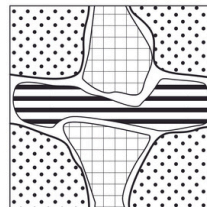

Steps to Creating an Analogue Pattern Repeat:

Print out square template on Watercolour paper (200 gsm or higher) Cut paper into a square and divide square into 4 with light pencil lines.

Step 1. On the back of your square paper, number the corners 1–4. On the front, draw in the centre area only, leaving at least 2 cm clear around all edges.

Step 2. Cut the square vertically down the middle. Swap the left and right sides, tape them together on the back, then fill the new centre area (leave the top and bottom edges blank).

Step 3. Cut the square horizontally across the middle. Swap the top and bottom halves, tape them together on the back, then fill the final blank strip (do not draw off the left and right edges).

✓ **Your repeating tile is now complete!**
