How to Build Your Paper-Based Tracking Routine

Whether you manage a single vehicle or a small fleet, here's how to stay organized without digital distractions.

Step 1 → Log your mileage

- Every work trip = a deduction
- Record date, purpose, start & end odometer
- Use your **Mileage** Log Book daily



Step 2 → Track vehicle expenses

- Fuel, insurance, repairs – keep every receipt
- Total weekly/monthly costs
- Use your **Expense Log Book** weekly



Step 3 → Maintain a service history


- Oil changes, inspections, tire checks
- Helps with resale value & tax audits
- Use your **Maintenance Log Book** as needed

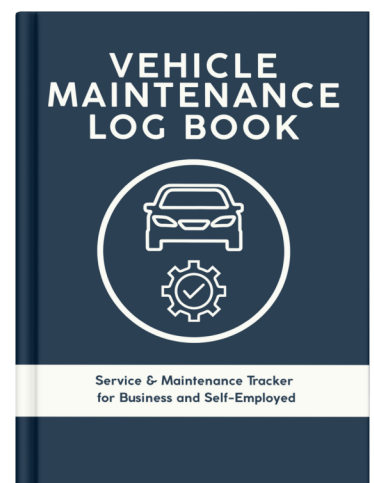
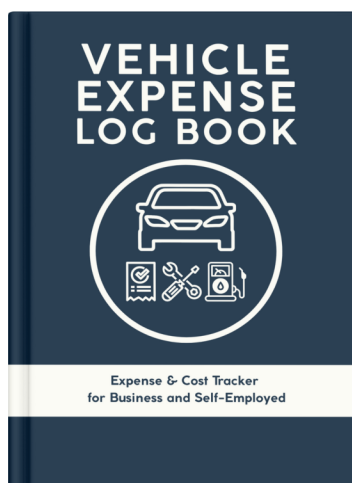
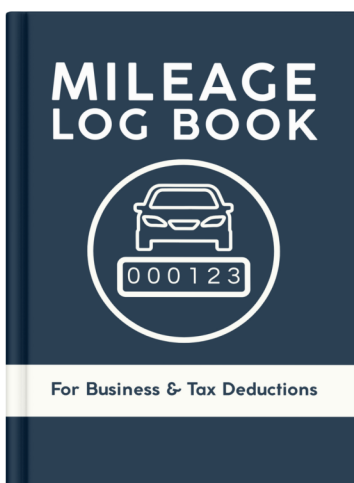
