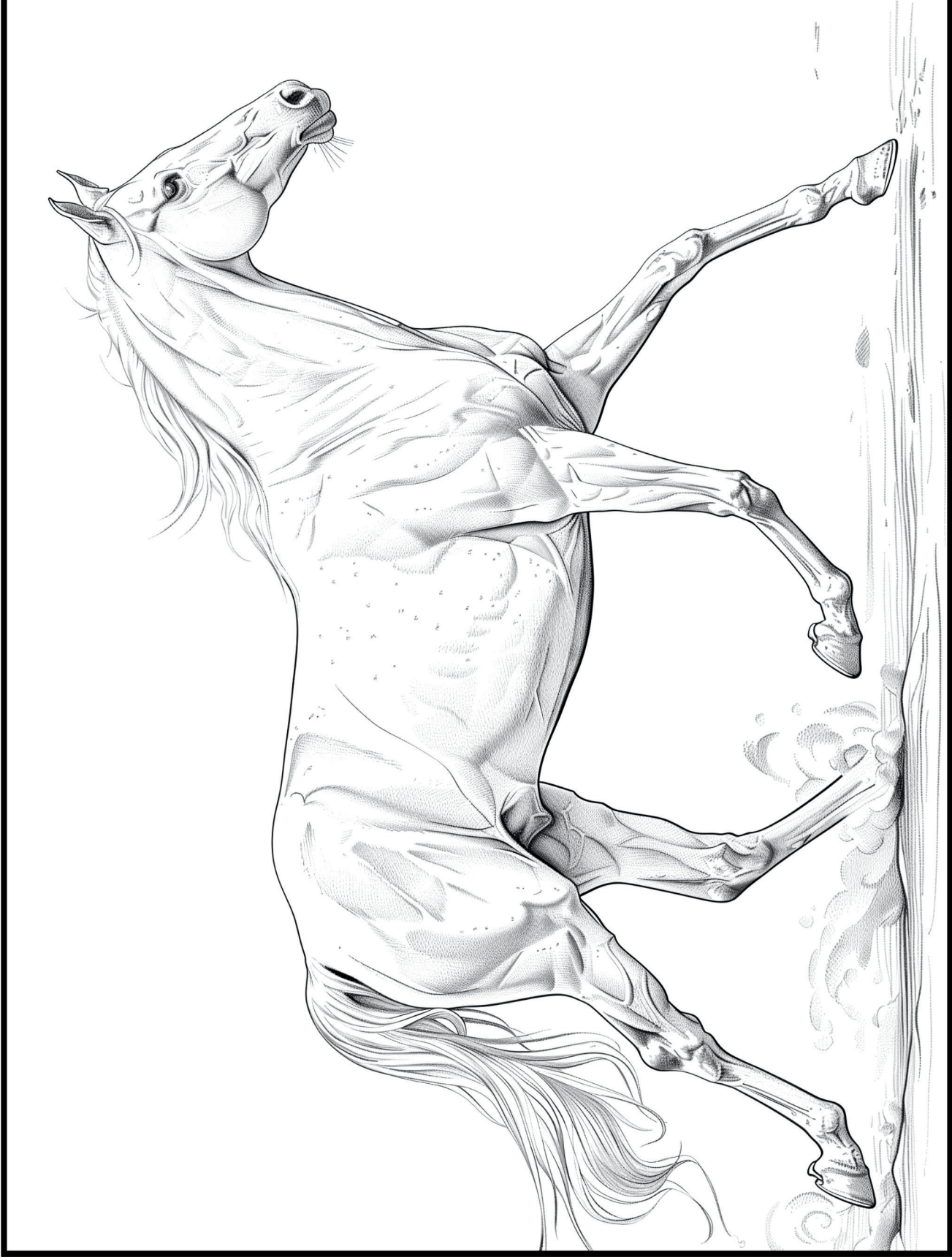

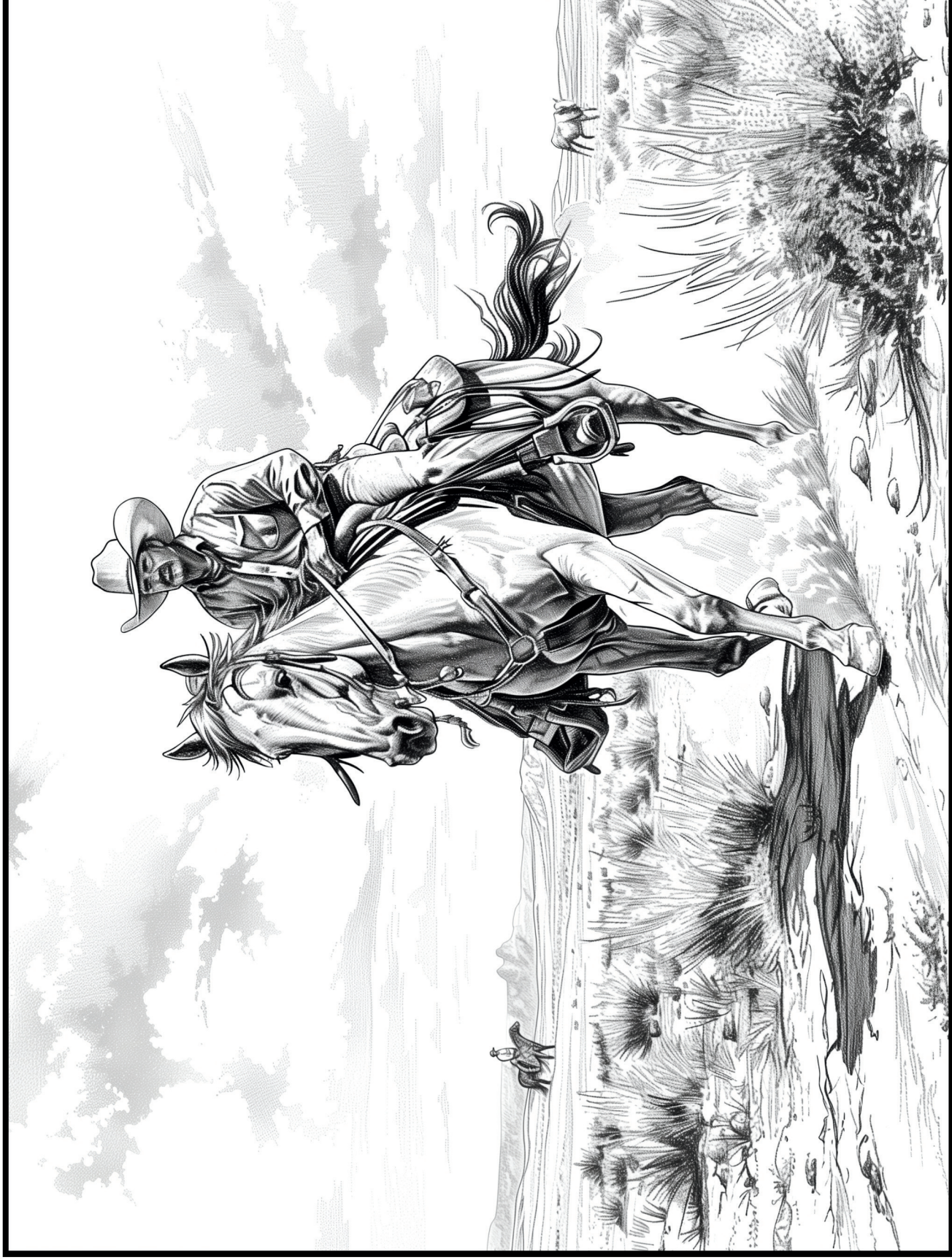
### Akhal-Teke Horse

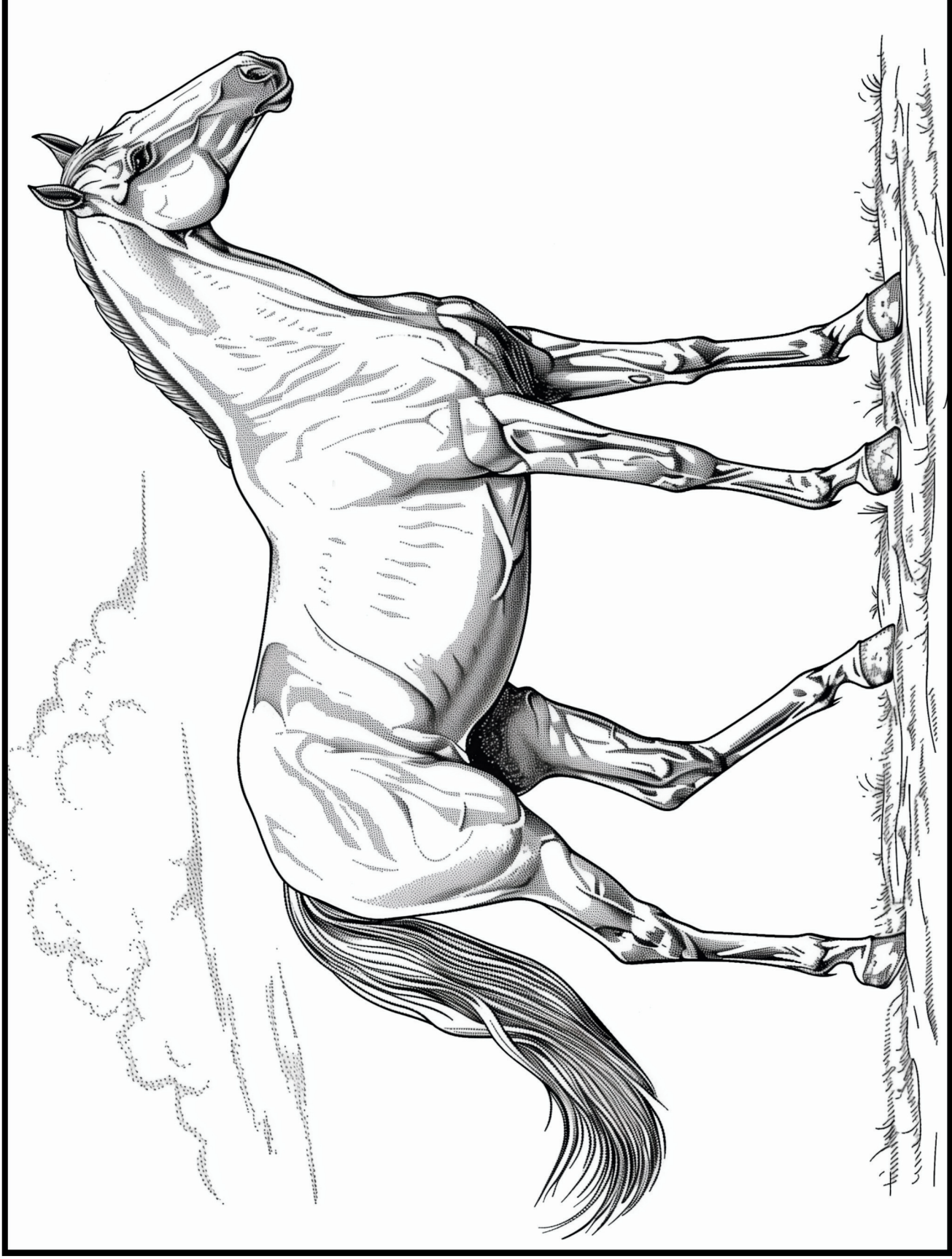
## Mangalarga Marchador

## Rocky Mountain Horse

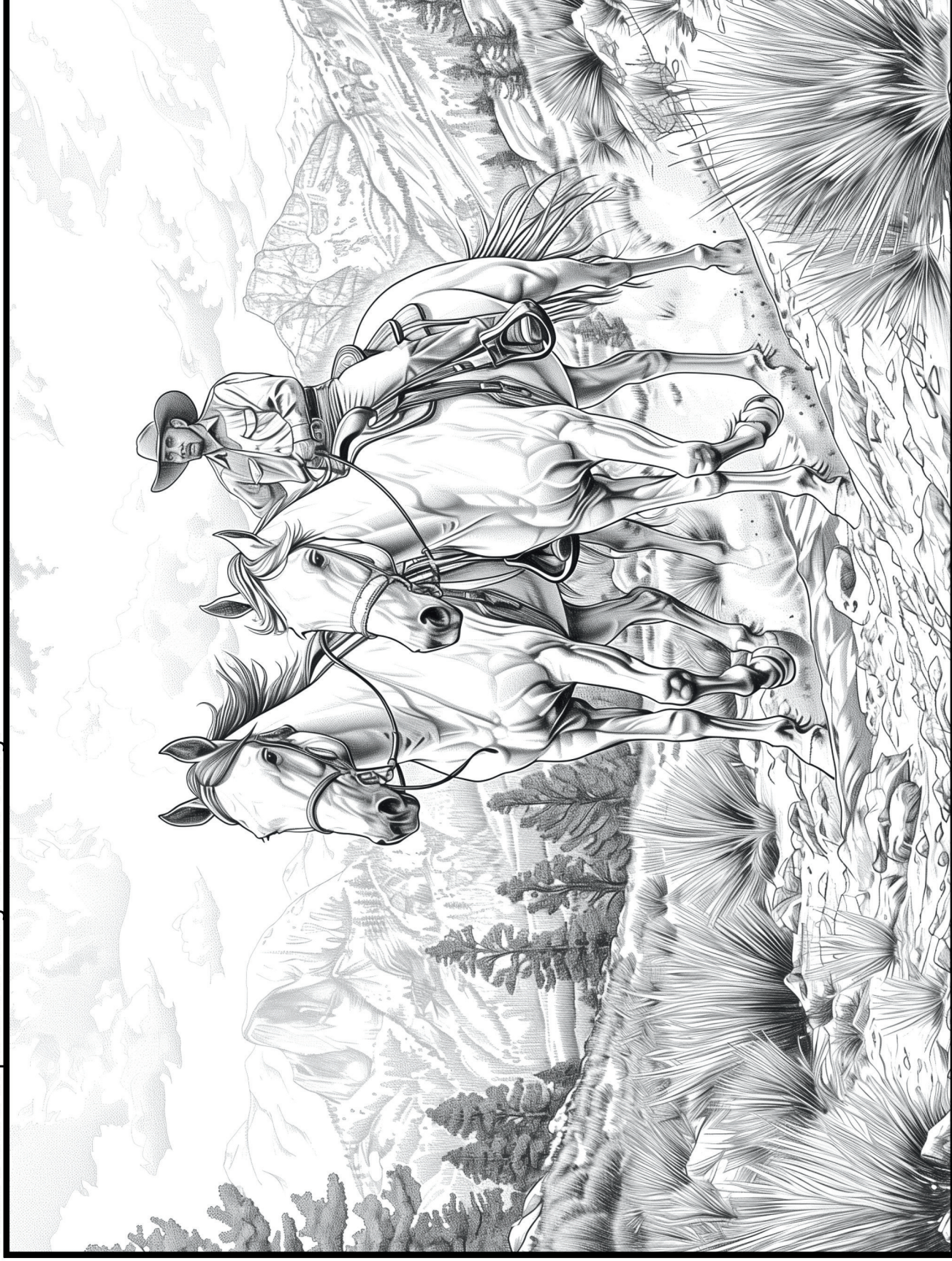

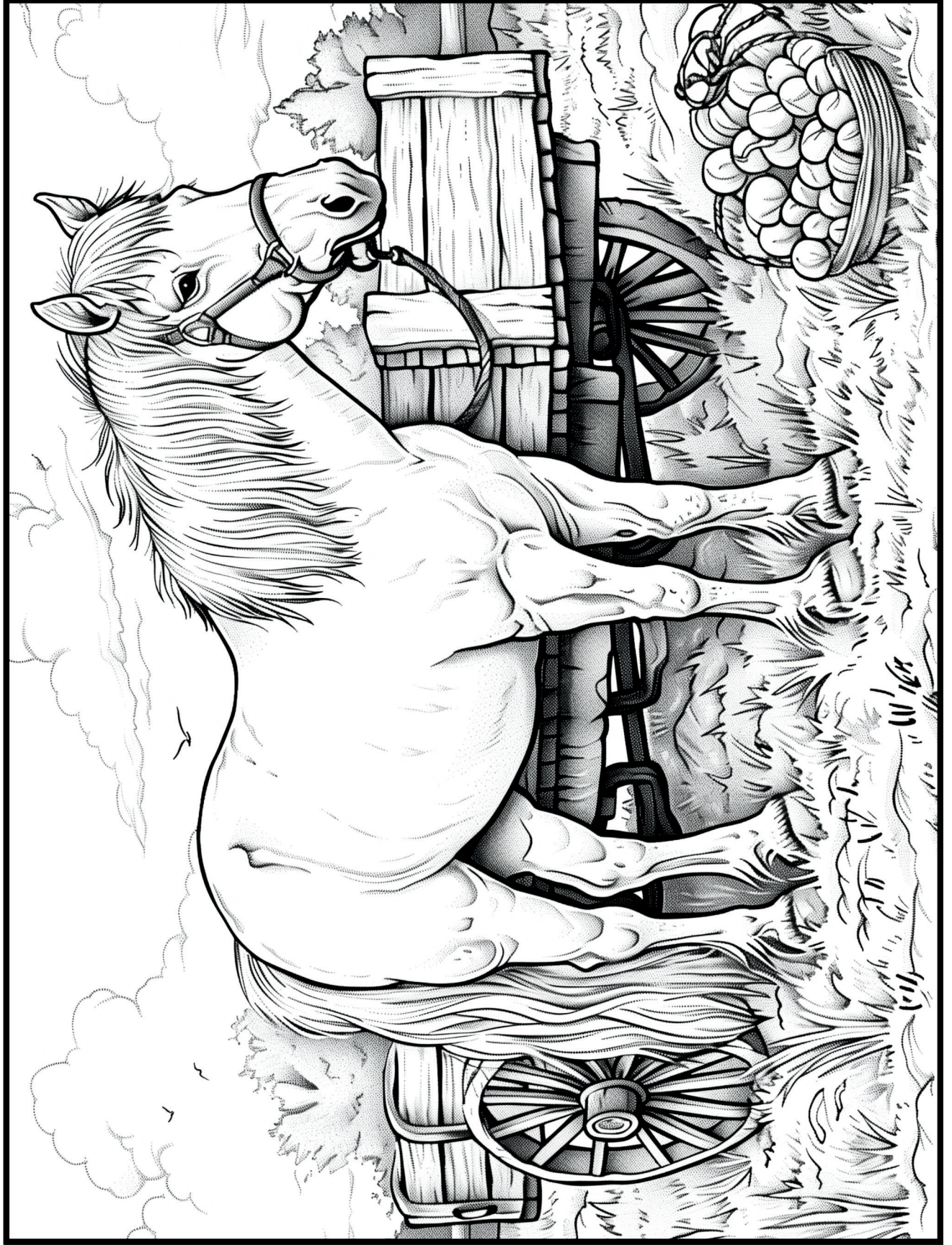


### Connemara Pony

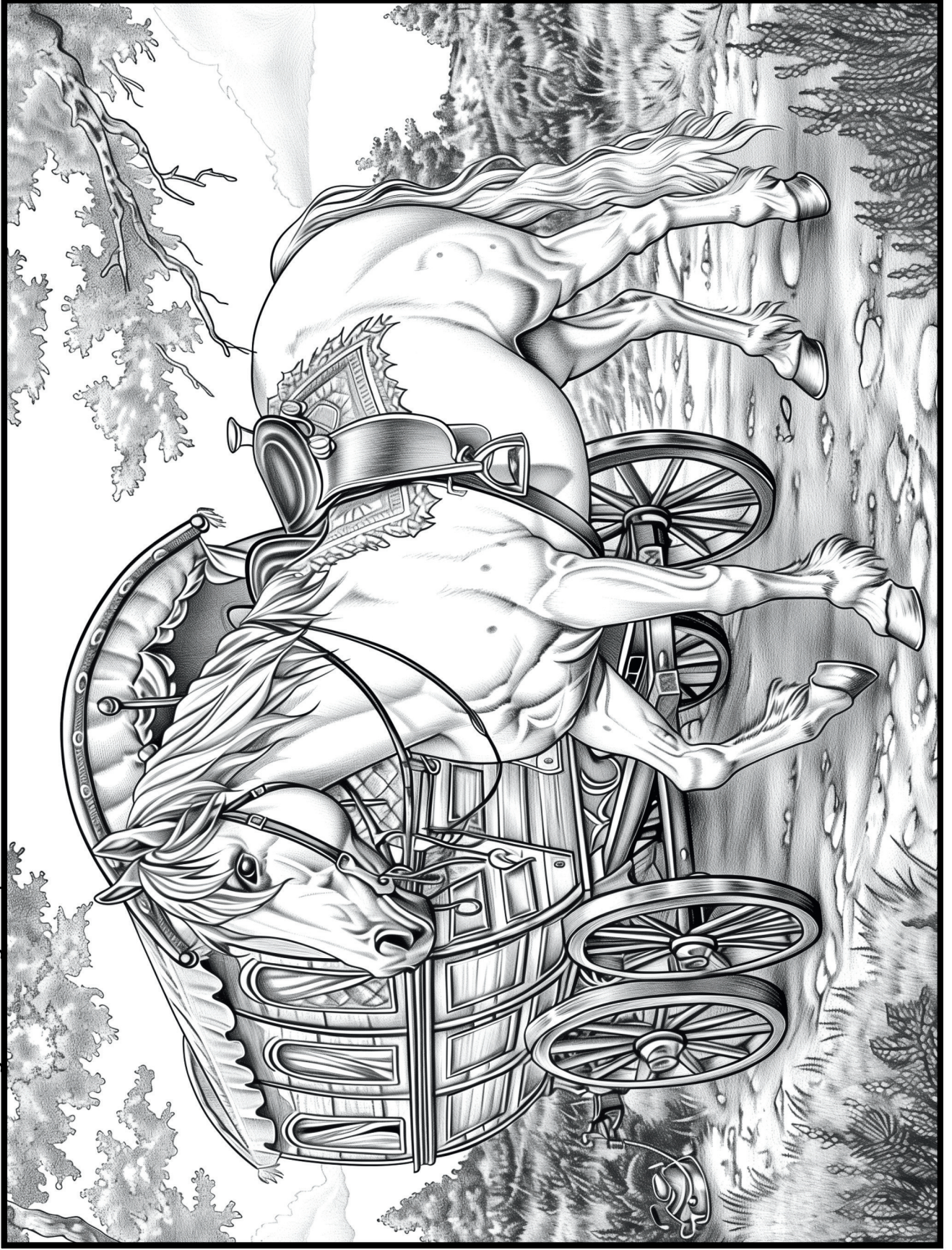
