Students stop working and listen carefully to their teachers. (28)

Teachers guide classes to stand quietly beside their desks. (37)

When told to move, students walk calmly toward the nearest exit. (48)

They follow their class line and keep space between each person. (59)

Outside, students gather at a safe meeting place together. (68)

Teachers check names to make sure everyone is present. (77)

Students wait quietly until teachers give new instructions. (85)

Fire drills help students learn how to stay safe. (93)

Practising these steps makes safety routines easier. (100)
