Devotional:

Devotional:

The warmth of summer invites us to slow down and enjoy what God has already given.

Gratitude flourishes when we stop chasing and start noticing; sticky hands from melting popsicles, laughter echoing in the yard, prayers that finally bore fruit.

Thankfulness turns ordinary moments into praise.

Poem:

The sunlight spills through open skies,

Devotional:

Fall reminds us that even when life changes, God's goodness does not. Leaves let go not in loss, but in trust, knowing that the tree will bloom again. Sometimes gratitude grows deepest when we thank Him not for what we keep, but for what He helps us release.

Poem:

The colors fade, the breezes sigh,
Yet still Your faithfulness is nigh.

Prayer:

Lord, teach me to be thankful in change.

Devotional:
