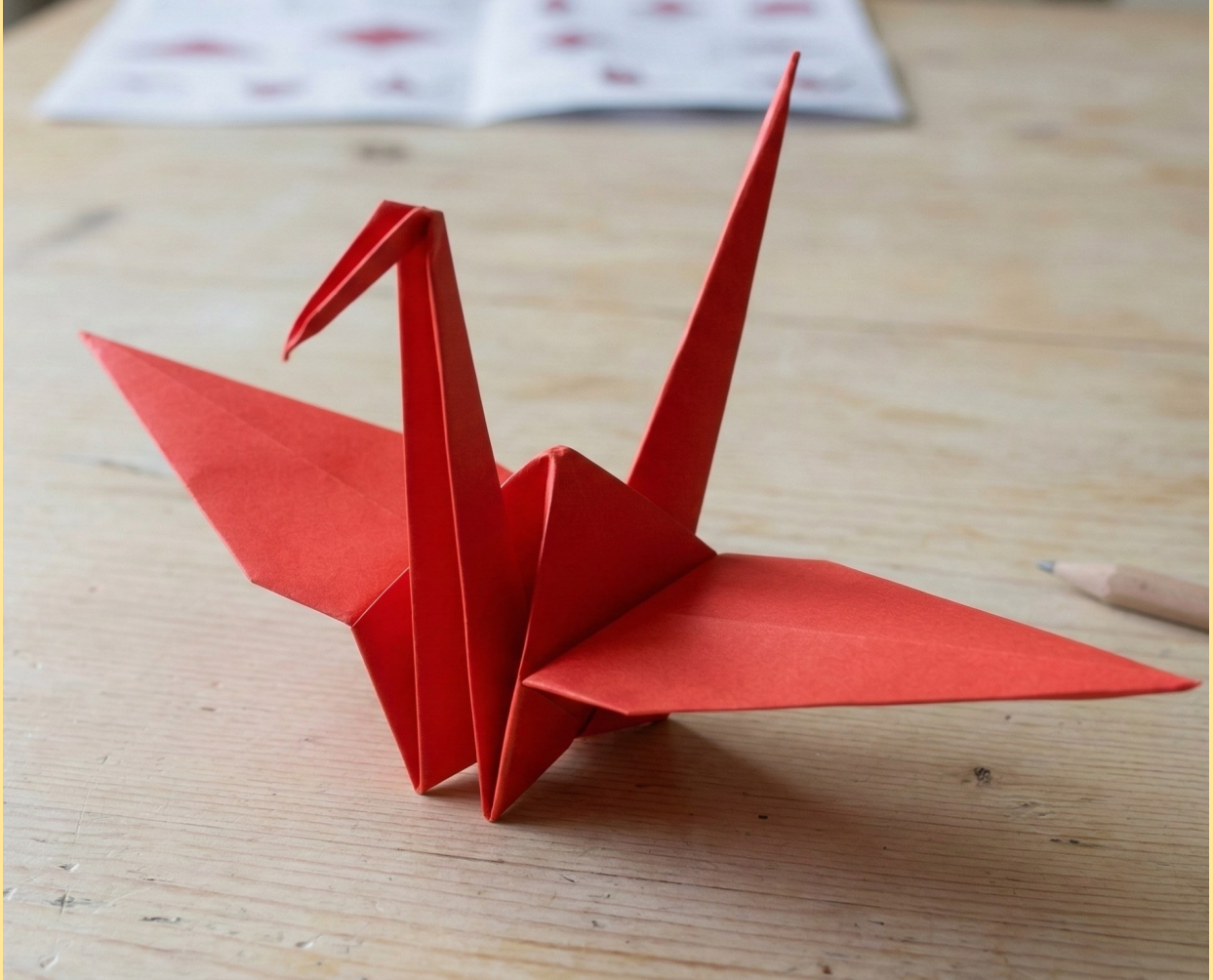

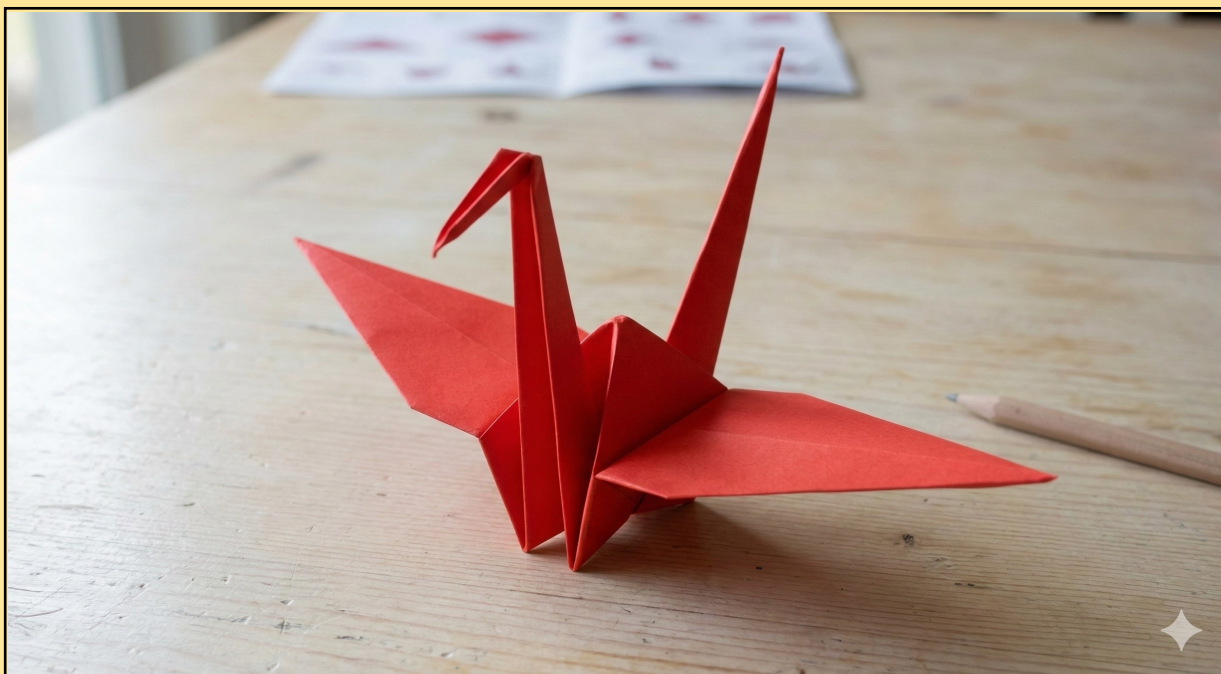
Origami Crane

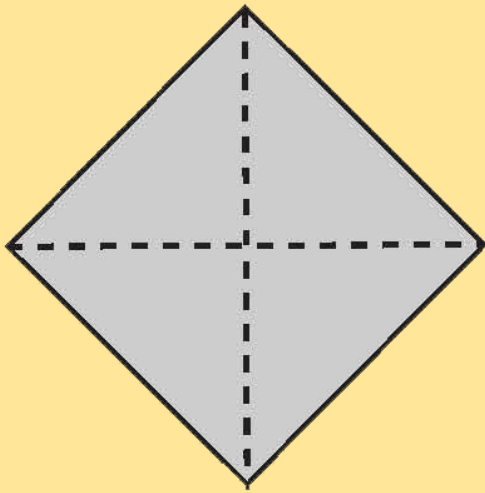

Crane Instructions



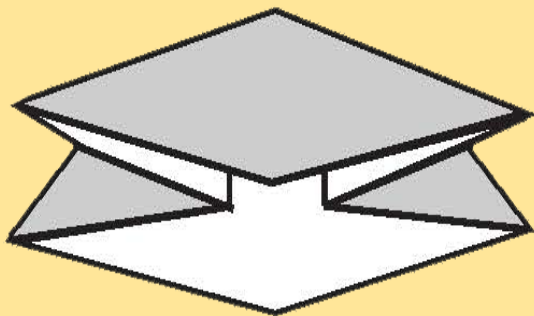
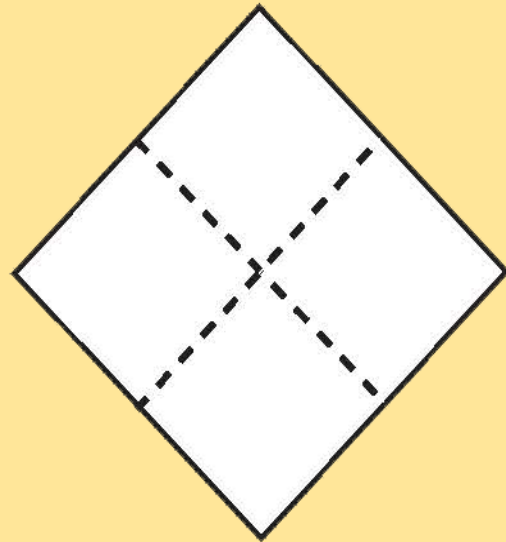
The Foundation



1. **Prepare Your Paper:** Start with a square piece of paper. If it is coloured on one side only, place the coloured side facing up. Fold the paper in half diagonally to form a triangle, unfold it, and repeat with the other corners to create an "X" crease.

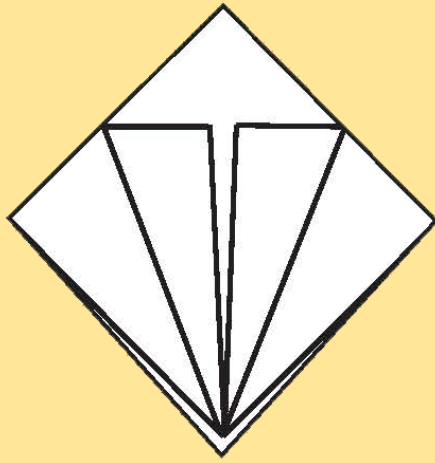

2. **The Reverse Fold:** Flip the paper so the coloured side is now facing down. Fold the paper in half horizontally to form a rectangle, unfold, and repeat vertically.



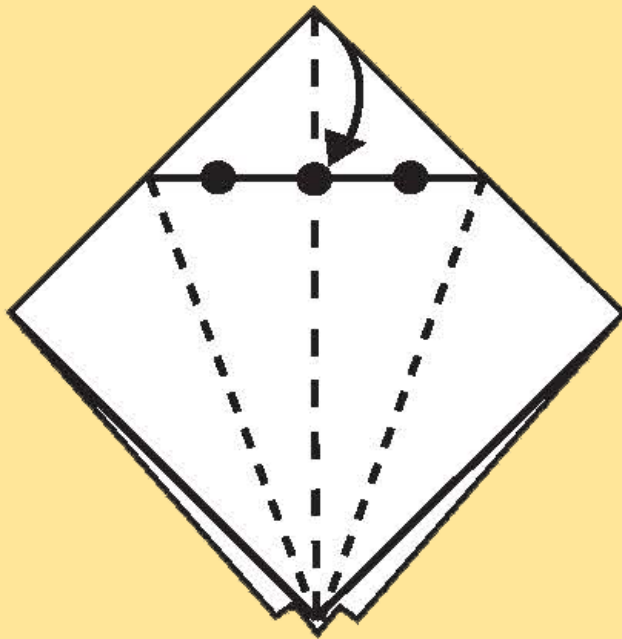
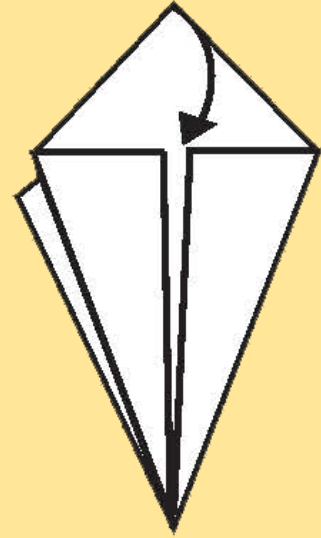
3. **The Square Base:** Fold along all four creases at once to collapse the paper into a small square.

Ensure the open end (the loose corners) is facing towards you.



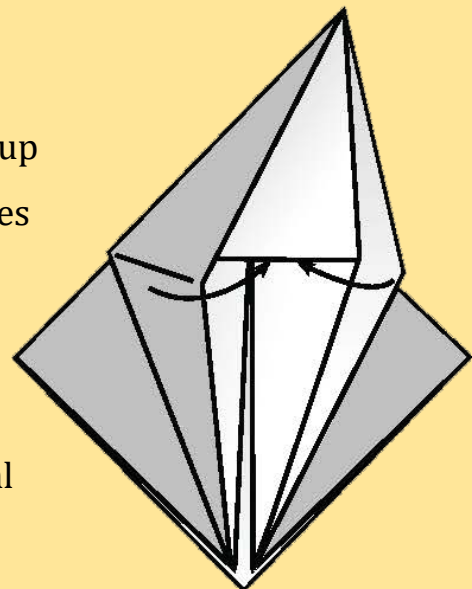
4. Fold two edges in, to form a kite shape on top. Repeat on the other side.

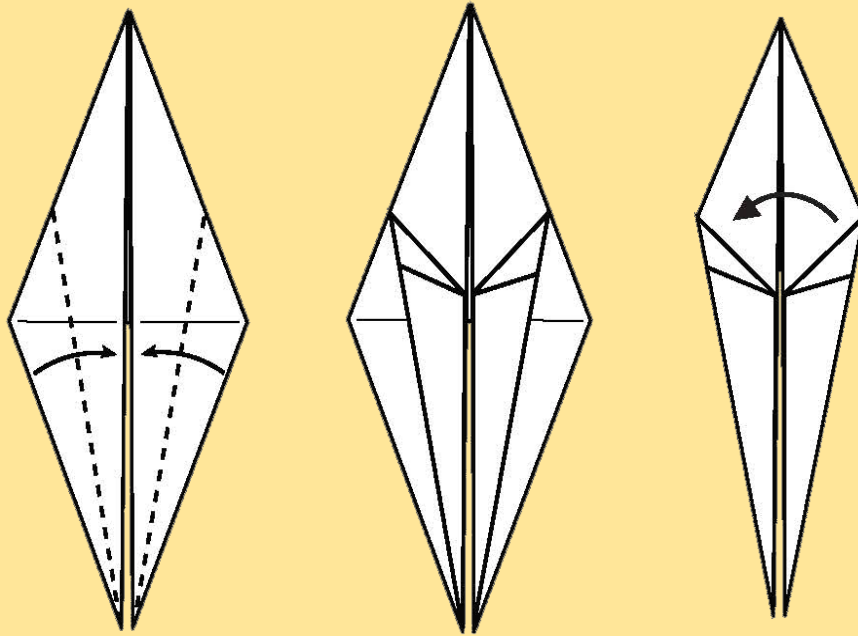
5. Fold the point down and crease above the other two folds. Flip the paper and repeat



6. Pull the bottom corner (top layer only) up above the top corner. Fold along the creases you made. Repeat on the other side.

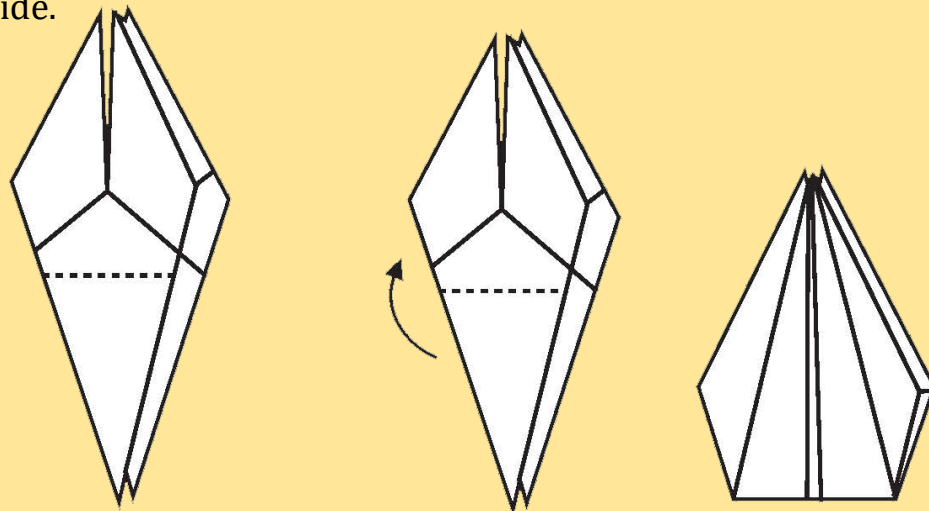
TIP: If in doubt here go back to the tutorial





7. The Body Fold

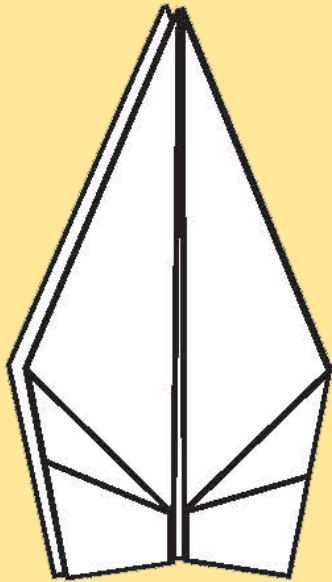
Kite Fold: Fold the two side edges of the top layer inward toward the centre crease to form a kite shape. Flip the paper over and repeat on the other side.



8. Crease the Top: Fold the top triangular point down and crease it firmly above the two side folds. Flip and repeat. **Undo** the folds.

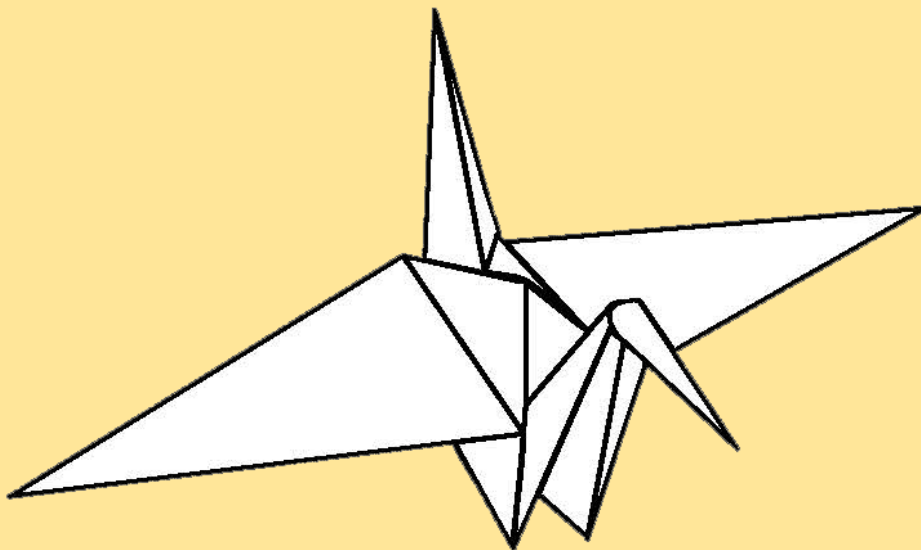
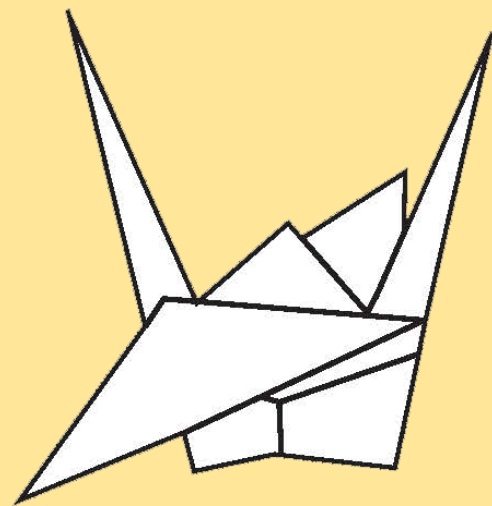
9. The Petal Fold: Lift the bottom corner of the top layer only. Pull it up toward the top corner, folding along the creases you just made in the last step. Flip the paper and repeat on the other side.

10. The Finishing Touches



Reverse the "Book" Fold: Again, take the top layer of the right side and fold it over to the left. Flip the piece and repeat. This hides the "legs" inside.

11. The Head & Body: Bend down the tip of one of the internal points to create the head and beak. To finish, gently pull the wings outward away from each other and push up from the bottom; this will inflate the centre of the body.



And there you go, a beautiful origami crane, well done x
