CARD BASE

CRUMB CAKE CARDSTOCK

5 1/2 x 8 1/2 score at 2 1/8, 4 1/4 flip card over and score at 2 1/8 on opposite end) 3 x 6 score at 3 (moving panel)

CARDSTOCK

BASIC WHITE CARDSTOCK

3) 4 1/2 x 5 1/2 (stamp 2-Hydrangea, 1-Poppy, mask with ink, and die cut out)
*Second Hydrangea only spot samp bloom for die cutting 3 blossoms' out) If Desired.
3 x 6 (cut two squares using stylish shape dies #5)

*Scrap for your selected sentiment

FRESH FREESIA CARDSTOCK

4) 2 x 5 1/8 (first layer, Mats)

CRUMB CAKE CARDSTOCK

4 x 5 1/4(2 small foliage, 2 large foliage

DSP

LOVELY GARDEN DESIGNER SERIES PAPER

2) 2 x 5 1/2 (black polka dot pattern, embossed with eyelet 3-D folder After embossing cut both panels down to 1 $3/4 \times 5 1/8$ (due to allowance/shrinkage) 3 $3/4 \times 5 1/8$ (Black polka dot pattern, without stamping using masks only! mask two floral, and two leaves, to your liking)

INKS

PRETTY IN PINK CLASSIC STAMPIN PAD FRESH FREESIA CLASSIC STAMPIN PAD OLD OLIVE CLASSIC STAMPIN PAD CRUMB CAKE CLASSIC STAMPIN PAD TUXCEDO BLACK MEMENTO INK PAD

EMBELLISHMENTS

GOLD STRIPED RIBBON BRUSHED BRASS BUTTERFLIES WINK OF STELLA

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TUTORIAL

Cut all card stock according to recipe directions.

Stamped floral images on the basic white card stock using memento tuxedo black ink.

DECORATIVE MASKS

Hydrangea stamp 1 complete hydrangea, I did 2 complete to use leaves for future projects. You can just stamp second hydrangea bloom to get your die cut for the 3-blossom cluster die. (If you do not want to have the 3-blossom cluster for your embellishment on your sentiment, then only do one hydrangea) Secure Floral images with post it notes, I also used post it notes for each mask as I layered on the Inks.

Fresh Freesia

Mask #1 swirl very lightly covering completely

Mask #2 swirl medium covering completely

Mask #3 swirl firm covering completely

Old Olive

Mask #4 swirl very lightly covering completely Mask#5 swirl medium, cover and completely **Poppy**

Pretty in Pink

(same as above)

Die cut floral images out, including the three blossoms from 2nd hydrangea. Apply Wink of Stella (set aside to dry, you can apply twice and it really makes it shiny)

DSP

Using your decorative masks on your DSP polka dot side you want to concentrate on the four corners & sides for your background behind the movement of the fancy fold. Use the same Masks and Inks, just do not stamp the Images. Go lighter on blending see illustrations and photos on website. Cut in half at 1 7/8 x 5 1/8 (set aside) The two longer strips 2 x 5 1/2 of the polka dot DSP run them through your Eyelet 3-D embossing folder. Trim down to 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ x 5 1/8 (Set aside)

I DESIGNED THIS CARD TO HAVE DIFFERENT SIDE BORDERS FOR THE SECOND LAYER.

STYLISH SHAPES DIES

Die cut 2 square #4 Fresh Freesia colored side of DSP

Die cut 2 square #5 Basic White Cardstock

Die cut sentiment #2 Banner

GREENERY

Crumb Cake Die cut 2 LG greenery pieces Die cut 2 Med greenery pieces

ASSEMBLY TIME

FIRST-Using your bone folder crease all score lines on card base. Liquid glue is advised. Glue down the first layer mat Of Fresh Freesia. Glue down the second layer of polka dot DSP. The embossed pieces are placed on each END and the beautiful Newly Decorated pieces are glued in the two center sections. (side margins are smaller there) Just do your best to align all panels straight across on the top and bottom of ALL layers $\frac{9}{2}$

Glue Fresh Freesia DSP squares onto Basic White Squares, THEN attach to the 3 x 6 moving base piece. (set aside to dry) I use my blocks to place on top for a few minutes.

NOW-It's a distressing time. Use the Crumb Cake ink and dauber or blending brush and apply the ink to all 4 leaves edges. (until desired look is achieved) Use bone folder and arch all leaves on the branches to add additional dimension. (TRY IT THIS TIME!!)

ATTACHMENT-time! You will need grid paper or mat to measure the width of the movement panel. So, this beautiful card will fit inside the Basic White Envelope #159236. Push all 4 accordion layers together and place on the left side of the grid. Slide the moveable section onto the card until your measurement is 4 ¼ wide. (see photo on website) I used post it to mark where the panel needs to be glued. Be sure to put more glue because of the embossing and the movement of the fold. Glue to the front and back of the base. (Set aside with large block on top to dry.

DECORATING- time! Glue the 4 leaves one each corner of the embossed panels (see photo) Use Stampin dimensionals on BOTH FLORAL images. (see photo)Remove backing and stick down where desired. Glue down sentiment of your choosing, right side will need 2 dimensionals and left side will simply be glued straight onto hydrangea. Curl up the edges of the 3-blossom floral die cut piece and glue it onto the corner of sentiment banner and right to the hydrangea.

EMBELLISNMENT-TIME! Tie a small gold striped ribbon and attach it with mini a glue dot This is the most exciting moment... We have ALL been waiting for. Finding just the right spots for the Brushed Brass Butterflies. This card has a very small area to write BUT believe me when the recipient receives this card.... The only thing you need to do is sign it WITH LOVE. You've poured your heart into every fold and flourish — now sit back, smiling, and let your handmade beauty bring joy to someone special. *****
