- Children are the most precious things for a family, that's why you have to be experienced and trustworthy. We trust you!



WHAT YOU'LL BE DOING AS AN AU PAIR:

WITH US, your main task will be to take care of your host family's children and some light household

chore duties only related to kids. Like doing their laundry, preparing lunch/dinner for them, emptying

the dishwasher cleaning up the kid's rooms and so on.

So, it means you would:

• Play with your host children, do crafts with them, read a book to them, go to the park with

them, bathe them. It will all depend on the family's expectations.

• Take the kids to school, pick them up, help with homework. Give them the yummy snack you

have prepared

- Take them to play dates with other children or take them to other appointments and activities.
- Depending on your host family's needs and your working hours, you might need to dress your

host children in the morning (or help them get dressed) and help them get ready for bed in the

evening.

You will also help out with minor household duties, like:

- Cleaning the children's room(s) and of course your own,
- doing the children's laundry, emptying the dishwasher,
- preparing meals for the kids (lunch/dinner),
- You are also responsible for keeping your room clean.

☒ What you won't do:

- You won't be responsible for cleaning parent's areas of the house, such as bedrooms.
- No washing and ironing clothes of the entire family. No cooking for the entire host family (of course you can prepare a meal for them, to introduce them to your culture).
- Au pairs are not to serve as general housekeepers or assume responsibility for household management. In any case, our Families are already informed about the regulation, and we only accept those who accept it.

WHAT YOU GET (THE SWEET STUFF!)

- Days off: At least 2 days off per week
- Locations: Conveniently situated near French schools and the city for a social life.
- French Courses fees: In case of a long placement, our families will offer an incentive.
- Assistance: You can reach us 7/7 through WhatsApp at any time during your stay.
- For stays exceeding 3 months, you will be enrolled in the French social security system. This will cover a part of your healthcare expenses while you're in France.
- Private medical insurance: in addition, you will be covered by an au pair tailored insurance during your entire stay.
- Administrative assistance: We'll guide you through the renewal process for residence permits.
- Pocket money: At least €90 per week, or €100 if you are a driver
- Public transportation will be provided for your mobility. If you need to drive for the kids, the family will assist with the cost of fuel, but you will be responsible for your long-distance trips.
- Holidays: At least 3 paid weeks holidays in case of a long placement.
- Community: Connection with our other cheerful au pairs already in FRANCE
- Shopping: get Amazon discount for your shopping

In summary, you will have a legal status in France, a secure host family, and favourable placement conditions, including additional services and support.

All is a relevant budget for a hosting family.

Other Cost inside the country:

Dates and other details will be discussed and agreed upon mutually between you and your host family.

FRENCH COURSES & STUDIES

Since March 2019, attending French courses is compulsory for a stay longer than 3 months. It can be in any in any private language school or public association providing French courses.

Your host family will arrange the schedule to let you the time to attend to the most of them.

These are courses of all levels, tailored for young people who are learning French like au pair and international student.

This is usually between 3 to 12 hours per week. As soon as you have found your HF, we will guide you to find the best local establishment.

Courses are not only useful for French level improvement, but also for meeting people, having friends and a balance working time / social life. Courses are very helpful for your integration.

Think about your employment attractiveness on the Job Market! You will also gain an attestation that will proves you have attended French courses abroad.

Key asset to make the difference when you will apply later for job positions or to apply for a private school or University.

Keep in mind the school fees will have to be handled by you. But no worry, au pairs are used to attend courses, you just need to save a little money, and it is affordable.
