Atmosphere 1: The Golden Hour Arrival

Atmosphere 3: The Gala Dinner

Elegant, Cinematic, and Timeless. **The Vibe:** High-class sophistication. This is for the sit-down portion of the evening where the music acts as a lush backdrop to a luxury meal.

- *Moon River* — Audrey Hepburn Style
- *La Vie En Rose* — Edith Piaf
- *Make You Feel My Love* — Adele



Atmosphere 4: The High-Fashion Afterparty

High-Energy, Iconic, and Electric. **The Vibe:** The dancefloor is open. These are the "everyone knows the words" anthems, delivered with a premium, high-energy performance.

- *Flowers* — Miley Cyrus
- *About Damn Time* — Lizzo
- *Shut Up and Dance* — Walk The Moon
