1. Deep Google Classroom & Workspace Integration

Google Classroom Mobile Tab

Access Gemini directly within the Google Classroom app on iOS and Android. Quickly construct lesson hooks, generate review questions, or address student misconceptions on the go during your prep period or between classes.

Instant Rubric & Assessment Conversion

Convert plain text or Google Docs into structured assignment rubrics and draft actionable, grade-appropriate written feedback directly in Google Docs or Classroom.
