

VENDING MACHINE CONTRACT AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This CONTRACT OF AGREEMENT (“Contract”) is made and executed at _____, this _____, 2025, by and between:

Mr. **Tarsecio Nolasco**, with home add, 1467 Urban Deca Home, Vitas Street Tondo Manila Brgy 106, Philippines (**“Buyer”**)

and

VENDING MACHINE PH by ITADISH TRADING, with TIN Number 248-994-888-000, represented by Ms. Phenny Charie Castillo, a company duly organized and existing in accordance with the laws of the Philippines with address at MS 201 Corinthian Executive Regency, ADB Avenue, Ortigas Center, San Antonio Pasig City 1600. (**“Supplier”**)

WITNESSETH: That -

WHEREAS, BUYER is purchasing Two (2) unit brand New Smart Vending Machine of ITAdish Vending. Complete order customization (See Annex A).

WHEREAS, SUPPLIER will provide the Brand New Smart Vending Machine described on Annex A.

NOW, THEREFORE for and in consideration of the foregoing promises, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. PAYMENT

1.1 BUYER will pay the Supplier for the purchase of Two (2) Brand New Standard Vending Machine. (Kindly refer to Annex A for the complete description), and for all obligations specified in this Agreement, if any, as the full and complete purchase price excluding the 12% sales tax, the sum of Php 628,000. (“ The Purchase Price”). See Invoice.

1.2 BUYER covenants and agrees to comply with the payment terms.

1.3 In consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein, SUPPLIER agrees to a full 100% refund if the Vending Machine is not delivered.

2. PERMITS and TAXES

2.1 The Buyer shall bear sole and full responsibility for obtaining all necessary business permits, filing all required sales-related documentation, and ensuring compliance with all applicable laws, rules, and regulations in the Philippines in connection with this Agreement.

2.2 The foregoing obligation shall likewise apply to all transactions involving international sales, without limitation.

2.3 In the event that the Buyer does not currently possess a valid business permit, the Buyer shall procure such permit within a reasonable period of time and furnish a duly certified copy thereof to be appended to the Buyer's official records under this Agreement.

3. CASHLESS PAYMENTS (optional)

3.1 Cashless Payment Option

The Buyer may elect to purchase either:

- (a) a vending machine equipped for cashless payment transactions; or
- (b) a vending machine without cashless payment capabilities.

However, any Buyer requesting the installation of a cashless payment system shall be required to present and maintain a valid and complete business permit prior to the approval and activation of such cashless features.

3.2 Standard Units and QR Payment Capability

Standard vending machine units do not come equipped with QR code payment capabilities. QR code payments are supported only on vending machines with Android VMC systems or through the installation of a Nayax Unit as an additional component.

3.3 Payment Processing System and Fees

Android vending machines equipped with the Nayax Unit accept swipe cards, debit cards, and other digital payment methods via the payment processing system managed by 2C2P.

Fees: The Buyer shall pay an annual fee of ₱30,000 (or ₱20,000 at the discounted rate), plus an onboarding fee of ₱30,000 (or ₱20,000 at the discounted rate).

Accepted Payment Methods: GCash, PayMaya, debit cards, and credit cards are supported forms of payment.

Optional Feature: The use of the Nayax Unit for cashless payments is entirely optional and subject to the Buyer's compliance with the business permit requirement set forth in Clause 3.1.

3.4 Post-Purchase Installation of Nayax Unit

The Nayax Unit may be purchased and installed after the initial vending machine acquisition, subject to the following conditions:

- The Buyer shall notify Itadish in advance of the intent to add cashless capabilities.
- The Buyer shall ensure adequate internet connectivity for the installation and operation of the Nayax Unit.
- Itadish shall conduct the necessary preparatory work only after confirmation of compliance with the business permit requirement in Clause 3.1.

4. LOCATION AND LOGISTICS

4.1 Supplier can provide the Buyer location when asked. This location maybe a warehouse for temporary storage or a public area conducive to generating sales, with a monthly rental fee not exceeding Php 2,000.

4.2 Buyer will shoulder Logistics and logistics staff(3) tip of Php 500 each. This gratuity is of significance to the individuals responsible for the logistics of the vending machines, as it serves as an incentive for the careful handling and maintenance of the unit, given its weight of 350 kilograms and the requirements for the three individuals to carry and manage it. This only applies to second deliveries and onwards.

4.3 Seller only uses one(1) Logistics Company Partner. Vending Machine Transfer requires a truck of 7ft with lifter, and a jacklift. Personnel must know how to handle big items of 350-400 kilos. It is of buyers risk to engage an alternative logistics company unfamiliar with the proper handling of the large vending machine.

4.4. Vending Machine location must be easily accessible, no big stairs, no basement, not outdoor. It must have a direct socket to avoid motor issues.

5. PAYMENT

5.1 The scheduled payments must be made punctually according to the agreed timeline. Payments should only be remitted to the company's designated bank account or in the form of a check made out to "itadish trading" entity. No cash payments shall be tendered to any personnel of the seller.

5.2. Cash Payment Discount

In the event that the Buyer elects to make full payment in cash upon execution of this Agreement, a discount in the amount of Twenty Thousand Philippine Pesos (Php 20,000.00) shall be applied to the total contract price.

5.3 Late Payment Penalty – Scheduled Payments

Should the Buyer fail to remit the second scheduled payment within thirty (30) calendar days from its due date, a penalty equivalent to twenty percent (20%) of the outstanding balance shall automatically accrue and become immediately due and payable.

5.4 Final Payment Terms

The final twenty percent (20%) of the total contract price shall become due and payable within seven (7) calendar days following the arrival of the vending machines in the Philippines and after the machines have been successfully deployed in full operational condition and free from defects.

* If the Buyer avails of the free storage facility for a maximum period of five (5) months, ten percent (10%) shall be payable within the month of arrival in the Philippines, and the remaining ten percent (10%) shall be payable within seven (7) calendar days after deployment.

* Any late payment shall incur a penalty equivalent to ten percent (10%) per month on the unpaid amount until full settlement is made.

5.5 Payment Terms – Second-Hand Vending Machines

For the acquisition of second-hand vending machines, the Buyer shall remit a deposit of Fifty Thousand Philippine Pesos (Php 50,000.00) upon execution of this Agreement. The balance shall be payable in full upon delivery of the vending machines. Where financing or installment payments are involved, the terms and conditions of the financing or lending institution shall prevail.

5.6 Full Payment After Deployment

The full contract price must be settled within thirty (30) calendar days following the deployment of the vending machines in the Philippines. Failure to do so shall result in a penalty charge of twenty percent (20%) per month on the outstanding balance until full settlement is made.

5.7 Order Cancellation Fee

In the event that the Buyer cancels the order for any reason after execution of this Agreement, a cancellation fee equivalent to thirty percent (30%) of the total contract price shall immediately become due and payable as liquidated damages.

6. ADD ONS

6.1 Tray Configuration Changes:

Any modifications to the vending machine's tray configuration after delivery, including a complete reconfiguration of the entire tray system, shall be subject to an additional charge of USD 50.

6.2 Spiral Provision:

The Seller shall provide five (5) additional spirals at no cost upon the Buyer's request. Any additional spirals beyond this allocation shall be charged at a rate of PHP 200 per spiral.

6.3 Cashless Payment Modifications:

Installation or integration of additional cashless payment methods, including but not limited to swipe card payment systems or GCash, after the initial deployment of the vending machine, is strictly prohibited.

6.4 Selection Modification Restrictions:

A complete reconfiguration of the spiral tray from a single-selection setup to a dual-selection setup after delivery is expressly prohibited and shall not be permitted under any circumstances.

6.5 CCTV Installation Restrictions:

The installation of any additional CCTV cameras inside the vending machine shall not be permitted unless the Buyer installs a separate unit to provide Wi-Fi connectivity for the CCTV system. The SIM card and associated data plan supplied with the vending machine are exclusively for vending machine data monitoring, cloud services, and software maintenance. Unauthorized use of this SIM card for other purposes is strictly prohibited to prevent service interruptions.

7. DELIVERY, WAREHOUSE, TECH & LOGISTICS

DELIVERY

7.1 Deliveries Outside Metro Manila

The BUYER shall be solely responsible for all delivery costs and arrangements for deliveries outside of Metro Manila, except as otherwise provided herein.

7.2 Free Delivery Within Designated Areas

The SUPPLIER shall provide free delivery services for one (1) delivery to locations within Metro Manila,

Bulacan, and Cavite.

7.3 Deliveries Outside Designated Areas

For deliveries outside Metro Manila, Bulacan, and Cavite, the SUPPLIER shall coordinate and assist the BUYER with sea and/or land transport through the SUPPLIER's partner logistics companies. All associated costs shall be borne by the BUYER.

7.4 One-Time Free Delivery Limitation

The free delivery service referenced in Clause 7.2 is strictly limited to one (1) initial delivery per transaction. Any subsequent relocation, change of delivery address, or additional transportation requirements shall be at the full expense of the BUYER.

7.5 Assistance for Additional Logistics Services

The SUPPLIER shall provide reasonable assistance to the BUYER in engaging the SUPPLIER's partner logistics company for any additional transportation or moving services requested by the BUYER. All costs for such services shall be the responsibility of the BUYER.

7.6 Tech food and accommodation

Buyer shall cover food and accommodation of our technician for any deployments outside Metro Manila. Supplier shall cover all types of transpo, bus, flights, and boats.

7.7 Preparation prior to delivery

Coins: The buyer shall prepare 30-50 pcs of old and new coins, 1,5,10 and 20 for vending machine change. We will need the coins to configure the coin acceptor that it release correct amount.

Initial Products: Pls have initial products prepared like skyflakes biscuits, bottle of water, soda in cans, and chips.

WAREHOUSE

7.6 Warehouse Storage: The Buyer may store their Vending Machine at the Supplier's warehouse for a maximum period of five (5) months from the date of delivery or readiness for storage, whichever is earlier.

7.7 Storage Fees: In the event that the Buyer's Vending Machine remains in the Supplier's warehouse beyond the maximum storage period specified in Clause 7.6, the Supplier shall be entitled to charge a storage fee of Two Thousand Pesos (₱2,000) per unit, per month, or any part thereof, until the Vending Machine is removed.

7.8 Supplier Non-Performance: Should the Supplier be unable to deliver the Vending Machine to the Buyer after full payment has been made, the Buyer shall be entitled to a full refund of all amounts paid, without prejudice to any other remedies available under this Agreement or applicable law.

8. WARRANTY

8.1 Warranty Against Defects

The Supplier warrants that each vending machine supplied to the Buyer shall be free from defects in design, materials, and workmanship at the time of delivery.

8.2 Warranty Coverage

All vending machines shall be covered by a one (1) calendar year warranty from the date of purchase. This warranty includes the free replacement of spare parts and motor parts as required. Aftersales onsite technical support is expressly excluded unless otherwise agreed in writing.

8.3 Post-Warranty Parts Supply

Following the expiration of the one (1) year warranty period, the Supplier agrees to provide spare parts and motor parts, as needed, at prevailing market rates.

8.4 Delivery Support

The Supplier shall provide the following support to the Buyer:

- (a) A physical demonstration upon delivery of the vending machine;
- (b) Video tutorials prior to delivery; and
- (c) Additional video instructions upon reasonable request.

8.5 Exclusions from Warranty

The warranty shall not extend to:

- (a) Cracked screens, missing or stolen components, or damage caused by the Buyer or any third party;
- (b) Damage caused by Force Majeure events;
- (c) Unauthorized alterations, including but not limited to rewiring, relocation of payment units, or opening the compressor after delivery;
- (d) Damage resulting from unauthorized repairs or modifications, misuse, neglect, improper maintenance, or failure to implement recommended corrective actions;
- (e) Normal wear and tear of parts subject to periodic replacement;
- (f) Damage arising from accidents, natural disasters, power surges, electrical faults beyond the Supplier's control, pest infestations, environmental factors (e.g., extreme temperatures, humidity, direct sunlight), vandalism, or intentional acts of third parties;
- (g) Damage caused by the use of unauthorized or incompatible parts or accessories;
- (h) Damage caused by failure to follow manufacturer instructions;
- (i) Consumable items including, but not limited to, batteries;
- (j) Issues related to the quality or safety of products stocked in the vending machine;
- (k) Loss of revenue or profits due to vending machine downtime;
- (l) Outdoor installation where machines are partially exposed to the elements (e.g., rain, direct sunlight) unless otherwise approved in writing by the Supplier;
- (m) Coffee vending machines or second-hand vending machines; and

(n) Accumulation of dirt, debris, or foreign objects due to lack of cleaning.

8.6 Notification of Warranty Claims

The Buyer shall notify the Supplier in writing of any warranty claims within a reasonable period after discovering the defect.

8.7 Supplier's Obligations Upon Notice

Upon receipt of notice under Clause 8.6, the Supplier shall, at its discretion and within the time period specified in the notice:

- (a) Provide instructional materials, including videos or catalogues, for troubleshooting (applicable when the location is outside Metro Manila); or
- (b) Repair or replace defective goods or parts thereof at no cost to the Buyer.

8.8 Continued Use

Continued use of the vending machine by the Buyer following notification of a defect shall not constitute a waiver of the Buyer's rights under this warranty.

8.9 Conditions Resulting in Warranty Nullification

The following circumstances shall constitute grounds for immediate termination of warranty coverage and related support services:

- (a) Three (3) instances of continued refusal by the Buyer to properly maintain the vending machine despite receiving written recommendations for corrective measures;
- (b) Failure or refusal to clean the vending machine or use the Supplier's cleaning protocols or services as recommended;
- (c) Any instance of abusive, threatening, or defamatory conduct towards the Supplier's staff, whether in person, online, or through any communication channel;
- (d) Initiation of any legal action against the Supplier without prior attempts at amicable resolution.

8.10 Definition of Free One-Year Warranty

The one-year warranty is strictly limited to the free replacement of spare and motor parts. It excludes technical support and transportation costs. Lifetime support shall be available exclusively through video tutorials, WhatsApp, and Viber assistance.

8.11 Supplier's Qualifications

The Supplier represents and warrants that it is duly licensed, financially stable, and equipped with the requisite personnel, expertise, and resources to supply and support the vending machines in accordance with this Agreement.

9. REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE

9.1 Buyer's Responsibility for Learning and Troubleshooting

The Buyer acknowledges and agrees that familiarization with the operational components of the Vending Machine is essential. This includes, but is not limited to, accessing settings, entering data, operating the bill acceptor and coin acceptor, configuring payment options, updating images and videos, adjusting temperature, cleaning the unit, uploading photos to the cloud, using wheels, accessing SIM card ports, and any add-on functionalities.

The Buyer further acknowledges that they are responsible for performing basic troubleshooting while physically present at the Vending Machine, under the guidance of the Supplier's international technician. Troubleshooting may involve manipulating wires, pressing buttons, inserting USB devices, or other actions as instructed.

9.2 Documentation Provided by Supplier

The Supplier shall provide the Buyer with both hardcopy and softcopy manuals for all Vending Machine units and associated components. This includes, but is not limited to, the Vending Machine Manual, Bill Acceptor Manual, Coin Acceptor Manual, and manuals for any add-on units.

9.3 Instructional Videos

The Supplier shall provide instructional videos demonstrating basic Vending Machine maintenance and troubleshooting procedures prior to delivery of the unit. Updates to these instructional materials may be provided after delivery to assist the Buyer in proper operation and maintenance.

9.4 Aftersales Support

The Supplier shall provide aftersales support via Viber and WhatsApp at +63 976 093 3901. The Buyer agrees to provide photographs and/or videos as requested by the Supplier's technical team to facilitate remote assistance.

9.5 Buyer Maintenance Obligations

The Buyer shall, at their own expense, maintain the Vending Machine in good working condition following delivery. Proper cleaning solutions and maintenance procedures shall be utilized in accordance with the manuals provided.

9.6 Optional In-House Technician Services

In the event that the Buyer is unable or unwilling to perform troubleshooting in accordance with the manuals or instructional videos, the Supplier may dispatch an in-house technician for a fee.

9.7 Warranty on Parts

The Supplier shall provide spare parts and motor components free of charge for a period of one (1) year from the date of delivery. Labor and transportation costs for technical support are not included in this warranty.

9.8 In-House Technician Fees

The fee for dispatching an in-house technician shall be as follows:

* Within Metro Manila and Clark: PHP 1,500 per day, plus transportation.

* Outside Metro Manila: PHP 2,000 per day, plus transportation and accommodation.

The Supplier reserves the right to adjust these fees without prior notice.

9.9 Urgent Technical Support

For urgent issues requiring immediate technical attention, if the Buyer is unable to perform troubleshooting, the Buyer shall pay the applicable in-house technician fee (PHP 1,500 plus transportation) and provide proof of payment via email. Upon receipt, the Supplier shall deploy a technician to the Vending Machine location within

twenty-four (24) hours.

10. REQUIREMENTS

10.1 Signed Contract of Agreement

10.2 Initial Payment

10.3 Identification Card scanned copy

10.4 PDC and bank Cert (optional)

10.5 Business Permit if available, If none please provide dt or any when available

11. LOCATION

11.1 Location Provision. In the event that the BUYER does not have a pre-determined location for the vending machine, the SUPPLIER shall provide a suitable location for a fee of PHP 2,000 per month, inclusive of electricity and rent.

11.2 Location Availability. All locations provided by the SUPPLIER are subject to availability. The SUPPLIER shall present the BUYER with available options from which the BUYER may select.

11.3 Contract Assistance. The SUPPLIER shall assist the BUYER by providing guidance and an editable contract template tailored to the BUYER's requirements.

11.4 Termination of Installation. The BUYER retains the right to remove her vending machine from the installation site at any time at her discretion.

11.5 Location Package and Renewal. The standard location package is six (6) months by default, with optional terms of one (1) year or two (2) years. Packages are renewable upon advance payment or payment by check. The BUYER must notify the SUPPLIER at least two (2) months prior to the expiration of a six-month or one-year term if she intends to renew the agreement.

11.6 Location Selection. The BUYER has the right to select the installation site, provided that the location:

- a) Is indoors and protected from rain and direct sunlight;
- b) Has a reliable electrical connection and a direct plug (no extension wires);
- c) Has a reliable internet connection; and
- d) Complies with all accessibility requirements outlined in this agreement.

11.7 Relocation. The BUYER may request a change to an alternative location made available by the SUPPLIER. The cost of transporting the vending machine to the new location shall be borne solely by the BUYER.

11.8 Site Requirements and Compliance. The BUYER shall ensure that the installation site:

- a) Is adequately protected from weather conditions;
- b) Provides sufficient accessibility, including verification of elevators or arrangements for personnel to move the machine in areas with stairs; and
- c) Is located on an elevated platform to prevent flooding.

Failure to comply with these requirements may result in damage to the vending machine, additional charges, delays in installation, and/or voiding of applicable warranties or support services.

11.9 Internet Connectivity. The BUYER shall provide the SIM card and registration for the vending machine's internet connection. The BUYER may select the provider (Globe, Smart, Gomo, or any other provider offering optimal connectivity at the installation location).

11.10 Insurance. The BUYER is strongly advised to obtain insurance for the vending machine to cover potential damage, theft, or other associated risks. The BUYER is responsible for all costs related to procuring and maintaining such insurance.

12. PACKAGING

12.1 Supplier's Packaging Obligation

The Supplier shall provide packaging for the Vending Machine that is appropriate, secure, and in accordance with industry best practices, such that the Vending Machine is delivered to the Buyer free from damage.

12.2 Buyer's Obligation to Retain Packaging

The Buyer shall retain the original packaging materials, including cartons, foam, and any other protective materials provided by the Supplier. Such materials must be used to repack the Vending Machine securely if it is to be relocated. The Buyer shall ensure that the Vending Machine is properly and securely packaged prior to any transport or relocation to preserve its integrity and maintain compliance with all warranty obligations.

12.3 Orientation Requirement

The Vending Machine must be kept in an upright position at all times and must not be laid on its side or inverted under any circumstances. Any failure to comply with this requirement, including improper handling or positioning, may cause damage to the Vending Machine and shall result in the voiding of all warranties provided by the Supplier.

13. FORCE MAJEURE

- Limitation of Liability – Force Majeure
- The Supplier shall not be liable for any loss, damage, or malfunction of the Vending Machine, or for any delay or failure in performance under this Agreement, arising directly or indirectly from causes beyond the Supplier's reasonable control, including, but not limited to:
 - a. Acts of God, including natural disasters such as floods, earthquakes, hurricanes, storms, fire, or other extreme weather events;
 - b. Acts of war, hostilities, invasion, terrorism, civil unrest, riots, insurrections, or acts of public enemy;
 - c. Governmental actions, including civil or military authorities, changes in law, regulation, embargo, quarantine, or expropriation;
 - d. Accidents, explosions, or other unforeseen events;
 - e. Strikes, labor disputes, or industrial actions;
 - f. Failure or interruption of utilities or transportation systems;
 - g. Cyberattacks, hacking, or other unauthorized access affecting the Vending Machine or associated systems; or
 - h. Any other circumstance reasonably beyond the Supplier's control.

The parties agree that the Supplier's obligations under this Agreement shall be suspended to the extent and for the duration of any such events, and the Supplier shall not be deemed in breach of this Agreement due to such events.

14. CONTRACT AND TERMINATION

14.1 Commencement and Warranty Period

This Agreement shall commence on the date of execution by both Parties. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the warranty period shall commence upon the Buyer's receipt of the Vending Machine.

14.2 Professional Conduct and Anti-Harassment Clause

Both Parties agree to uphold a professional and respectful working relationship at all times. The Buyer and its representatives shall refrain from using any form of abusive, offensive, or demeaning language, including but not limited to verbal insults, profanities, or gestures directed toward the Supplier or any member of the Supplier's staff. Similarly, the Supplier and its representatives shall treat the Buyer with equal respect and professionalism. Any form of harassment — whether physical, verbal, or non-verbal — toward any staff member, male or female, is strictly prohibited. Should any incident of harassment or abusive behavior occur, the affected staff member reserves the right to immediately suspend all ongoing activities and leave the premises without penalty. In such

cases, all future assistance or transactions shall be conducted solely through remote means, including but not limited to video guides and online tutorials, without in-person support.

The Buyer must promptly report any unprofessional behavior or misconduct by Supplier staff to the Supplier's management for investigation and appropriate disciplinary action. Likewise, the Supplier may report any misconduct by the Buyer or its representatives, and appropriate measures will be taken, including possible suspension or termination of the Agreement.

This clause applies equally and mutually to both Parties to ensure a safe, respectful, and harassment-free working environment.

14.2 Order Cancellation

Any cancellation of an order by the Buyer made after the execution of this Agreement but prior to shipment of the Vending Machine shall incur a cancellation fee equivalent to thirty percent (30%) of the total purchase price.

14.3 Failure to Remit Payments

Failure by the Buyer to remit any payment due under this Agreement, including but not limited to machine payments, on-site service fees, add-on fees, or any other applicable charges, shall constitute a material breach and shall entitle the Seller to terminate this Agreement, suspend support services, and void the complimentary one (1) year warranty covering spare parts and motor components.

14.4 Non-Payment Upon Delivery

Should the Buyer refuse or fail to pay the remaining twenty percent (20%) of the purchase price upon delivery of the Vending Machine in good condition, such refusal shall be deemed a forfeiture of the Vending Machine and shall result in the automatic termination of this Agreement.

14.7 Modification

No amendment or modification of this Agreement shall be valid or binding unless made in writing and signed by duly authorized representatives of both Parties.

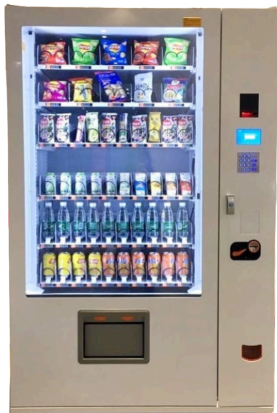
