 months / 6-9 months (Pics D12 - D17)

R 8

Ch 2, 3dc, 2hdc, sk 5/6 sts. Do not cut the yarn you were working with.

8.1 Take another yarn in the same color and attach to the 6th / 7th st, ch 1, sk, 1 sc, 2hdc, 2 dc2tog, 1 dc, 2 dc2tog, 2hdc, 2 sc, turn, (pic D12)

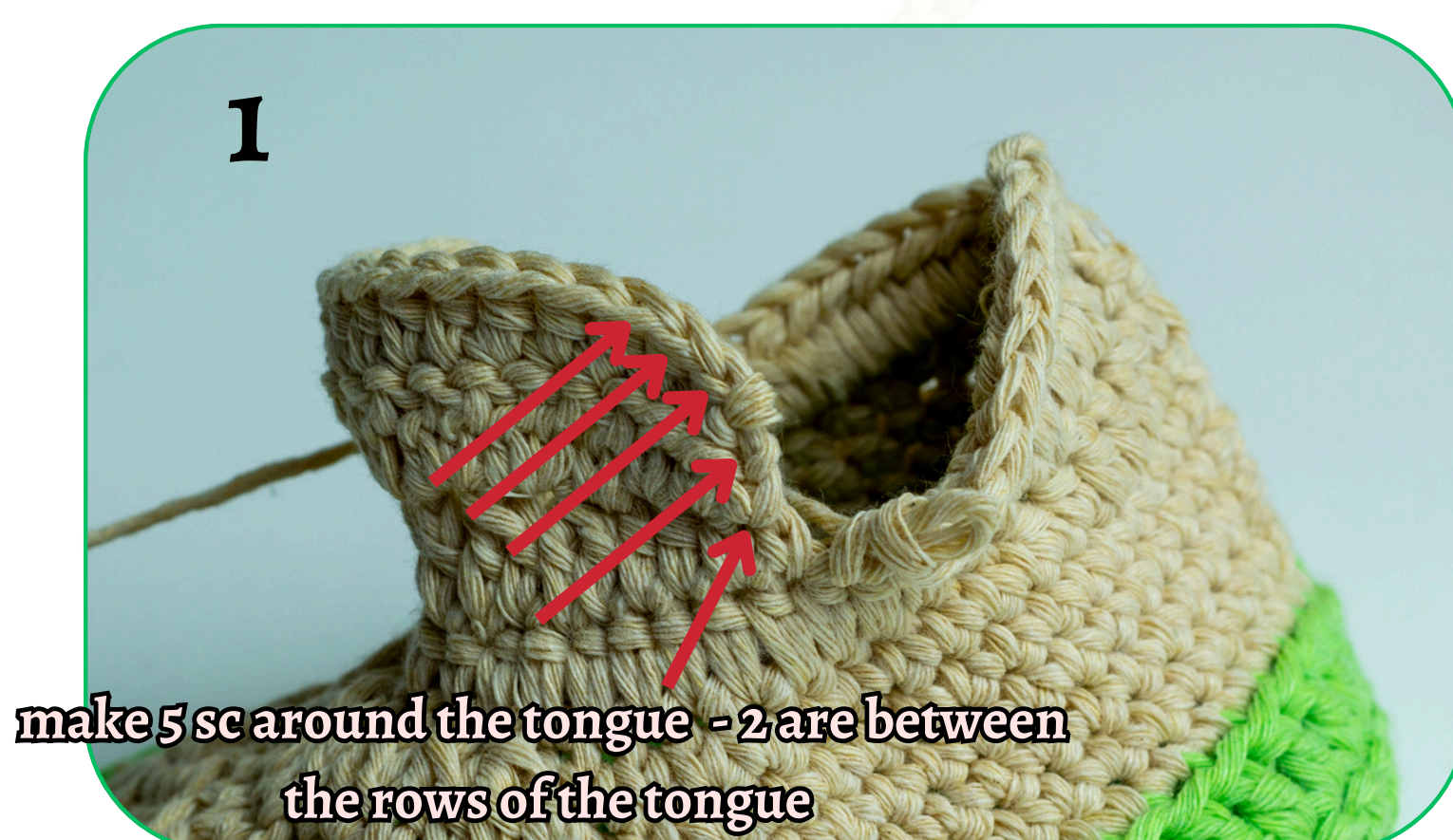
8.2 1 sc into turning st, 2hdc, 1dc, 2dc into each of next 4 sts, 1 dc, 2hdc, 1 sc, turn (pic D13)

8.3 sk 1, 1 sc, 13 hdc / 2 hdc, 9 dc, 2 hdc, slst (pics D14-D17)



... Continue R 8

Go back to the skipped stitches and continue: **5/6** sc, 5 sc around the side of the tongue (Pic 1), 2 hdc, 5 dc, 2 hdc, 5 sc across the top and down the other side of the tongue (Pics 2, 3), then work: 5 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 2 dc in the last stitch, slst to join. (all **37/40/42** sts)



all sizes

R 9 (pic C44 - C45)
ch1, **37/40/42** sc, inv join
(**38/41/43** sts)
