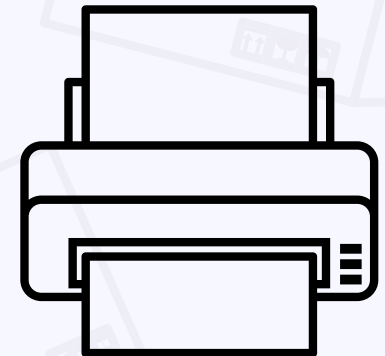
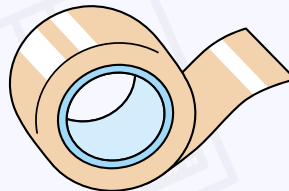

SUPPLIES NEEDED



- Computer or Phone (computer preferred)
- Printer (color preferred but not necessary)
- Free USPS Shipping Boxes, Mailers, & Labels
 - Priority Mail (Express) boxes or mailers
 - PS Form 3811 Return Receipt (optional)
 - Priority Mail Express Label 11-B
- 1" x 2-5/8" White Shipping Labels (AVERY 8160)
- Packaging Tape (if shipping a USPS Box)
- Blue Pen





LABEL SETUP [postage area]



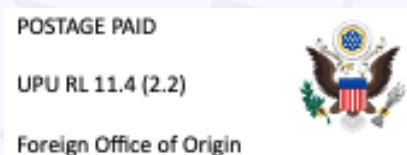
- Every package you ship will require 3 labels applied in the postage area
 - Label A depends on the service you are using (Express or Priority)
 - Label B & C do not change & go on every shipment
 - Click on the link to download each label template

ADDRESS FORMATTING & PLACEMENT



FORMAT THE DELIVERY ADDRESS PROPERLY

- USE ALL UPPERCASE LETTERS. ELIMINATE PUNCTUATION.
 - EXAMPLE:

JOHN SMITH
123 MAIN ST
ANYTOWN NY 12345
USA



ADDRESS FORMATTING & PLACEMENT



ADD NON-DOMESTIC & "WITHOUT THE UNITED STATES" TO THE RETURN ADDRESS / ORIGIN ADDRESS

- THIS ENSURES YOUR LETTER QUALIFIES AS AN INTERNATIONAL MAIL ITEM, TRIGGERING USPS ROUTING GUIDELINES FROM IMM 742.1.

HOW IT'S USED:

- COMPLETE LABEL 11-B WITH THE DELIVERY AND RETURN ADDRESS FORMAT TAUGHT IN THIS EBOOK.
- YOU APPLY LABEL 11-B TO YOUR EXPRESS MAIL ENVELOPE OR PACKAGE TO VISUALLY INDICATE THE MAIL CLASS
- IN A PREPAID SYSTEM, THIS LABEL DOES NOT REPLACE POSTAGE BUT SUPPORTS ROUTING AND VISIBILITY
- THE EXPRESS MAIL # WILL ACT AS YOUR TRACKING #

FORM 3811 RETURN RECEIPT (optional)



FORM 3811 IS USED WHEN YOU WANT PROOF THAT YOUR PACKAGE OR MAIL PIECE WAS DELIVERED. ONCE THE ITEM IS DELIVERED, THE RECIPIENT SIGNS THE CARD AND USPS MAILS IT BACK TO YOU AS OFFICIAL CONFIRMATION.

IT'S OPTIONAL, BUT USEFUL WHEN YOU WANT TO VERIFY THAT SOMETHING IMPORTANT ARRIVED — SUCH AS LEGAL DOCUMENTS OR HIGH-VALUE MAIL.

✶ WHEN TO USE IT:

- YOU'RE SENDING SOMETHING THAT REQUIRES PROOF OF DELIVERY YOU WANT THE RECIPIENT'S SIGNATURE MAILED BACK TO YOU
 - OFTEN USED WITH: CERTIFIED MAIL, REGISTERED MAIL, OR PREPAID PACKAGES WITH LEGAL INTENT

PACKAGE EXAMPLES

- **Priority**

- Priority flat rate boxes have TO / FROM printed on the box. You can neatly hand write the address's or print labels and affix them to the box
- Affix label A, B, and C in the postage area of the box





DROP OFF INSTRUCTIONS



- Place mailer in USPS blue dropbox/mailbox
- Place boxes in USPS Package drop barrel located in the foyer of your local Post Office
- Do not hand it directly to a clerk. The return address & prepaid labels initiates routing without triggering postage validation.





How It Works: Legal Basis for Prepaid Package Shipping



This prepaid method works by leveraging existing USPS guidelines and international mail policies that allow certain types of mail to be treated as postage paid, even without traditional stamps or online postage.

One key source supporting this is the USPS International Mail Manual (IMM) Section 742, which explains how to handle mail pieces that do not have postage stamps affixed.

IMM 742 Key Points:

- Mail items marked with terms like "Postage Paid," "Service des Postes," or "Taxe Percue" are to be treated as prepaid.
- Parcels arriving from foreign postal systems without visible stamps are also considered prepaid by default.
- The manual instructs postal clerks to process these items without requiring additional postage, as long as the proper markings are used.

Why This Is Lawful:



This method relies on existing international postal agreements and USPS internal procedures — not loopholes. It follows documented policies that USPS clerks are trained to follow, particularly for items marked and routed using authorized language like:

- POSTAGE PAID
- Without the UNITED STATES
- NON-DOMESTIC
- And including proper label formats

✉ Your Role:

By following the instructions and using the correct formatting, labels, and drop-off practices described in this eBook, you are simply choosing to operate within a legal mail classification that has existed for decades — but is rarely used by the public.
