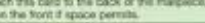

FORM 3811 IS USED WHEN YOU WANT PROOF THAT YOUR PACKAGE OR MAIL PIECE WAS DELIVERED. ONCE THE ITEM IS DELIVERED, THE RECIPIENT SIGNS THE CARD AND USPS MAILS IT BACK TO YOU AS OFFICIAL CONFIRMATION.

IT'S OPTIONAL, BUT USEFUL WHEN YOU WANT TO VERIFY THAT SOMETHING IMPORTANT ARRIVED — SUCH AS **LEGAL DOCUMENTS OR HIGH-VALUE MAIL**.

HOW TO DROP OFF YOUR CERTIFIED/REGISTERED MAIL PIECE



ONCE YOU'VE PROPERLY PREPARED YOUR MAIL-PIECE USING THE STEPS IN THIS GUIDE, IT'S TIME TO DROP IT OFF. BUT DON'T HEAD TO THE USPS COUNTER JUST YET — HERE'S WHY.

✓ THE BEST WAY TO SEND IT:

PLACE YOUR MAIL DIRECTLY INTO A USPS BLUE COLLECTION BOX, LOBBY MAIL SLOT, OR FOYER DROP BIN — NOT AT THE SERVICE COUNTER.

THIS METHOD IS FULLY COMPLIANT WITH USPS POLICY AND IMM 742 GUIDELINES. HOWEVER, MOST USPS CLERKS ARE NOT FAMILIAR WITH THIS PROCESS, AND BRINGING IT TO THE COUNTER MAY LEAD TO UNNECESSARY CONFUSION OR REJECTION.

📄 WHY NOT THE COUNTER?

- YOUR ITEM IS BEING SENT AS PREPAID, NON-DOMESTIC, AND WITHOUT THE UNITED STATES
- COUNTER STAFF ARE TRAINED ONLY ON DOMESTIC, COMMERCIAL POSTAGE PROCEDURES
- YOUR MAILING USES INTERNATIONAL ROUTING PROTOCOLS THE FRONT DESK IS NOT TRAINED TO PROCESS





HOW TO DROP OFF YOUR CERTIFIED/REGISTERED MAIL PIECE



WHAT TO DO INSTEAD:

- ☒ USE A BLUE USPS COLLECTION BOX
- ☒ USE AN INSIDE LOBBY SLOT
- ☒ USE A SECURE FOYER DROP BIN AT YOUR LOCAL USPS BRANCH

DO NOT:

- ☒ ATTEMPT TO PURCHASE POSTAGE AT THE COUNTER
- ☒ ASK USPS STAFF TO "ACCEPT" OR "VERIFY" THE ITEM
- ☒ LET THEM REMOVE YOUR TRACKING LABEL OR ADD STAMPS

BY MAILING IT DIRECTLY THROUGH THE COLLECTION SYSTEM, YOU BYPASS THE COMMERCIAL INTERFACE AND ENGAGE USPS AT THE PROCESSING LEVEL, WHICH IS BOUND BY THE IMM TO TREAT YOUR MAIL AS PREPAID WHEN PROPERLY LABELED AND FORMATTED.

YOU ARE NOT BREAKING THE LAW. YOU ARE ASSERTING YOUR LAWFUL RIGHT TO USE THE MAIL AS A PRIVATE AMERICAN — OUTSIDE OF THE FEDERAL CORPORATE SYSTEM.

HOW IT WORKS: Legal Basis for Prepaid Certified & Registered Mail



WHY THIS WORKS

THE FOUNDATION FOR THIS METHOD COMES DIRECTLY FROM THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE'S OWN REGULATIONS, SPECIFICALLY THE INTERNATIONAL MAIL MANUAL (IMM) SECTION 742. THESE GUIDELINES OUTLINE HOW MAIL MAY BE TREATED AS PREPAID – EVEN WITHOUT TRADITIONAL POSTAGE STAMPS – WHEN PROPERLY MARKED AND ROUTED.

IMM 742.1 – MARKING:

“SOME ITEMS OF FOREIGN ORIGIN DO NOT BEAR POSTAGE STAMPS, BUT INSTEAD ARE MARKED ‘POSTAGE PAID,’ ‘SERVICE DES POSTES,’ ‘PORT PAYÉ,’ OR ‘WITHOUT THE UNITED STATES.’ TREAT THIS MAIL AS PREPAID.”

IMM 742.2 – PARCELS WITHOUT STAMPS:

“SOME FOREIGN POST OFFICES DO NOT PUT POSTAGE STAMPS ON PARCELS. ALL SUCH PARCELS RECEIVED MUST BE REGARDED AS PREPAID.”

YOUR CERTIFIED OR REGISTERED MAILPIECE BECOMES LAWFUL PREPAID MAIL WHEN:

- YOU MARK IT NON-DOMESTIC
- ADD “WITHOUT THE UNITED STATES” TO ESTABLISH IT’S OUTSIDE FEDERAL JURISDICTION
- USE USPS-AUTHORIZED TRACKING LABELS (LABEL 3800 FOR CERTIFIED MAIL, LABEL 200 FOR REGISTERED MAIL)
- FORMAT YOUR RETURN ADDRESS USING “REPUBLIC OF [STATE]” WITH BRACKETED ZIP CODE

THIS METHODOLOGY ALIGNS WITH USPS POLICY, INTERNATIONAL POSTAL LAW, AND COMMON LAW MAILING RIGHTS. YOU'RE NOT EVADING POSTAGE – YOU'RE OPERATING OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE FEDERAL POSTAL JURISDICTION AND CHOOSING TO ROUTE YOUR MAIL THROUGH INTERNATIONAL PROTOCOL AS A PRIVATE AMERICAN.

 THE USPS IS BOUND BY TREATY AND POLICY TO PROCESS PROPERLY FORMATTED PREPAID MAIL – AND THAT INCLUDES CERTIFIED AND REGISTERED SERVICES.
