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1. Executive Summary

Experience at sea must be described using industry-standard terminology and quantified wherever possible. Generic templates and one-size-fits-all formats fail to convey the specific competencies that yacht recruiters prioritize, resulting in qualified candidates being overlooked despite having the right credentials.

3. Service Overview

4. Methodology

The audit follows a structured three-step process designed to deliver actionable results within three to five business days of receiving the complete CV.
