ALL ABOUT BITCOIN

What is Bitcoin ?




Bitcoin is a type of digital money, also known as a cryptocurrency. It was created in 2009 by an anonymous person or group of people using the name Satoshi Nakamoto. Unlike regular money issued by governments, Bitcoin isn't controlled by any company, bank, or country.

Where is Bitcoin stored?

Bitcoin is stored in something called a digital wallet, which can be an app on your phone, a program on your computer, or a physical device. Your Bitcoin lives on a public network called the blockchain – a digital ledger that records every transaction made.

How can people buy Bitcoin?

You can buy Bitcoin through online platforms called crypto exchanges (like Luno, Binance, or Coinbase) using your local currency like USD or ZAR. Some services even allow you to buy it through mobile money apps and ATMs in certain countries.

A crypto exchange is a website or app where you can buy, sell, and trade cryptocurrencies like Bitcoin, Ethereum, and many others. It works like a digital shop where you can swap your money for different digital coins.

WHAT IS BITCOIN HALVING?

04

Bitcoin halving is an event that happens about every 4 years, where the reward for mining new Bitcoin is cut in half.

Right now:

When miners verify Bitcoin transactions, they get a reward in Bitcoin.

After halving:

That reward is cut in half – so if they were earning 6.25 BTC per block, after the halving it'll drop to 3.125 BTC.

Next halving:

Expected around 2028

WHY DOES BITCOIN HALVING HAPPEN?

Think of it like this:

If there were only 21 golden tickets in the whole world, and people kept wanting them, the price would go up because they're rare. 💎

And every halving makes Bitcoin even rarer.

Quick Facts:

- Max Supply: 21 million Bitcoin
- Circulating Now (2025): About 19.7 million mined

Next Halving: Expected in 2028, reward drops to 3.125 BTC per block

BITCOIN MARKET CYCLE HISTORY

Bitcoin historically follows a 4-year market cycle driven by its halving events.


Here's the typical cycle:

<u>Event</u>	<u>Timing</u>
Halving	Every 4 years (2024, 2028)
Bull Run Starts	Every 6–12 months after halving
Bull Market Peak	12–18 months after halving
Major Dip/Bear	18–24 months after halving
Recovery/Pre-Halving	2–3 years post-halving


Simple Example for Beginners

 Imagine you have a toy store that only restocks a rare superhero toy every 4 years.

 After the new stock arrives (halving), kids get excited, and the toy's price goes up.

 A year later, everyone wants it, and it becomes super expensive (bull run).

 Then, people lose interest, and the price drops (bear market).

 The best time to buy it is when nobody wants it anymore – just before the next restock comes around.

 That's how Bitcoin's price cycles work too!

Bear Market: When Bitcoin's price is falling or expected to fall, showing a general downward trend. 📉🐻

Bull Market: When Bitcoin's price is rising or expected to rise, showing a general upward trend. 📈🐮

🐻 Simple Example for Beginners

Once upon a time in Crypto Forest 🌳, there lived two very different friends – Benny the Bear 🐻 and Billy the Bull 🐮.

Benny the Bear loved to take big naps 🛌 and sometimes got grumpy 😞. When Benny walked through the forest, he accidentally knocked down the fruit trees 🍏🍒, and all the fruits fell to the ground 🍂.

"Uh-oh, the fruit is falling!" said the forest animals 🐿️🐰. That's what happened when Benny came – everything went down, just like Bitcoin's price in a bear market. 📉

But Billy the Bull was full of energy ⚡ and loved to run around 🏃♂️ with his big, strong horns 🐮💪. When Billy charged through the forest, he pushed the trees up higher 🌳📈 and helped the fruits grow bigger and brighter 🍏✨.

"Yay! The fruit is rising!" cheered the animals 🎉🐿️🐰. That's what happened when Billy came – everything went up, just like Bitcoin's price in a bull market. 📈

And so, the forest animals learned that sometimes Benny the Bear would visit, making prices go down 📉, and sometimes Billy the Bull would visit, making prices go up 📈 – and they always stayed ready for either! 🌟

THE POWER OF BITCOIN IN THE CRYPTO MARKET

 Bitcoin's Market Share:

 **Bitcoin typically holds between 38% to 55% of the total crypto market value** at any given time. This percentage is called **Bitcoin Dominance**.

For example:

- In bull markets: Bitcoin dominance may drop as people chase altcoin profits.
-
- In bear markets: Dominance rises as investors pull out of risky coins and consolidate back into Bitcoin.



WHY DOES THE MARKET DROP WHEN BITCOIN DIPS?

 ***Bitcoin is like the big brother of crypto.***

It was the first, and it still commands the largest share of total market value. When Bitcoin's price drops sharply:

- Investor confidence across the whole crypto market drops.
- Traders liquidate alt-coins to cover Bitcoin losses or exit positions altogether.
- Market sentiment turns fearful, triggering mass sell-offs of smaller coins (known as alt-coins).
-

This is why when Bitcoin sneezes 🤧 — the entire crypto market catches a cold.

Good to Know:

- ✓ Bitcoin's price sets the overall trend for the market
- ✓ Major Bitcoin dips = best moments to pick up quality altcoins at bargain prices

PRO TIPS FOR BUYING CRYPTO SMARTLY

- **Watch Bitcoin's Fear & Greed Index:**

Buy when it shows "Extreme Fear" (below 20). You can find this index easily online at alternative.me/crypto/fear-and-greed-index.

- **Use RSI (Relative Strength Index):**

Weekly RSI below 30 often signals a great buying point, indicating Bitcoin is oversold.

- **Look for Market Dips:**

The best times to buy Bitcoin are during dips – when the price falls significantly in a short time. This often happens in bear markets or after negative news events.

- **Accumulate During Bear Markets:**

Best long-term investments happen when nobody's paying attention.

- **Take Advantage of Halvings:**

6–9 months before and 12–18 months after a halving are strategic times to watch for dips and strong buying opportunities.

 **Pro Tip:**

Always enable 2FA (Two-Factor Authentication) for security  – and never share your passwords!
