Hot Cocoa Mug Cake Recipe

A cozy treat for your family game night!

Ingredients:

- 4 tbsp flour
- 2 tbsp cocoa powder
- 2 tbsp sugar
- 3 tbsp milk
- 1 tbsp vegetable oil
- 1 tbsp chocolate chips
- Whipped cream (optional)



Instructions:

1. Mix all ingredients in a microwave-safe mug.
2. Microwave for 60–90 seconds until fluffy.
3. Let cool slightly, top with whipped cream, and enjoy!

Magic Candy Cane Tip:

Place your mug cake beside your Magic Candy Cane while it cools. Santa says cocoa tastes sweeter when shared with someone you love.
