Spiritual Warfare Decree: Overcoming Lust

Daily declarations and Scripture for walking in purity, power, and purpose

Daily Spoken Prayer

Heavenly Father, I come before You in the mighty name of Jesus.

I surrender my heart, my body, and my desires to You today.

Clothe me in the armor of God and fill me with Your Spirit.

I declare that I am not a slave to lust—I am a son of God, redeemed and set free. I put to death every fleshly desire and I walk in purity, power, and purpose. Jesus, be Lord over my thoughts, my eyes, and my heart.

Strengthen me to choose righteousness and guard my steps according to Your Word. Holy Spirit, fill me now—lead me in wisdom, and deliver me from temptation. I declare victory today. I walk in holiness. I am more than a conqueror. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Spiritual Warfare Decree

I decree that I am strong in the Lord and in the power of His might (Ephesians 6:10). I have made a covenant with my eyes (Job 31:1), and I walk in purity of heart (Matthew 5:8).

I put on the Lord Jesus Christ and make no provision for the flesh (Romans 13:14). I flee lust and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace (2 Timothy 2:22). I walk by the Spirit and will not gratify the desires of the flesh (Galatians 5:16). I have escaped the corruption of lust through the divine power of Christ (2 Peter 1:3–4). Walking in humility and the fear of the Lord



Daily Spoken Prayer

Father in Heaven, I come before You in the name of Jesus.

I renounce pride and every spirit of self-exaltation.

I declare that apart from You, I am nothing and can do nothing.

Clothe me today with humility, just as Christ humbled Himself.

Teach me to walk in lowliness of heart and fear of the Lord.

I will not lean on my own understanding, but I will trust in You with all my heart. Uproot every hidden form of pride in my thoughts, my words, and my motives. Let my boast be in knowing You and in carrying the mind of Christ. I humble myself before You today. Exalt me only in Your timing and for Your glory. Let no prideful desire take root in my heart.

Fill me with the wisdom, grace, and peace that come only through humility. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Spiritual Warfare Decree

I decree that I am clothed in humility and walk in the fear of the Lord (1 Peter 5:5–6). I do not boast in my strength, wisdom, or accomplishments—I boast in knowing God (Jeremiah 9:23–24).

Daily Spoken Prayer

Today, I put on Christ and cast off all jealousy and covetousness.

I choose contentment, gratitude, and humility over competition and comparison. Fill me with Your Spirit so that I may walk in love, peace, and confidence in my calling. Let my heart be pure, my motives be right, and my focus be fixed on You alone. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Spiritual Warfare Decree

Spiritual Warfare Decree

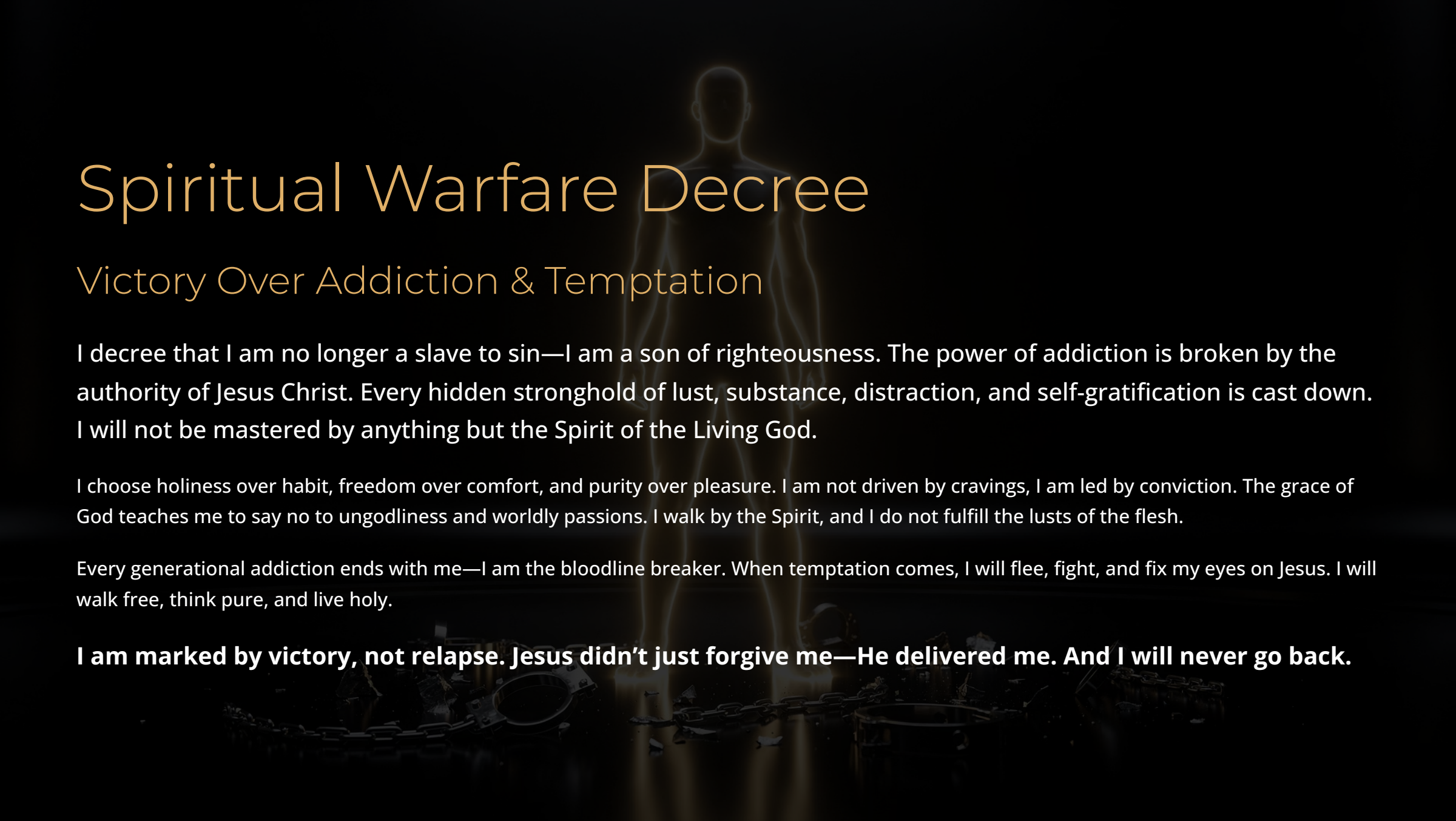

I break agreement with fear, dread, hopelessness, and despair. These are not my portion. Joy is. Peace is. Power is.

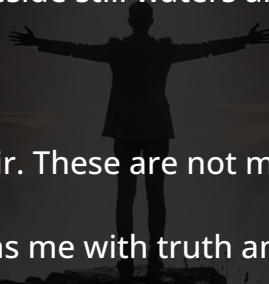
Your perfect love casts out all fear, and Your Spirit strengthens me with truth and courage.

Standing Firm in Clarity

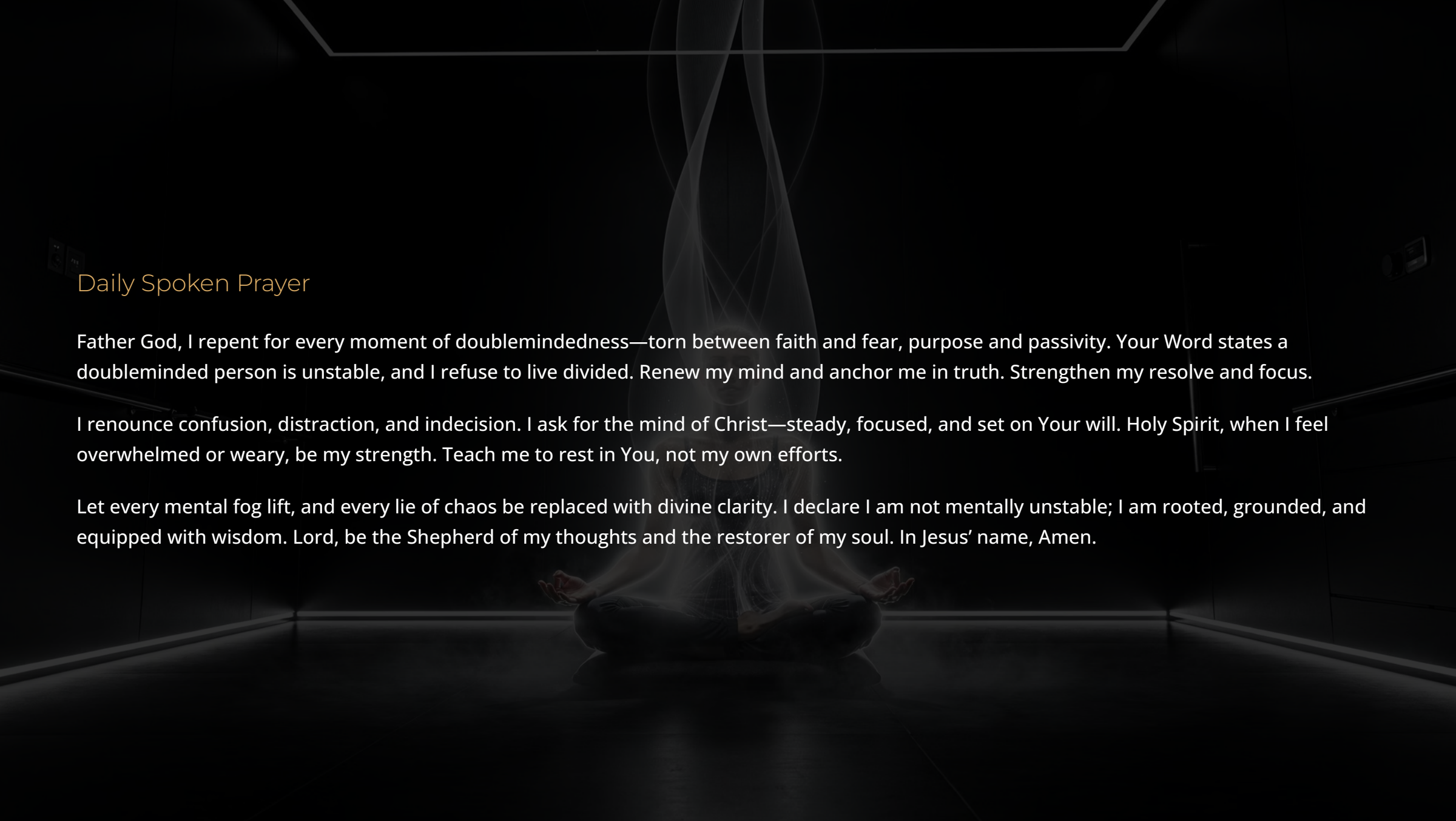
