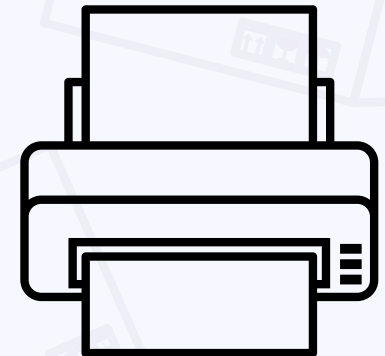
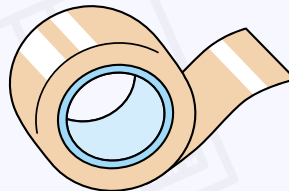

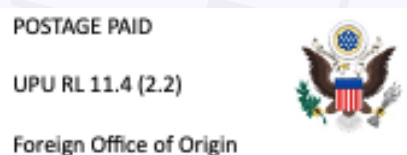

FORMAT THE DELIVERY ADDRESS PROPERLY

- USE ALL UPPERCASE LETTERS. ELIMINATE PUNCTUATION.
 - EXAMPLE:

JOHN SMITH
123 MAIN ST
ANYTOWN NY 12345

ADDRESS FORMATTING (RETURN)



RETURN ADDRESS FORMAT:

- JOHN DOE
 - YOUR NAME IN UPPER CASE (OR FIRST MIDDLE LAST IF PREFERRED)
- C/O: 123 MAIN STREET
 - "CARE OF" ESTABLISHES YOU'RE RECEIVING MAIL AT THIS LOCATION BUT NOT ASSERTING FEDERAL RESIDENCE
- REPUBLIC OF ILLINOIS [ZIP]

FORM 3811 IS USED WHEN YOU WANT PROOF THAT YOUR PACKAGE OR MAIL PIECE WAS DELIVERED. ONCE THE ITEM IS DELIVERED, THE RECIPIENT SIGNS THE CARD AND USPS MAILS IT BACK TO YOU AS OFFICIAL CONFIRMATION.

IT'S OPTIONAL, BUT USEFUL WHEN YOU WANT TO VERIFY THAT SOMETHING IMPORTANT ARRIVED — SUCH AS LEGAL DOCUMENTS OR HIGH-VALUE MAIL.

- **Priority**

- Priority flat rate boxes have TO / FROM printed on the box. You can neatly hand write the address's or print labels and affix them to the box
- Affix label A, B, and C in the postage area of the box





DROP OFF INSTRUCTIONS



Once you've properly prepared your mailpiece using the steps in this guide, it's time to drop it off. But don't head to the USPS counter just yet — here's why.

✓ The Best Way to Send It:

- Place your mail directly into a USPS blue collection box, lobby mail slot, or foyer drop bin — NOT at the service counter.

This method is fully compliant with USPS policy and IMM 742 guidelines.

However, most USPS clerks are not familiar with this process, and bringing it to the counter may lead to unnecessary confusion or rejection.

📋 Why Not the Counter?

- Your item is being sent as prepaid, non-domestic, and without the UNITED STATES
- Counter staff are trained only on domestic, commercial postage procedures
- Your mailing uses international routing protocols the front desk is not trained to process



DROP OFF INSTRUCTIONS


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What to Do Instead:

-  Use a blue USPS collection box
-  Use an inside lobby slot
-  Use a secure foyer drop bin at your local USPS branch

Do Not:

-  Attempt to purchase postage at the counter
-  Ask USPS staff to "accept" or "verify" the item
-  Let them remove your tracking label or add stamps

By mailing it directly through the collection system, you bypass the commercial interface and engage USPS at the processing level, which is bound by the IMM to treat your mail as prepaid when properly labeled and formatted.

You are not breaking the law. You are asserting your lawful right to use the mail as a private American — outside of the federal corporate system.

TRACK YOUR ITEM VIA USPS.COM

- Use your registered or certified mail # as your tracking number to get updates on location and delivery confirmation!



HOW IT WORKS: LEGAL BASIS FOR PREPAID PACKAGE SHIPPING



This prepaid method works by leveraging existing USPS guidelines and international mail policies that allow certain types of mail to be treated as postage paid, even without traditional stamps or online postage.

One key source supporting this is the USPS International Mail Manual (IMM) Section 742, which explains how to handle mail pieces that do not have postage stamps affixed.

IMM 742 Key Points:

- Mail items marked with terms like "Postage Paid," "Service des Postes," or "Taxe Percue" are to be treated as prepaid.
- Parcels arriving from foreign postal systems without visible stamps are also considered prepaid by default.
- The manual instructs postal clerks to process these items without requiring additional postage, as long as the proper markings are used.

WHY THIS IS LAWFUL:



This method relies on existing international postal agreements and USPS internal procedures — not loopholes. It follows documented policies that USPS clerks are trained to follow, particularly for items marked and routed using authorized language like:

- POSTAGE PAID
- Without the UNITED STATES
- NON-DOMESTIC
- And including proper label formats

✉ Your Role:

By following the instructions and using the correct formatting, labels, and drop-off practices described in this eBook, you are simply choosing to operate within a legal mail classification that has existed for decades — but is rarely used by the public.
