

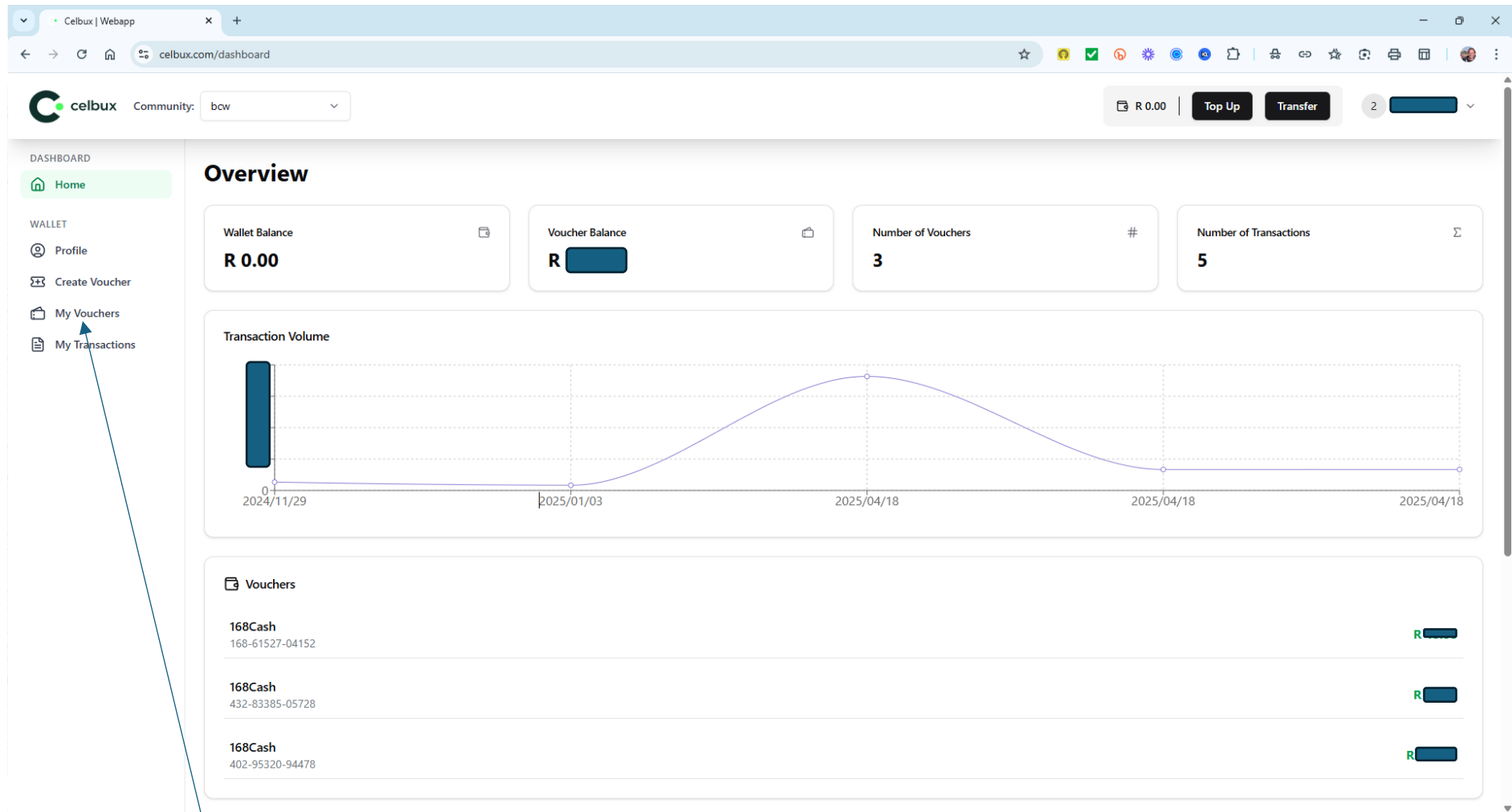

Choose a Voucher starting with 168 and **click on the 3 dots to the right.**

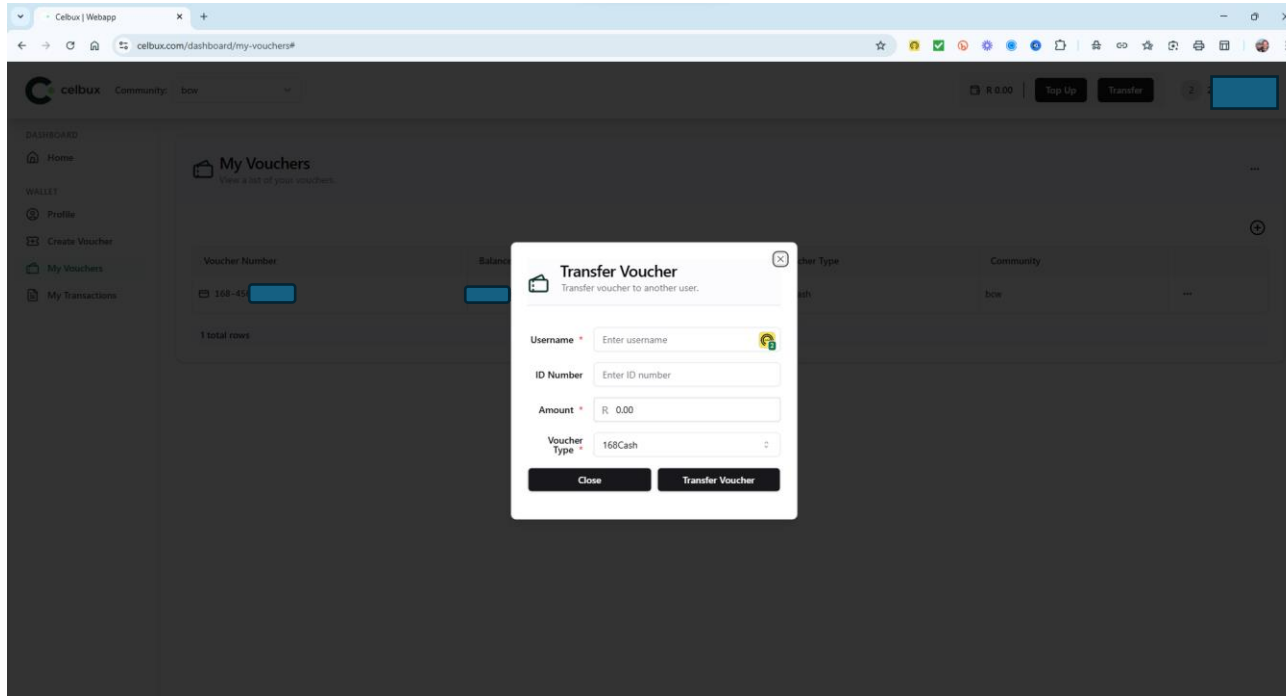



- You **DO NOT** receive an SMS when **YOU do the Transfer**.
- The person who RECEIVES this money will receive an SMS showing the person's name who sent the money, how much was sent, and their new 168 Number.
- **YOU, DOING** the Transfer, need to do **A COLLAPSE** function of the current 168 number in your Wallet in order to receive a **new 168-number via SMS**.

Click on the 3 dots next to your 168-number and click on **“Collapse Voucher”**.


