What Is an Au-Pair?

An Au-Pair is not just a babysitter – you're a cultural ambassador!

It is a young adult between age 18-26 years, who travels to the united states on a J-1 visitor exchange Visa to provide childcare in exchange for the experience to live with and become part of an American family. Au pairs provide their host families with childcare, up to 45 hours a week, and help with child related household duties, transporting children to school and activities.

Our partners is a US Department of State Designated Au Pair Program, promotes educational and cultural exchange between nations through our inter-cultural au-pair program. Our program provides American families with live-in childcare and allows our au pairs to experience American education, life, and culture in an affordable international education program.



Who Can Apply?

You must be:

- ☑ Be Between 18 and 26 years old
- ☑ Be proficient in English
- ☑ Background Check (no criminal record)
- ☑ Minimum 3 Non-family references with 500 hours
- ☑ Be willing to commit for 12 months in the U.S
- ☑ Be a non-smoker
- ☑ Specify if you can look after special needs children
- ☑ Have a minimum of B1-level English
- ✓ Valid Driver's License
- ☑ Matric certificate or higher
- ✓ Valid passport
- ☑ Be in good health

- ♦ 1.5 consecutive days off per week

- ♦ 2 Weeks paid vacation after 12 months of completing program
- ♦ Your own personal room & meals
- ♦ Weekly stipend of \$146.81-\$265.00

Your Responsibilities?

- ♦ Working 45 hours a week with maximum 10 hours per day
- ♦ Childcare duties (walk/drive the children to school, straighten their rooms, do their laundry, prepare meals)
- ◆ Undertake development activities such as playing games, drawing, or helping with homework
