Au Pair In Germany Info Pack

What is an Au Pair?

An AU Pair is a young person who lives with a host family in Germany and helps with childcare and light household duties in exchange for:

- Free accommodation
- Meals
- A monthly stipend
- Cultural exchange experience

Why become an Au Pair in Germany?

- Learn German in a native-speaking environment
- Live in one of Europe's most central and culturally rich countries
- Build international experience
- Travel across Europe during holidays
- Affordable way to experience life abroad



Requirements to Be an Au Pair in Germany

You must:

- Be between 18-26 years old
- Have basic German knowledge (A1 level)
- Be unmarried and have no children
- Have completed high school (Matric/Grade 12)
- Be in a good health
- Clear criminal record
- Be able to stay for 6-12 months
- Have a love for taking care of children

Duties of an Au Pair

- Play with and supervise the children
- Assist with getting children ready for school
- Light household tasks (e.g., tidying up toys, helping with laundry, loading dishwasher)
- Up to 30 hours per week, including babysitting
- 1-2 days of per week





What you get as an Au Pair in Germany?

- €280 pocket money per month
- Free room and meals
- €70 monthly contribution toward a language course
- Health, accident, liability insurance
- Public transportation ticket to the language school
- Free board & lodging in a private room
- 1.5 days off per week
- 4 weeks of paid vacation per year
- Help the host family 30 hours per week that is 6 hours per day
- Paid flight ticket (Some families reimburse other pay upfront)

Visa & Documentation

If you are from:

- EU/EEA – No visa needed
- Non-EU countries (South Africa, Namibia, and neighbour countries) -Need a long-term national visa for au pair proses

More documents you need:

- Valid passport
- German language certificate
- Police clearance certificate
- Health check certificate



Cultural Exchange Opportunities

- ◆ Weekend travels to neighbouring countries (France, Netherlands, Austria)
