Section 2: Trauma Wounds (Deep Cuts, Gunshots, Severe Bleeding)

Immediate Actions:

Apply **direct pressure**

Use a **tourniquet** if necessary

Pack with **hemostatic gauze** (QuikClot, Celox)

Natural Support:

Yarrow poultice to slow bleeding

Honey to reduce infection risk

Section 3: Burns

Steps:

Cool with clean, cool water (not ice)

Cover with sterile dressing

Avoid breaking blisters

Natural Support:

Aloe vera gel for soothing and healing

Honey as an antimicrobial dressing



Section 4: Bites & Stings

Snakebite:

Immobilize limb

Keep victim calm

Do NOT cut or suck venom

Insect Stings:

Remove stinger

Apply **plantain leaf poultice**

Use **baking soda paste** to neutralize venom



Section 5: Infection Prevention & Management

Wash with **boiled water & soap**

Dress with **clean bandages daily**

Apply **natural antibiotics**: garlic, honey, oregano oil

Watch for **red streaks, pus, fever** = dangerous infection



Section 6: Building a Collapse-Proof Wound Kit

****Essential Gear:****

* Trauma shears

* Sterile gauze & tape

* Tourniquet

* QuikClot/Celox

* Alcohol wipes

****Herbal Additions:****

* Yarrow (bleeding)

* Aloe vera (burns)

* Plantain (bites, stings)

* Honey (infection)
