8. NEC Experience

I have managed and administered NEC3 ECC and TSC on site from tender to final account under Options A and B, and NEC3 ECS subcontracts as the Contractor assessing subcontractor quotations. I hold adjudicator appointments under NEC3 ECC Option W1.

That experience concentrates in the areas most often disputed: whether an event was notified in time and whether the Project Manager ought to have notified it; the consequences of a failure to reply in time; the prospective basis of assessment and the dividing date on which a quotation is built; Defined Cost and the Fee under the Shorter Schedule of Cost Components; delay measured against planned Completion on the Accepted Programme, including terminal float, time risk allowances and concurrency; and the Project Manager's own assessment where no programme has been accepted. Under Option A I have dealt with payment for completed activities and revision of the activity schedule, and under Option B with re-rating on a change in quantity.

Having prepared quotations to a Project Manager and assessed them as Contractor under the subcontract, I have seen these questions from both chairs.
