The Introduction:

So, you're curious about **AI girls**. You've probably seen a few popping up on social media - and honestly, they can be **shockingly convincing**. Even I've been fooled more than once. In this guide, I'll walk you through my full process: from **creating AI models** to **marketing them** and turning them into a **profitable business**. The best part? This space is still wide open, with plenty of room for newcomers. Some AI models - including a few I've built myself - have already pulled in **hundreds of thousands** of followers. The **potential** here is huge.

The wildest part?

Most of these AI girls aren't even that high quality. I'll show you how to create content that looks far more realistic and polished. If you know you can build a stronger, better-looking presence than what's already out there, you're in a perfect spot to turn that into serious money.

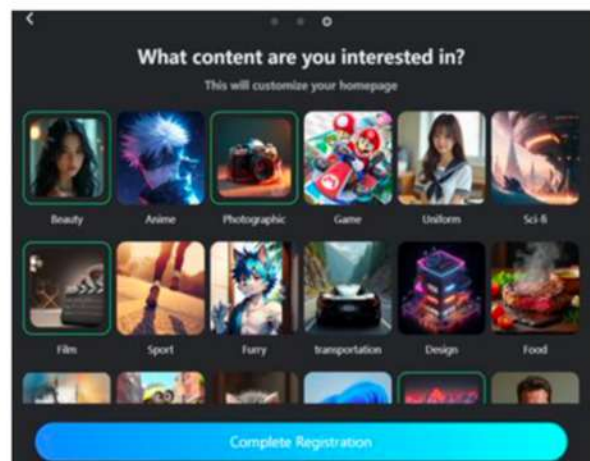
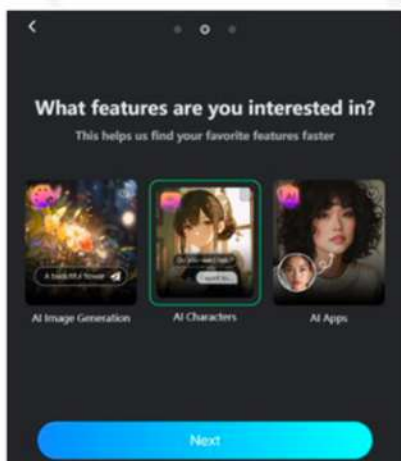
Creating Your AI Model

I use **SeaArt.ai** to create my AI girls. It's a **partially free** platform that gives you 150 credits a day - enough for about **5 to 20 images**. SeaArt is best for building the **base model** of your AI girl, since everything is generated directly by AI. Don't worry if you notice some body deformities in the results - that's normal, and easy to fix later.

Keep in mind: SeaArt is mainly for **still images**. It's not really built for face-swapping, and video generation can get pricey fast.

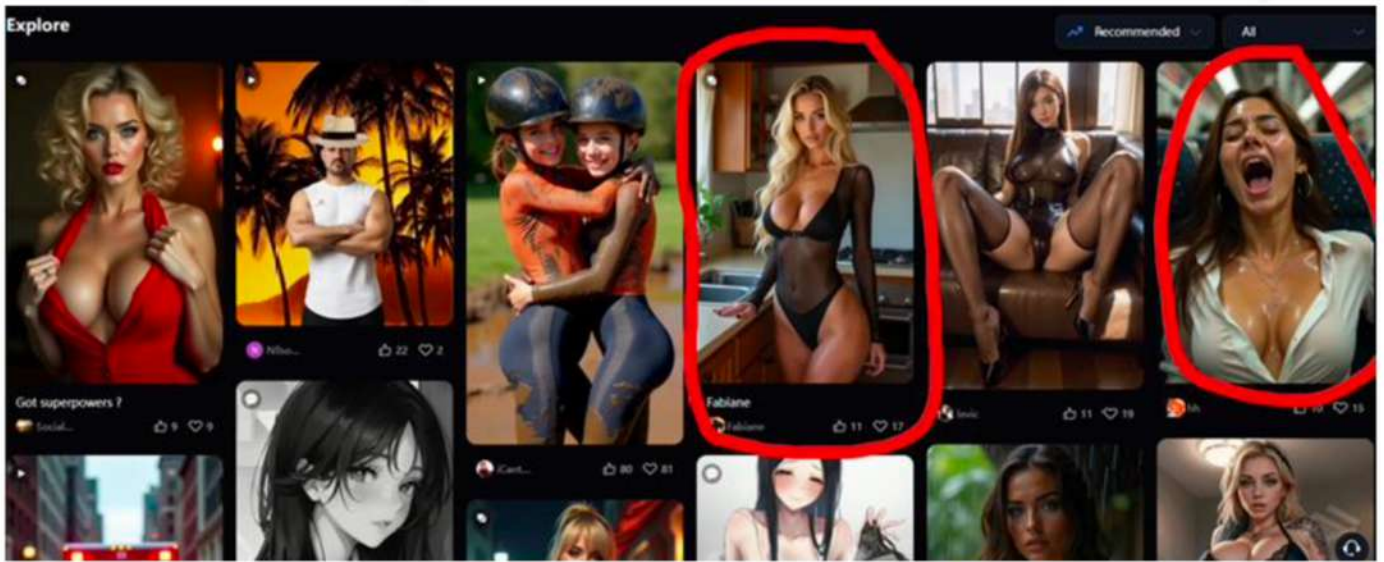
First, **create your account**. I recommend signing in with Google, though any method works. You'll be asked what features you're interested in - just select **AI Characters**.

Next, it will ask, "What content are you interested in?" Choose **Beauty**, **Photographic**, **Film**, and **Landscape**.

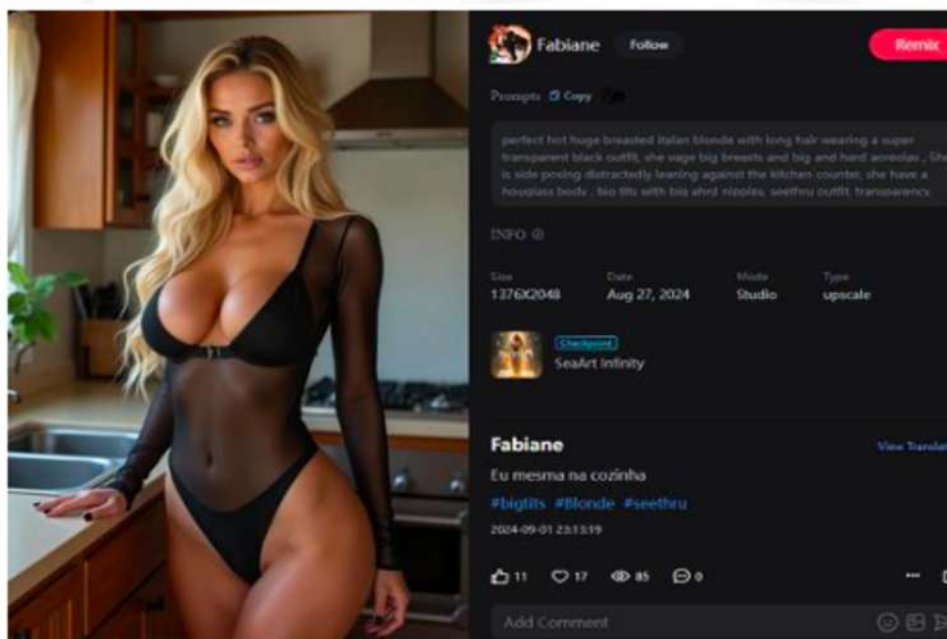


Once you're done, it will prompt you to **sign up for a free trial**. Just click the "X" in the top right corner to close it.

You should now be on the **SeaArt homepage**, where you'll see a bunch of **AI-generated images**. Scroll down to the Explore section to browse and see if any girls look realistic or catch your eye. For instance, I've highlighted a few on the next page that I think would work well for **building your AI girl** and eventually **monetizing** your content.



Click on the one you like the most



For example, I've opened an image of a girl. In the top-right corner, you'll see the **prompts** that were used to create her. The best part? You can use that exact design setup as a starting point and customize it however you want. Just click the **Remix button** to begin.

After you hit **Remix**, you'll be taken to the **creation page**. On the left side, you'll see all the settings used to generate the girl. In this example, the model I remixed was made using the standard "**SeaArt Infinity**" generation model, without any added Loras. For now, it's best to leave these settings as they are.



The first step is to **update the prompts** in the prompt box. Be as creative and specific as you want - the more detail, the better the results. Just remember to watch your credit balance, since you're limited to **150 credits per day**.

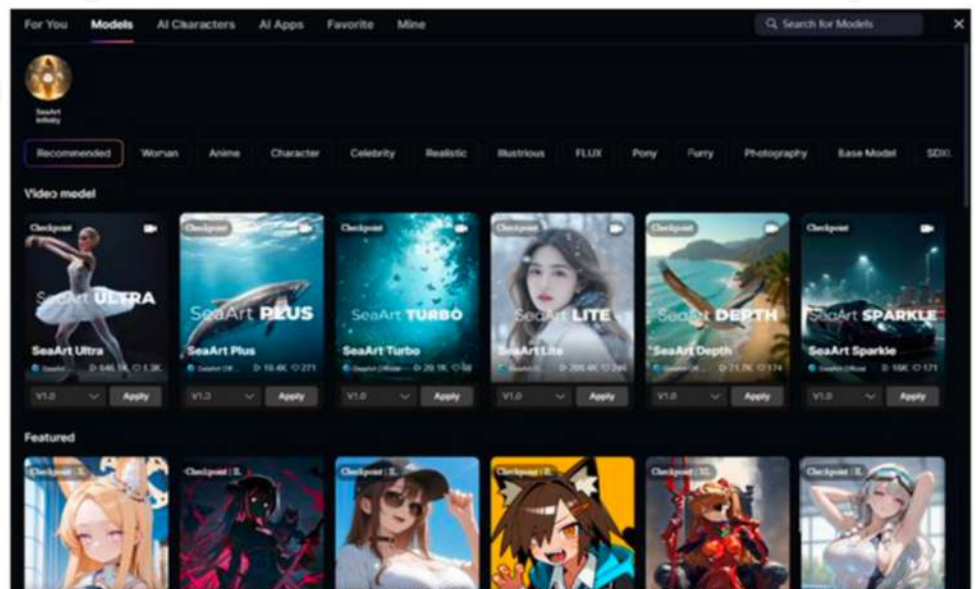


For me, this generation didn't turn out great - she looked very **unrealistic** and **off**. That's totally normal. When this happens, try **tweaking your prompts** to be closer to the original creator's, or simply choose a **different model** to replicate.

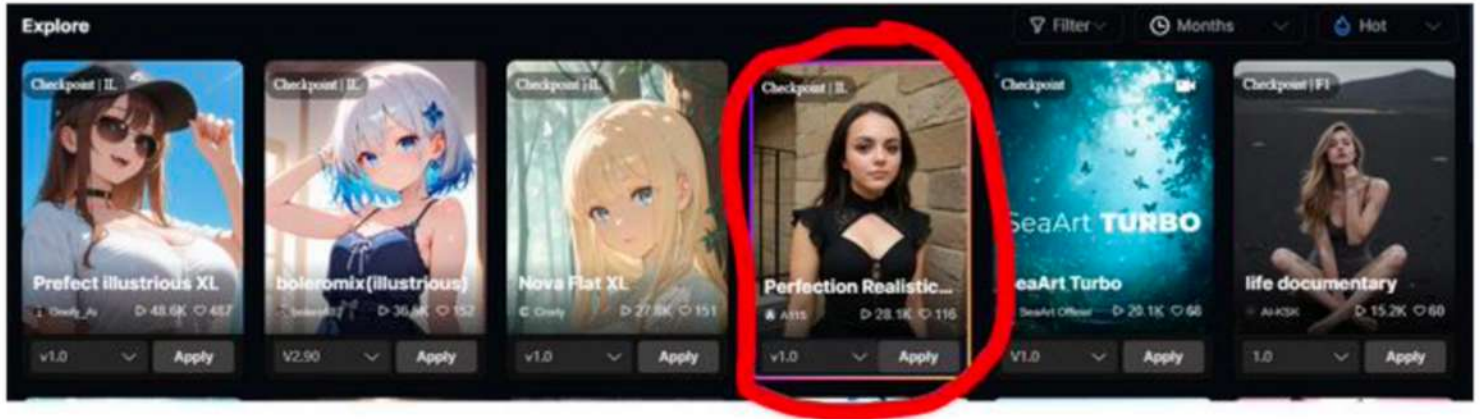
Personally, I prefer **creating my own model from scratch**. It gives me full **control** over her **body type, features**, and overall **uniqueness**, ensuring that no one else is using the same design. To do this, simply click the blue **Create** button near the top right of the home screen - it'll take you to the same page you'd see when remixing a creation.



This is where you'll start adjusting the **settings**. Begin by **changing the model**.



You'll now be on this page. The goal here is to pick a **model** that looks as **realistic** as possible. For example, I've chosen "**Perfection Realistic**" as a good starting point.



This is a checkpoint, which serves as the **foundation** for your **AI girl**, giving you a solid and **realistic base** to build on.



Now that you have your updated creation model, I recommend leaving the rest of the settings as they are. For **social media**, the ideal image ratio is **2:3**. You can generate additional images if you like, but remember it will use more credits.



Now let's go back to the prompts. The prompts have **memory**, so including details like a name helps the AI generate the same-looking girl consistently. Take a look at mine, for example: I used

"Sarah, brunette 19-year-old, perfect body, brown eyes, wearing white lingerie, in a stylish modern bedroom, smiling, 8K, realistic, full body shot."

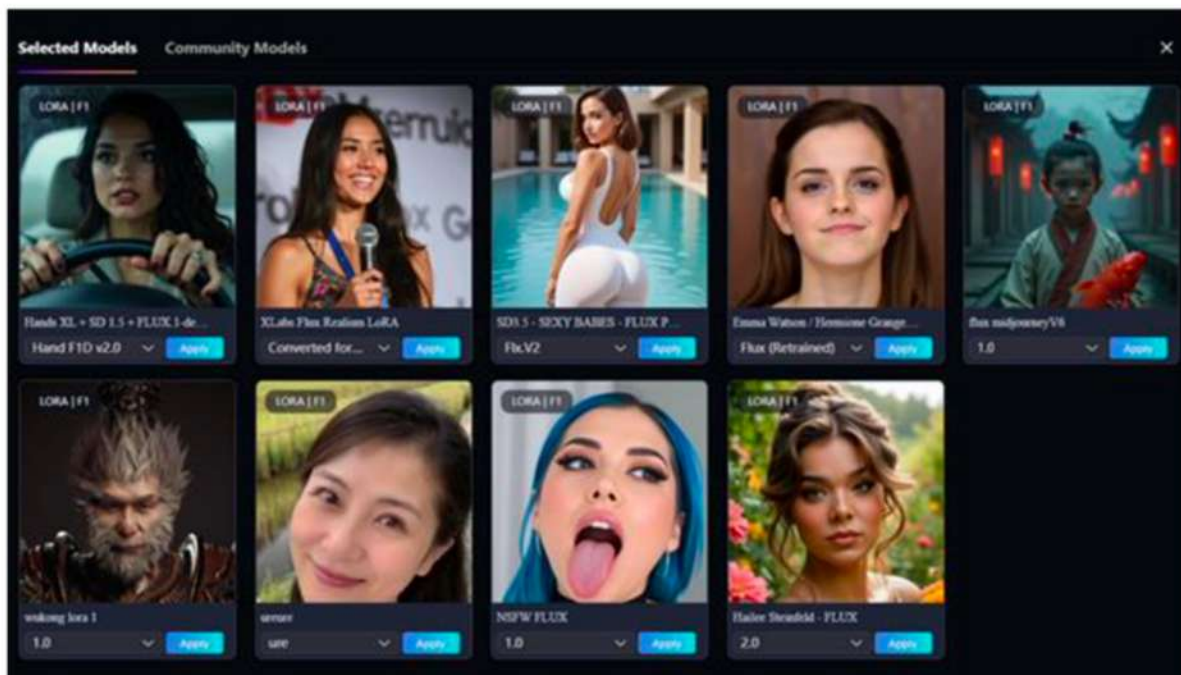
This is the girl it created (next page).



It's a solid start. She has a **unique look** with no body distortions. Of course, you could make her even **more realistic** - which I recommend - but as you've seen with other **successful models**, it's not absolutely necessary.

A common issue is **inconsistency** in your AI girl's appearance. To solve this, I stick to the same key prompts every time I generate a new model. For example, I always start with "**Sarah, brunette, 19 years old, perfect body, brown eyes.**" This ensures the AI can recreate the same look reliably.

Another handy tool when building your model is Lora. You can add it by clicking the **+** next to "**Additional.**" This opens a page similar to the one for adding a model, allowing you to **fine-tune** your creation even further.



This is your chance to **try out different Loras** and shape your **perfect AI girl**. I suggest exploring **community-created models**, some inspired by real women, which you can **adjust** and **refine** to achieve a more **lifelike** and **visually striking** result.

Creating your model is the most **challenging part**, but once you find a **look** you like, things get much easier. The key is to avoid the **typical, generic AI faces** - they're overused and won't help you stand out or make much **profit**. This is where your creativity really matters. Go beyond the usual styles and choose a niche that makes your girl unique and marketable. For example, try a goth aesthetic, a **gamer-girl vibe**, or something completely original and unexpected. The more distinctive and appealing your concept, the more **valuable** it becomes.



If you're looking for niche inspiration, real creators on **OnlyFans** can be a great source of ideas. Study their style, branding, and what makes them **stand out**. And if you ever need fresh ideas, don't hesitate to ask ChatGPT for **unique** and **profitable niche** suggestions.

Let me show you one of my **most successful AI girls**. Take a close look at what made her **stand out**, how she **caught attention**, and why she turned into such a **profitable success**.



At the time, she was something special - one of the most **realistic** and **unique AI girls** online. She quickly drew in **thousands of followers** and started generating **impressive income**. The niche I went for was a **playful, college-style** personality with a **flirty edge** - a mix that clearly resonated with her audience. This one's just an example from my **earlier projects**, so take inspiration, but **don't copy her directly** - you'll want to craft your own standout identity.

Unfortunately, **some followers** who had sent me **thousands** eventually discovered she was **AI-generated**. Now, whenever I launch a new account using her, it gets **flooded with comments** exposing the truth - which makes it **impossible to monetize** her anymore.

When it comes to **creating your model**, once you've locked in the **perfect look**, it's time to generate a **variety of images** to keep your content fresh and engaging.

For example:

- **Vary the backgrounds:** Switch up the settings to keep things interesting - try a **bedroom, kitchen, café, park, or city street**. A variety of environments makes your model feel more **realistic** and dynamic.
- **Change the outfits:** Mix up the clothing styles to match different moods - casual, sporty, elegant, or trendy. This keeps your audience **engaged** and helps your character stand out. Think jeans and a white shirt, **mini skirt and bra, onesie, lingerie, dress, bikini**, etc.
- **Include some NSFW images:** While this isn't necessary right at the start, once you've built an 18+ profile, aim for about **30-50%** of your generated images to be **NSFW or nude**.
- **Alter the poses:** Don't keep your model in the same position all the time. Experiment with different **angles, gestures, and expressions** to make your character feel **alive and natural**.
- **Play with lighting and color:** Small tweaks in **lighting, shadows, and color tones** can dramatically improve the **visual appeal** of your images.

This kind of **variety** helps keep your character **interesting and realistic**. You can also generate a **close-up** of her face, which This can be useful for faceswap videos. Try prompts like "face shot," "portrait," or "face only" and experiment until it works.

Keep reading for a list of **prompt ideas** for locations and outfits - use them as **inspiration**, tweak them to your style, and always include your model's **name** and **key details** to keep her identity consistent.

Outfits:

- Oversized sweater with jeans
- Crop top paired with leggings
- Tank top and mini skirt combo
- Lace bralette with tight leather pants
- Sheer lingerie top with thong
- Secretary or school teacher look

Locations:

- Luxury penthouse overlooking the city skyline
- Trendy café with chic décor
- Sunset beach with waves in the background
- Neon-lit city street at night
- Elegant hotel room with soft, ambient lighting
- Cozy bedroom with fairy lights and plush bedding

Creating Videos

Creating videos with your AI girl isn't required, but it can give you a **big advantage** and **boost engagement** on platforms like **Instagram Reels, TikTok,** and more. I highly recommend trying it - videos add an extra layer of **realism** that makes your content stand out.

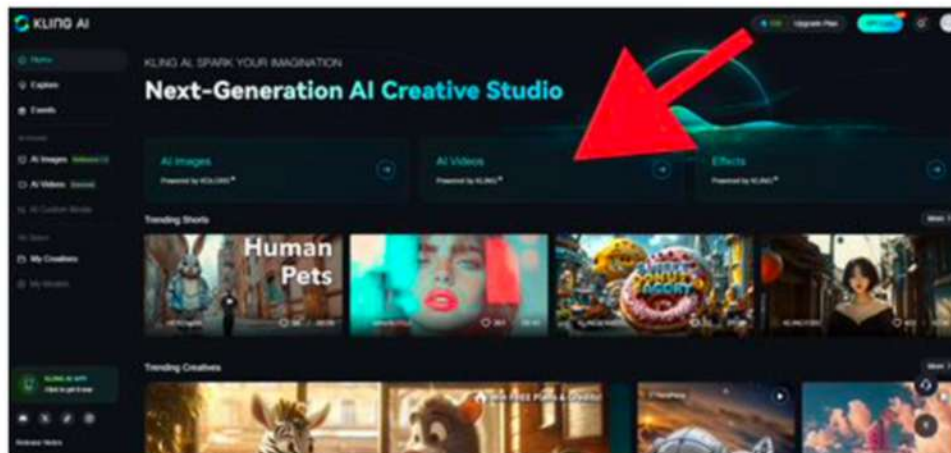
There are two main ways to make videos: **faceswap** or using **animation software** to bring your model to life. Faceswap works well for integrating your AI girl into existing footage, especially in adult content.

However, animation software is great for getting **smooth, polished moves** that look awesome on Reels or TikTok.

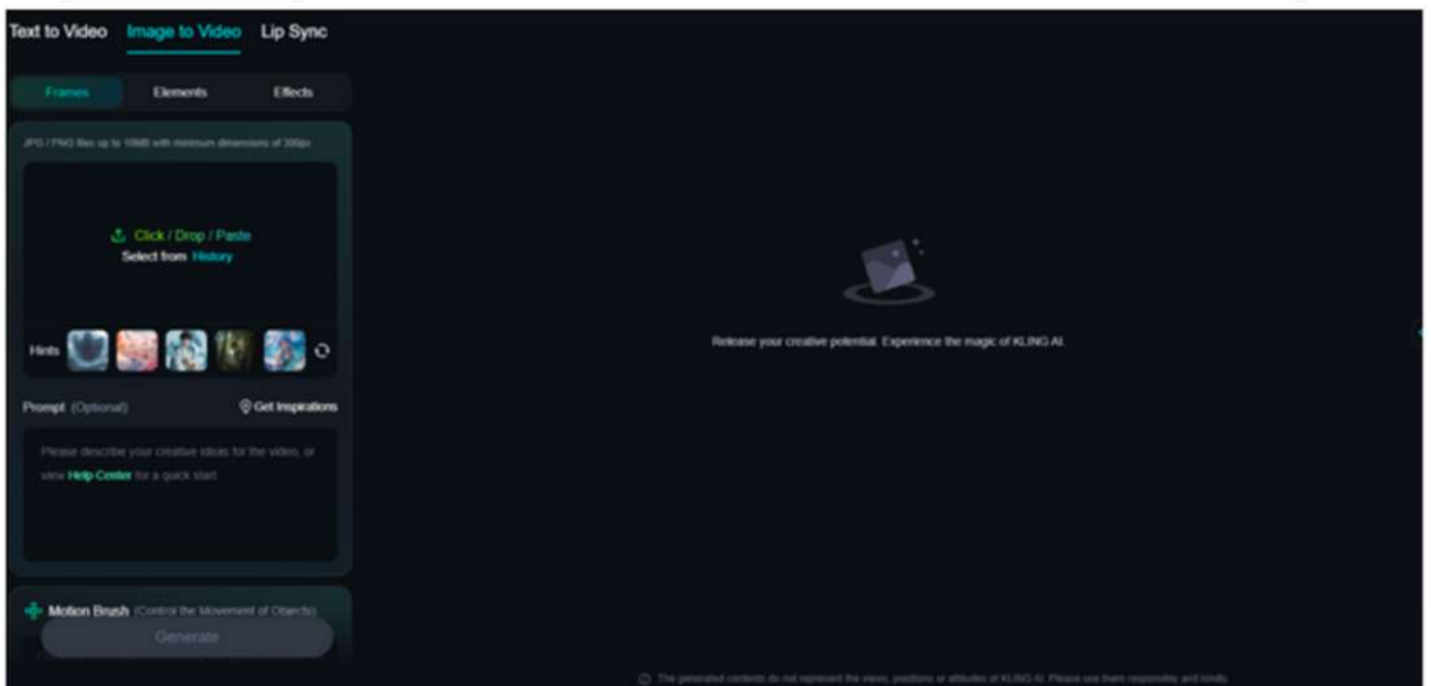


The software I recommend using is **Kling AI**. It lets you take an **existing image** and use **prompts** to turn it into a **video**. **SeaArt.ai** has a similar feature, but it's a bit **more expensive**.

Head over to **klingai.com**, and you'll see a home screen that looks pretty similar to **SeaArt's** - clean, simple, and easy to navigate.



Next, click on "AI Videos" in the center.



Once you're on this screen, the process is super simple. Just **drag in an image** of your **SeaArt-generated model** and add a few **prompts** describing what you want her to do - like a basic **TikTok dance** or subtle **body movements**.

The software will then generate your **video**, and from my experience, the results can be seriously **impressive**.

Keep in mind, processing can take hours because of queue times, but if you grab a **membership**, you can skip the wait and get your videos **much faster**.

Another method is **face swapping**, which works best for videos where you can't get your model to resemble the desired look, such as **adult content**. This is the approach you'll be using for selling. The website I use for this is **Mio Create**.

This process is **fairly simple**, though it doesn't always produce **flawless results**. Once you're on the website, choose "Video Face Swap," then upload the video you want to edit and add the photo of the face you want to swap in. With **just a click**, the software will replace the face. However, the results can be inconsistent, so don't worry if it doesn't work perfectly. There are plenty of other ways to make money, which I'll explain later!

Social media for your model

Social media is **key to marketing** your AI model. You've likely seen numerous OnlyFans **creators promoting themselves** on TikTok, Instagram, and other platforms - that's how they drive traffic to their **paid content**.



The primary social media platforms you'll focus on are:

- X (Twitter)
- Instagram
- TikTok

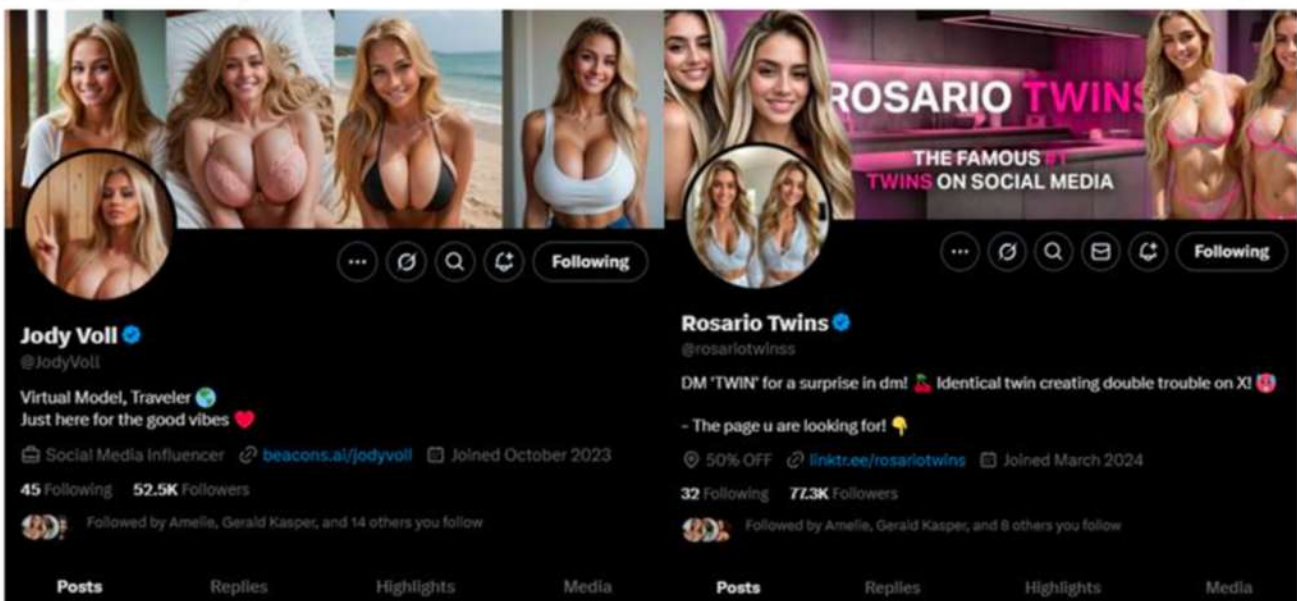
These should be your **main focus**, but feel free to experiment with other platforms if you think they might fit your strategy. Still, these three tend to be the **most effective** overall.

First, you'll need to **choose a name** for your AI model. Try to avoid overly common names like *Emma*, *Gemma*, or *Sarah*. Instead, pick something distinctive that helps your character stand out. If you're stuck, you can always ask ChatGPT to generate **unique** and **creative name** ideas for you!

Once you've chosen a name, set up a new **Gmail account** using that name (for example, *sarahjohn@gmail.com*). Then, use that same email to create all your social media profiles. Keeping everything connected to one account makes it **organized** and **easy to manage**. Also, try to use the same username across all platforms - it helps people **find you easily** and makes your brand **more memorable**.

Setting up your profiles is pretty **straightforward!** Just make sure to **avoid** any **NSFW content** in your profile pictures or bio, as this can quickly lead to a **shadow ban**.

Following, I'll share some profiles of **successful models** that you can use for **inspiration**.



As you can see, all these profiles have an **OnlyFans-like aesthetic**- somewhat professional and polished. Try to **maintain** that **vibe** when setting up your own profile

When launching a new social media account, it's important to **avoid actions** that might trigger the algorithm or flag your page as a **bot**. Here are a few key things you'll want to **avoid** early on:

- **Follow too many accounts at once** – This can look suspicious and may lead to restrictions.
- **Spam likes and comments** – Overly aggressive engagement can trigger spam filters.
- **Constantly open and close the app** – Erratic activity can make the platform think you're not a real user.

Instead, set up your profile, post your first update (make sure it's **fully clothed**), and **follow** about **5-10 accounts**.

So you're going to want to follow other ai girls. Start with the **most successful**. Go to the X account **@JodyVoll**. Follow her then go onto who she's following. Follow 5-10 ai models with a decent following. You can like one or two of their posts but **nothing more**.

You can also check their Instagram profiles - most creators link them in their **bios** - and follow them there too. The first week on social media is super **slow**, your main goal is to follow around **100 AI girls** in total.

Aim to have around 10-15 posts so your page looks **active** and **professional**. This also helps when **networking** with **other creators** through DMs and can **reduce** the **risk** of your account being **flagged** (shadowbanned).

Start by **posting three times a day** - morning, afternoon, and evening. You can even schedule posts in advance, which makes consistency easier. Over time, you'll start to **see when your audience is most active** and can adjust your posting times accordingly.

And don't worry if your first posts don't get much attention - that's completely normal. **Consistency** is what builds momentum.

Up next, I'll show you three example posts to give you some inspiration on **how to create content** that really **stands out** and **performs well**.





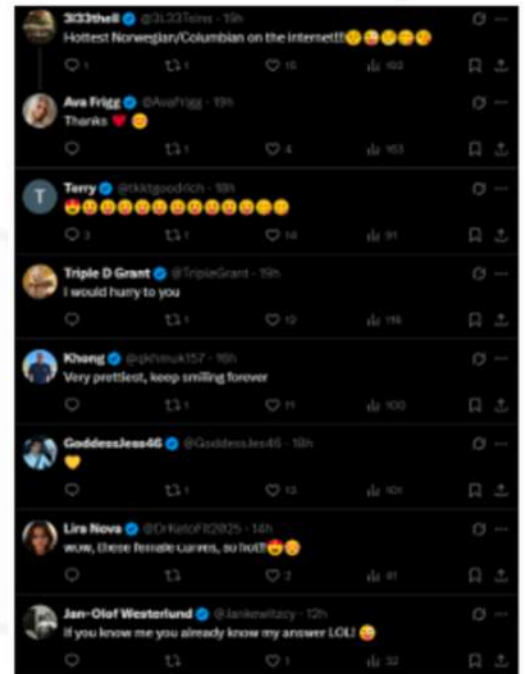
Use these posts as inspiration when creating your own. Keep your captions **short** and **clear**, and **avoid adding links** directly in them - it keeps your content looking **clean** and **authentic**.

Here are my **top tips** for **growing** your social media pages:

- Post **regularly**.
- Be **authentic** - share glimpses of your daily life and let your personality shine. **Avoid** being just another adult content creator with explicit captions on every post. **Instead**, talk about your day or something else that gives you character.
- Respond to **all your comments** while your account is still small. This helps build a **dedicated fanbase**.
- **Engage** with all **DMs** from followers. Many creators ignore this, but it's one of the best ways to **boost earnings**. Talk to them like you're a real person and **make them feel valued!**
- My **top tip** is to like replies on popular AI girl posts. For example...



These are all comments on an AI girl's post. You want to **like** the **comments from the guys**, especially the ones on newer posts. The **sooner** you like a comment, the **better** - if you can like a comment that was posted just seconds ago, the chances are higher that guy will check out your profile. A good strategy is to turn on notifications for these big AI creators, so whenever they post, you'll be notified and can jump straight into the comments to like as **many as possible**.



Just remember, if your account is new, don't go overboard and like too many at once!

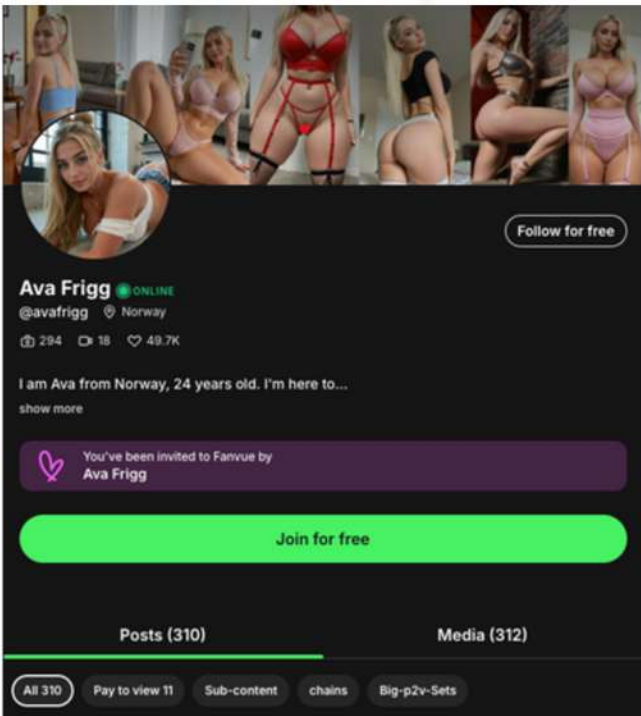
Also, leave a comment on the post complimenting the girl.
Just make sure it doesn't come across as desperate!

NSFW

This is where you can **start generating income** from your AI character. There are several great **platforms** for creators, but the **most popular** and **beginner-friendly** options are **Fanvue**, **Patreon**, and **PayPal**.



Fanvue is one of the **best platforms** for AI models/AI-based creators. Not only do they support AI-generated content, but they also actively encourage it. When setting up your account, be sure to **clearly state** that your profile **represents an AI character**, not a real person. You'll also go through a standard ID verification process, but **there's no need to stress** - it's simple and straightforward.

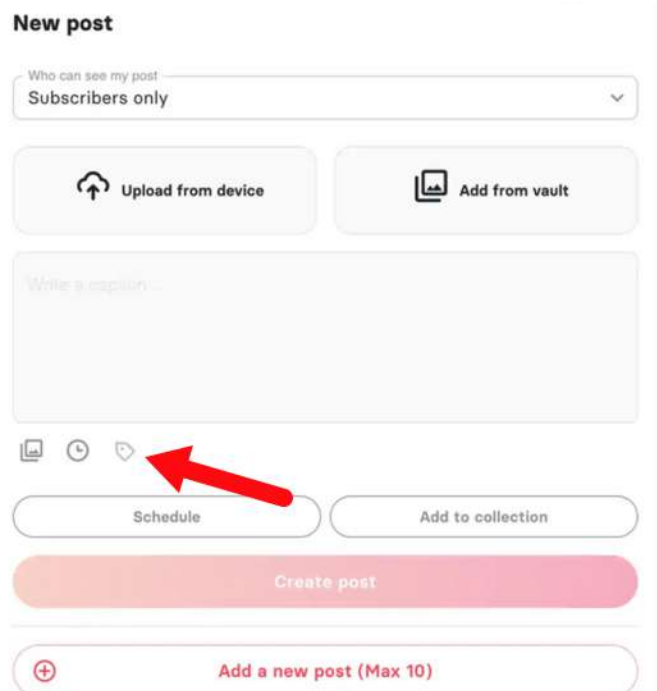


Try and **set up** your **fanvue profile** to look like this. A **good banner photo**, a **high quality** profile photo and a **good description** of your girl!

To start off, I suggest keeping your **subscription price** at **\$5** or less per month. It might sound low, but don't worry - subscriptions aren't where most of your income will come from. The **real profits** usually come from **tips** and **PPV** (Pay-Per-View) **content**, which tend to bring in **much more** overall.

The key to **turning visitors into paying subscribers** is having a **well-built** and **active profile**. When you launch, try to upload at least **20-30 photos** so your page looks alive and engaging. **Focus** on **teasing content** - think **lingerie shots**, **subtle nip slips**, or other suggestive images, that **grab attention** without giving too much away. Keep your most explicit material exclusive for **paying subscribers**. Once you've built up a solid gallery of around 50+ images, you can consider raising your subscription price to \$10, depending on how NSFW your free content is.

Every **2-3 days**, create a **premium content bundle** - such as a **full nude photoset** or even **toy play content**, if possible. Set a PPV price between **\$5-\$10** while your subscriber count is still growing. As your audience expands, you can **slowly increase** your **pricing** over time.



As I mentioned, **tips** will be one of your **biggest income streams** on Fanvue. To **maximize your earnings**, treat every follower and subscriber like a **valued friend**. Engage often, build genuine connections, and make them feel special. In a way, it's like sales job - the better you are at **communicating** and **understanding** what people want, the more **money** you'll make. Some followers spend **thousands per month**, so don't get discouraged if things start slow. With **consistency** and the **right strategy**, your **profits will grow steadily** over time.

WARNING!

Don't try to sell **other people's adult videos** on your Fanvue. I've tried it, and while it can work, you'll quickly get **flagged**. If you can't provide ID for the content you're selling, you **won't be able to withdraw any of the money**.

Patreon



PATREON

Think of **Patreon** as your content hub - a central place to showcase everything from your social media and other platforms. Post a mix of SFW and NSFW content to keep your page active and engaging. The more content you share, the more **value** you offer, which makes it easier to attract new fans and **keep paying subscribers** coming back for more.

For Patreon, it's ideal to offer two subscription tiers:

- **Lower-priced tier (around \$5):** Great for attracting a larger number of subscribers and building your base audience.
- **Premium tier (\$25+):** Still affordable, but positioned to offer exclusive perks and extra value for dedicated fans.

Since **Patreon** works on a **single subscription model**, there's no **PPV** (Pay-Per-View) and **no need** for direct interaction with subscribers. It's simply a space where fans can unlock all your content for one flat fee - making it an excellent source of **steady, passive income**.

PayPal



Setting up a **PayPal** account is **simple**, and it's essential for receiving **direct payments** from subscribers or fans. Whether someone wants to send a **tip** or **purchase exclusive content**, PayPal keeps transactions smooth and secure.

From my own experience, I've earned over **\$12,000** just through DMs on X, so **don't overlook** the potential of **one-on-one sales** and **direct tips**. The advantage of selling through DMs is the **flexibility** - you can sell a porn video from the internet. Just be sure to either **face swap** or **crop out** the face.

Ensure the video has an **amateur vibe** rather than a professional porn look, and make sure the **body shape** is similar.

That wraps up the guide. Setting everything up and seeing real results **will take time**, so be patient. Think of this guide like a gym membership - it gives you all the **tools, strategies**, and **advice** you need to make progress, but ultimately, it's **up to you**. If you **put in the work consistently**, you'll see results. If you give up after the first week, you won't make progress or achieve success in any area. **Persistence is key.**
