Your Guide to Pro-Quality Painting Tools

Brushes

- **2½" Angle Sash Brush** – For cutting in and trim work.
- **3" Flat Brush** – Great for large surfaces like walls and doors.
- **1½" Angle Brush** – For fine detail or tight spaces.

Pro Tip: Synthetic bristles for latex paints; natural bristles for oil-based.

Rollers

- **¼" Nap** – Smooth surfaces (doors, cabinets).
- **⅜" Nap** – Standard walls and ceilings.
- **½" Nap** – Lightly textured surfaces.
- **¾" Nap** – Rough textures like block or stucco.

Pro Tip: Use quality roller covers (Wooster or Purdy) for consistent texture.


3-Step Cleaning Routine

- 1 Rinse brushes and rollers immediately after use.
- 2 Use mild soap and a brush comb to remove paint.
- 3 Spin or shake dry; store upright.

Pro Tip: A Spin-Out roller cleaner saves time and extends roller life.
