# *Bunched Arrowhead Heritage Preserve:*

## *A Step Back in Time*

Escape the modern world and explore the untouched beauty of the **Bunched Arrowhead Heritage Preserve**. Just minutes from Travelers Rest, this 180-acre protected area offers a glimpse into the rolling foothills as they were centuries ago.

### ***What to Expect:***

*Scenic 1.25-Mile Loop Trail* – An easy, dog-friendly path through meadows, forests, and wetlands.

*Rare Plant Species* – Home to the endangered bunched arrowhead, blooming in late spring.

*Abundant Wildlife* – Spot songbirds, small mammals, and unique ferns year-round.

*Peaceful Retreat* – A quiet escape near horse farms and a secluded monastery.

***Getting There:*** From U.S. Highway 25, take Tigerville Road east for 1 mile, then turn left onto Shelton Road. Follow for another mile before turning right on McCauley Road. The parking area is ½ mile down on the right.

# Welcome to the Travelers Rest History Museum

## **History of the Museum**

The Travelers Rest **History Museum** is located at 8 S. Main Street in a historic building constructed in 1926 by W.H. Vest, originally serving as a grocery store. In 2010, local realtor T.L. Baldree generously donated the building to the Historical Society under the condition that it be relocated.

With support from the Bob Roe family, the building was transported to the southern edge of Travelers Rest, along the Swamp Rabbit Trail. The museum's facade features bricks from the former Travelers Rest High School, built in 1956 and demolished in 2011.

Come explore our latest exhibit featuring artifacts from the Anderson family and learn about the ongoing Spring Park Project!

## **Exhibits & Collections**

The museum proudly houses a variety of artifacts and exhibits showcasing the rich history of Travelers Rest and its role as a resting place for travelers moving between the mountains and the coast. Key exhibits include:

Anderson Family Collection – Rare artifacts and personal items.

Spring Park Project – A glimpse into the community's restoration efforts.

Travelers Rest Heritage – Displays highlighting early settlers, businesses, and cultural influences.

Located along the scenic Swamp Rabbit Trail, the museum is easily accessible by foot, bike, or car. Parking is available nearby.

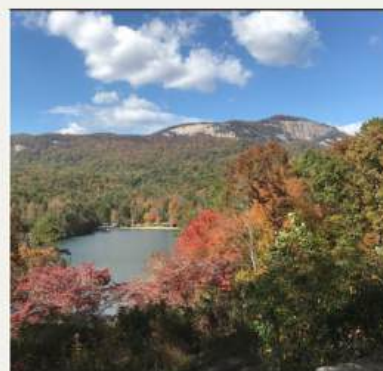
