Perú is a world genetic center with more than 4,400 native plants. Corn, an ancient grain, is fundamental to our culture.

The Gian White Corn of Cusco, or Blanco Urubamba, is grown between 2,750 and 2,950 meters above sea level, on fertile lands and ancestral terraces.



More than 80% of its producers are small farmers who keep this heritage alive.
