

Obsidian Markdown Cheatsheet

Headings

- Markdown: `# Heading 1` Rendered: `# Heading 1`
Tip: Use 1-6 hashes for levels; great for structuring notes.
- Markdown: `## Heading 2` Rendered: `## Heading 2`
Tip: Headings create collapsible sections in Obsidian.

Text Formatting

- Markdown: `**bold text**` Rendered: **bold text**
Tip: Asterisks make text stand out for emphasis.
- Markdown: `*italic text*` Rendered: *italic text*
Tip: Use for subtle highlights like book titles.
- Markdown: `~~strikethrough~~` Rendered: ~~strikethrough~~
Tip: Handy for marking completed tasks.

Lists

- Markdown: `- Bullet point` Rendered: - Bullet point
Tip: Nest with spaces for sub-lists.
- Markdown: `1. Numbered item` Rendered: 1. Numbered item
Tip: Numbers auto-increment even if you type 1. repeatedly.
- Markdown: `- [] Checkbox` Rendered: - [] Checkbox
Tip: Click in preview to toggle; perfect for to-do lists.

Links

- Markdown: `[Link text](https://example.com)` Rendered: [Link text](https://example.com)
Tip: Use for external references; opens in browser.
- Markdown: `[[Internal note]]` Rendered: [Internal note](#)
Tip: Links to other Obsidian notes; auto-completes.

Images

- Markdown: `![Alt text](image.png)`

Rendered:



Tip: Drag images into notes for easy embedding.

Code

- Markdown: ``inline code`` Rendered: `inline code`

Tip: For short snippets like commands.

- Markdown: ````code block```` Rendered: `code block`

Tip: Add language like ````python` for syntax highlighting.

Other

- Markdown: `> Blockquote` Rendered: `> Blockquote`

Tip: Use for quotes or notes from sources.

- Markdown: `---` Rendered: `---`

Tip: Separates sections visually in long notes.
