Day 22 – Purpose Produces Fruit

Scripture: *“I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in Me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from Me you can do nothing.” – John 15:5*

Reflection:

Your Next Action Steps

4. **Stay connected to God daily.** Continue with prayer, Bible study, and reflection, making them your lifelong habits.
5. **Invite community.** Walk with others who encourage your calling and hold you accountable.

Final Encouragement

Remember, your purpose is not about achieving something spectacular in the world's eyes—it's about being faithful to the One who called you. Even the smallest acts of obedience can have eternal impact.

Bonus

1. Reflection Journal Pages

Instructions for Readers:

- I am strong and courageous, for the Lord is with me. (*Joshua 1:9*)
- I am called to make a difference in the Kingdom. (*Matthew 28:19–20*)

3. Purpose Mapping Worksheet

Step 1 – My Gifts:

- What am I naturally good at?

- What skills have others affirmed in me?

Step 2 – My Passions:

- What activities or causes make me feel alive?

- What breaks my heart and makes me want to act?

Step 3 – My Opportunities:

- Where has God placed me right now (family, work, community)?

- What needs around me could my gifts and passions serve?

Step 4 – My Purpose Statement:

Combine your answers into one or two sentences. Example:

“God has called me to use my gift of encouragement and my passion for teaching to build up others in faith, especially women walking through fear and uncertainty.”
