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# TUTORIAL

# CUT ALL THE CARDSTOCK & DSP ACCORDING TO THE RECIPE!

#### **DIE CUTTING**

Die cut the large daffodil out of the Basic Black Cardstock. Die cut your frame out of the Silver Foil sheets using die cut #4-#5. Use the Center of the foil (from the frame) to die cut only top section of dandelion, and the small greenery. (see photo)

Die cut Cloud Cover background picture matting using die #5, then run it through the damask embossing folder. (set aside)

Die cut distressed piece of DSP using the corner swirl die We will call it our picture brackets die. Place on opposite diagonal corners.

#### **STAMPING**

Stamp the medium floral image looks like lilac onto the Basic White. Color with your Stampin Blends. Die cut out. (set aside)

Stamp your 2 pieces of Basic White with Cloud Cover for the inside of your card using the Demaske floral pattern at the bottom. Select your sentiment of choice and stamp on the top of both pieces. (set aside)

# **ASSEMBLY TIME (inside of card)**

Take your DSP 4 x 6 piece, lay it on the paper trimmer and score at 1, 2, 3,4, 5 inches. Use your bone folder and carefully lay the score lines back and-lining them up top and bottom of your paper on every fold to make sure that every score that you fall back is even and straight.

Take your Cloud Cover card stock, 4 x 4 lay it on the paper trimmer and score at 1 inch on one side of both pieces (see photo)

\* This is the crucial part where you get your DSP and your side pieces connected. (See photo) Both ends of your Cloud Cover will go behind the scored 1 inch scored line on the DSP. Attach carefully making sure everything is even and lines up plus your pattern needs to be in the right direction facing up.

**NOW**- using grid paper or a grid mat line up your card base straight. This accordion piece likes to move around so it's very important that you keep it straight for gluing. I used a block to hold down one side while gluing the other into place. Repeat carefully on the other side. Fold your accordion DSP together close card base set block on top (set aside.) After drying, glue the 2 white panels inside with your sentiments onto the Cloud Cover CS.

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#### **DISTRESSING / HEAT EMBOSSING TIME**

Take your DSP with picture brackets cut out and lift them up and carefully place scrap paper underneath them. I use Tuxedo Memento Black and a small brush. (aka gum dental flosser) or whatever tool you have that is small enough to maneuver through the scrolling. Using a clear Block squeeze out a few drops of black ink use the brush and go around and distress each edge of the swirls, very carefully, keeping the scrap paper underneath each as you raised them. Let that dry, push the scroll pieces back down flat into the DSP. **Take to your embossing area**, use your scratch paper and cover the DSP all around & under the scroll pieces. (see photo) Take your versa mark and the damask pattern photopolymer stamp and stamp the picture brackets **ONLY!** Sprinkle on the metallic silver embossing powder- tap off- and heat embossing. THIS IS THE BLING WOW!!! FACTOR FOR ME ON THIS CARD...

**THEN**-Take your distressed front mat with the embossed corners and glue down onto the black card base. DO NOT GLUE DOWN ANY PART OF THE SCROLL PICTURE BRACKETS Use your Stampin dimensionals and place underneath the scroll picture brackets. Make sure you leave the 3-pronged picture bracelets scroll **WITHOUT** any dimensionals. This is the spot where we will be sliding our main focal Picture Frame with beautiful florals. (See photo)

Use your Stampin dimensionals and place underneath the other scrolls. I used the Black combo package, and it was awesome! Because it has mini and large in the same pack and being black, they do not show especially on this black card base (BY DESIGN) YIPPEE!!

**CREATING THE PICTURE**-There are 3 separate Silver Foil greenery pieces & 3 in Basic Black card stock pieces. Glue them together for a shadow effect.

(See photo for cutting & gluing)

Use mini Stampin dimensionals cut in half & also cut along the edge called the Stampin bones place underneath the silver frame and mat it onto the Cloud Cover Cardstock embossed backdrop picture mat. (we're creating) Place the frame onto the card base and into the 3 pc scrolled picture brackets. Hold this down into place with a clear block using mini glue dots and slip them under the frame so it's secured right where you placed it. Now it's just Layering the florals one by one. Start with the large dandelion in the center of the frame glue straight down. Next place the floral lilacs where you want them. Take off and add Stampin dimensionals as needed. Remove their backings and press down firmly. I angled them and kept the leaves on top of the frame for an added dimensional look. Now add the two small greenery pieces down on top of the florals and into the corner of the picture frame to conceal the bottom of the floral stems, style to your liking!

You did it! Y This card bursts with beauty! From the distressed Beautiful Gallery DSP to the silver-embossed scrolled picture brackets. Our silver frame is overflowing with beautiful flowers; it's a true work of heart.
