

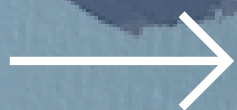

SUPPLIES

Keep it simple.

Use what you already have.

You'll Need:

- Watercolor paper (cold press preferred)
- Watercolor paints (basic set is perfect)
- 1–2 round brushes (size 2–10 ideal)
- A jar of clean water
- Paper towel or cloth
- Pencil

***It's not about the fanciest supplies.
It's about learning how to use them.***



CREATE YOUR PAINTING SPACE

Choose a spot where you can paint for 20–30 minutes.

You might:

- Play soft music
- Make tea or coffee
- Sit near a window
- Light a candle
- Paint outside

Remove distractions.

This is your time.

Even 20 focused minutes can change how you feel about painting.



WHAT TO EXPECT EACH DAY

Each day you'll receive:

- ✓ A clear step-by-step video
- ✓ Water control guidance
- ✓ Layering demonstrations
- ✓ Tips to avoid muddy colors
- ✓ A confidence boost

We'll focus on:

- Creating smooth washes
- Understanding paint consistency
- Building depth in simple ways
- Letting go of overworking
- Painting water without fear

*By Day 5, you'll think:
"Wait... I painted that?"*
