Once you have this list and your Qualifier Profile is set up, it will allow you to skip every low-paying platform and go directly to the corporate research panels that pay \$100-\$500 per session. When you use this list starting today, you'll be able to make your first \$50-\$100 in your first real session.

TIER 1: \$200-\$500 Per Session -- Elite Research Panels

- * Respondent.io (respondent.io) -- \$50-\$700 per study. Business and professional research for enterprise companies. Fast payments via PayPal within 24-48 hours of study completion. Best single platform for maximum per-session earnings.
- * User Interviews (userinterviews.com) -- \$50-\$250 per session. Consumer and product research for tech companies. 30-60 minute video calls. Payments within 48 hours. Start here first.
- * M3 Global Research (m3globalresearch.com) -- \$100-\$500 per study. Medical opinion research platform. Highest payouts available if you have healthcare background or specific patient experience.
- * Rare Patient Voice (rarepatientvoice.com) -- \$100-\$200 per study. Research for people with chronic or rare medical conditions. Highly specialized and consistently high paying.
- * Schlesinger Group (schlesingergroup.com) -- \$75-\$300 per session. Major market research firm running studies for pharmaceutical, financial, and CPG companies. Both in-person and virtual.
- * Fieldwork (fieldwork.com) -- \$75-\$200 per session. Specialty in healthcare, retail, and automotive research. Register your full profile for direct invitations.
- * OmniCare Research -- \$100-\$400 per study. Business-to-business research. Best for respondents with professional work backgrounds.
- * Kantar TNS -- Enterprise-level research network. \$75-\$250 per session. Register directly on their respondent portal.
- * Ipsos MORI (ipsos.com) -- Top-tier global research firm. Studies paying \$50-\$200. Register on their respondent portal for invitations.
- * C Space -- Community-based research for major consumer brands. Ongoing panel membership with regular paid research activities.

TIER 2: \$50-\$150 Per Survey -- High-Frequency Research Networks

- * Focusgroup.com -- Best aggregator for \$75-\$300 focus groups nationwide. Filter by compensation. Apply to everything over \$100. Check daily for new listings.
- * FindFocusGroups.com -- Searchable database of current paid focus group openings. Update your profile fully to receive direct invitations.
- * Probe Market Research -- \$75-\$200 per session. Specializes in automotive, CPG, and retail research.
- * Mindswarms -- Video survey platform. Pays \$50 per 10-minute video response. Quick turnaround and fast PayPal payments.
- * What Users Do (whatusersdo.com) -- UX research platform. \$30-\$60 per usability test. 20-30 minute sessions.
- * Validately -- UX and design research. \$50-\$90 per session. Matches you with companies testing new products.
- * UserTesting.com -- \$10-\$60 per test. Website and app usability testing. Quick sessions and fast PayPal payment within 7 days.
- * Dscout -- Research missions from major consumer brands. \$5-\$50 per mission. Ongoing relationship-based research.
- * Pinecone Research -- Invite-only consumer panel. Consistent payouts with high survey availability once you're in.
- * Ipsos i-Say -- Mid-tier panel with better payouts than standard consumer platforms. Good for daily volume stacking.
- * Toluna Influencers -- Upgraded Toluna panel. Product testing and community research pays more than standard surveys.
- * SurveySavvy (surveysavvy.com) -- \$1-\$5 per survey plus passive income component. Reliable payments and good survey volume.
- * American Consumer Opinion -- \$1-\$5 per survey. Long-running panel with consistent daily survey availability.
- * Vindale Research -- Variable payout including occasional high-dollar studies mixed in with standard surveys.

TIER 3: Stacking Platforms -- Use to Fill Gaps Between Premium Sessions

These platforms don't pay premium rates but they have high survey volume and fast payout options. Use them only to fill in time between premium sessions and boost your daily total.

- * ySense (ysense.com) -- \$10 minimum PayPal payout. Frequently available surveys. Good for quick first payments.
- * YouGov -- Opinion research panel. Lower pay but frequent surveys on current events and consumer products.
- * InboxDollars -- Mix of surveys and other earning methods. Good for diversification during slow premium periods.
- * Survey Club -- Aggregator of multiple survey networks. Mix of standard and occasional premium studies.

STRATEGY: Spend 80% of your daily time on Tier 1 and Tier 2 platforms. Use Tier 3 only to fill gaps. A mix of 1-2 premium sessions per week plus daily Tier 2 surveys puts you at \$50-\$100 every single day with the 15-minute system.

Passive Income Platforms -- Set Up Once, Earn Forever

- * Nielsen Computer and Mobile Panel (nielseniq.com) -- \$50 per device per year. Install on phone, tablet, computer. Zero daily effort. Pays passively.
- * MobileXpression -- Install on smartphone. Monthly PayPal payments from passive background data collection.
- * Surveys On The Go (surveysonthego.com) -- Push notification surveys. \$1-\$3 each, paid instantly to PayPal. Fastest payout in the passive space.
- * SurveySavvy Connect -- Background internet app. Monthly passive income added to your SurveySavvy balance.
- * Perk TV -- Watch videos passively while doing other things. Points convert to PayPal cash.

Once you're registered on 5-7 platforms from Tier 1 and 2 above, with your Qualifier Profile complete and your passive stack running -- you have a full daily income machine operating. Premium invitations come to you. Daily surveys fill the gaps. Passive apps run in the background. The money comes from multiple directions simultaneously.
