Kingdom Economy is based on:

- Faith
- Stewardship
- Obedience
- Seedtime & harvest
- Wisdom
- Righteousness
- Purpose

Key Scripture:

“But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.”

— Matthew 6:33 (NKJV)

The Kingdom Economy is not built on chasing money; it is built on **pursuing God**, which positions you for provision, clarity, and supernatural increase.

Many believers don't realize this:

Wealth was God's idea, not man's.

From Genesis to Revelation, God uses wealth as a tool to:

- Build the Kingdom
- Bless others
- Provide for families
- Advance divine assignments
- Break generational cycles

Scripture Proof:

“And the Lord will grant you plenty of goods... and bless all the work of your hand.”

— Deuteronomy 28:11–12

“The blessing of the Lord makes one rich, and He adds no sorrow with it.”

— Proverbs 10:22

Wealth becomes dangerous only when it becomes an idol.

But when wealth is stewarded under God's direction, it becomes a weapon of Kingdom impact.

THE TRUTH ABOUT POVERTY (BIBLICALLY)

Poverty is **not** God's will for His children.

While Scripture teaches compassion for the poor, it does not glorify poverty.

In fact, most poverty in Scripture is tied to:

- Oppression
- Disobedience
- Laziness
- Ignorance
- Mismanagement

Let this truth settle deeply:

There is nothing holy about struggling financially.

God empowers His people to prosper because it allows:

- Generosity
- Influence
- Stability
- Peace
- Advancement of the Gospel

Scripture Proof:

“He raises the poor out of the dust and lifts the needy out of the ash heap.”

— Psalm 113:7

THE POVERTY MINDSET VS. KINGDOM MINDSET

Here are the core mindsets keeping believers stuck:

Poverty Mindset Says:

- ✗ “I shouldn’t have more.”
- ✗ “Money is evil.”
- ✗ “I must stay small.”
- ✗ “God only gives enough to survive.”
- ✗ “Wealth is worldly.”

Kingdom Mindset Says:

- ✓ “I am a steward of God’s resources.”
- ✓ “Wealth can be holy when aligned with purpose.”
- ✓ “God provides seed to the sower.”
- ✓ “My assignment requires resources.”
- ✓ “Increase glorifies God.”

Scripture Proof:

“As a man thinks in his heart, so is he.”

— Proverbs 23:7

Transformation begins with renewing the mind.

5 PILLARS OF THE KINGDOM ECONOMY

1. Stewardship

Managing what God gives wisely.

Luke 16:10

2. Diligence

Hard work, consistency, and excellence.

Proverbs 12:24

3. Wisdom

Seeking God's instructions before making decisions.

James 1:5

4. Seedtime & Harvest

Understanding that giving unlocks multiplication.

2 Corinthians 9:6

5. Purpose & Assignment

Wealth is tied to calling, not greed.

Ephesians 2:10

These pillars form the backbone of biblical increase.

**HOW GOD
MULTIPLIES
WHAT YOU
HAVE**

God always follows this pattern:

Steward → Faith → Action → Multiplication

Examples:

- The widow with the oil
- The five talents
- The feeding of the 5,000
- Peter and the fish with the coin

God cannot multiply what His people refuse to move, use, or steward.

Scripture:

“Give, and it will be given to you... pressed down, shaken together, and running over.”

— Luke 6:38

Multiplication begins when you partner obedience with action.
