## WHO CAN BECOME AN AU PAIR IN ITALY?

- Age 18-30 years old
- Single with no children
- Love kids and family life
- Basic English or Italian Speaker
- Good health and open heart
- Willing to stay 3,6,12 months
- No criminal record
- 2 references (non-family related)
- Non-smoker
- Good swimmer

If this sounds like you, you are already halfway to Italy!

#### WHAT YOU'LL DO:

You'll be the fun, caring helper in the house – like a big sibling!

- · Help the kids get ready in the morning
- Play games, sing songs, do homework
- Babysit occasionally
- Assist with light child-related chores
- Au Pair in Italy should work 30 hours per week and working hours should not exceed 5/6 hours per day.
- Take children to school or other afternoon activities and pick them up.
- Cooking simple recipes for children
- Keep the children's room tidy and clean.
- Washing and ironing children's clothes
- Putting the children to bed
- Help children with their personal hygiene (brushing teeth, changing diapers etc.)
- Occasionally buy supplies
- Loading and emptying the dishwasher.

## WHAT YOU WILL GET:

- 320-400 euros per month
- The Au Pair should have at least one free day per week and at least once a month the free day should be a Sunday. There is no official legislation regarding the holidays of the participants in Italy, but we usually recommend at least 2 free weeks for 12 months Au Pair stay.
- The Au Pair in Italy can enrol in a language course. The daily work program should allow the candidate to spend a few hours studying the Italian language.
- Your own room
- Meals included
- Cultural experience of a lifetime
