Prompt #1:

“Explain This to Me Like I’m Brand New”

This is the **most important prompt** in this entire kit.

- learning AI tools

The Prompt

“Act as a patient teacher.

Explain [INSERT TOPIC] to me like I am brand new and have zero experience.

Use simple language.

Avoid jargon.

Use clear examples.

Explain:

1. \ What it is
2. \ Why it matters
3. \ How it works (at a beginner level)
4. \ What I should focus on first

3 Why This Prompt Works

Most people quit because they jump too far ahead.

- This prompt:
 - removes confusion
 - slows things down
 - builds confidence
 - gives you a solid foundation

💡 Pro Tip (Optional)

If the explanation still feels confusing, reply to AI with:

“*Explain this even simpler, using everyday examples.*”

You don’t need to master AI today.

You just need a **starting point.**



Prompt #2: “Create This For Me”

This prompt is for when you know what you want, but you don't want to start from a blank page.

If you've ever thought:

- “I don't know how to word this”
- “I don't know *where to start*”
- “I know what *I want*, but not how to write it.

This prompt is for you,

It helps AI do the heavy lifting, while you stay in control.

How to Use It

- 1 Decide what you want created
- 2 Fill in the brackets
- 3 Paste it into AI
- 4 Review the output
- 5 Adjust or refine if needed

Things You Can Create With This Prompt

- Social media posts
- Emails
- Simple sales pages
- Lead magnet ideas
- Video scripts
- Product descriptions
- About-me sections

Why This Prompt Works

Most beginners get stuck because they:

- overthink
- doubt themselves
- wait for “perfect”

The Prompt

“Act as an expert in [INSERT SKILL OR ROLE].

Create [INSERT WHAT YOU WANT CREATED] for [INSERT TARGET AUDIENCE].

The goal of this is [INSERT GOAL].

Use a [INSERT TONE] tone.

Keep it clear, simple, and beginner-friendly.

Ask me any questions you need before finalizing.



💡 Pro Tip (Optional)

If the output feels close but not quite right, reply with:

“ **Rewrite this to be simpler and more conversational.**”

AI Improves fast when you guide it.

Key Reminder

- You are not cheating.
- You are not “doing it wrong.”

You are using a tool the way it was meant to.

Prompt #3: “Fix What I Already Have”

This prompt is for when you’ve **already started...**
but what you created doesn’t feel quite right.

Maybe it’s:

- confusing
- messy
- too long
- too generic
- or just “off”

Good news:

You **don’t need to throw**
it away and start over.

This prompt helps AI
improve what you already
have.

The Prompt

“Act as an experienced editor and teacher.

I’ve created the following content, but it
needs improvement:

[PASTE YOUR CONTENT HERE]

Please:

- make it clearer
- simplify the language
- remove unnecessary fluff
- keep it beginner-friendly

Do NOT change the meaning.
Just make it easier to understand
and more effective.



How to Use It

- 1 Paste what you’ve already written
- 2 Add the prompt above
- 3 Let AI clean it up
- 4 Review the result
- 5 Keep what you like—change what you don’t

What This Prompt Is So Powerful

Most beginners think:

- “*This is bad—I’m not good at this.*”

But usually, the problem isn’t you.

- structure
- clarity
- and a second pass



Key Reminder

- You don’t get better by starting over.
- You get better by **refining**.

This prompt helps you **do exactly that**.

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Prompt #4: “Give Me Options”

This prompt is for when you feel **stuck choosing**.

You know what you want to do...

but your brain starts spinning with **questions like:**

- “Which one is better?”
- “What angle should I use?”
- “What if I choose the wrong thing?”

This prompt removes that pressure by giving you options to compare.

You don't need to guess anymore.

How to Use It

- 1 Decide what you need options for
- 2 Fill in the brackets
- 3 Paste it into AI
- 4 Review the list
- 5 Pick **one** and move forward

You don't need the “perfect” option.

You just need a **reasonable next step**.

Things You Can Get Options For

- Email media posts

- Headlines

Anytime you feel **stuck choosing**, this prompt helps.

Why This Prompt Works

Indecision feels like thinking—but it's actually avoidance.

“Simplify these options for a complete beginner.”

Simple options lead to faster action.

The Prompt

“Act as a creative assistant and strategist.

I need options for [INSERT WHAT YOU'RE WORKING ON].

Please give me [INSERT NUMBER] different variations or ideas.

Each option should:

- be beginner-friendly
- be clear and simple
- focus on one main idea

After listing the options, briefly explain when each one would be best to use.



Key Reminder

- You don't need to explore every option.
 - Pick one.
 - Test it.
 - Adjust later.
- Momentum beats perfect planning.

Prompt #5:

“What Should I Do Next?”

This prompt is for when you feel **stuck, scattered, or unsure what to focus on.**

You might be thinking:

- “There’s so much I could do...”
- “I don’t know what matters most right now
- “I feel busy but not productive”

This prompt helps you cut through the noise.

How to Use It

- 1 Briefly explain where you are right now
- 2 Be honest—no need to sound impressive
- 3 Paste the prompt into AI
- 4 Read the response
- 5 Do **one thing**, not everything

When to Use This Prompt

- When you feel overwhelmed
- When you’re jumping between ideas,
- When you don’t know what actually matters
- When you’ve learned a lot but haven’t taken action

Things You Can using:

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- When you’re jumping between ideas.
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The Prompt

“Act as a clear, practical guide.

Here is my current situation:

[DESCRIBE WHAT YOU’VE DONE SO FAR]

My goal is:

[INSERT YOUR GOAL]

Based on this, tell me:

1. What I should focus on next
2. What I should ignore for now
3. The single most important action I can take today

Keep the advice beginner-friendly and realistic.



💡 Pro Tip (Optional)

If the response feels too ambitious, reply with:

- “**Make this even simpler and realistic** for a beginner.”

That’s how momentum is built.

You Don't Need to Master AI Today

If you've made it this far, here's the most important thing to remember:
