- A Valentine's Story



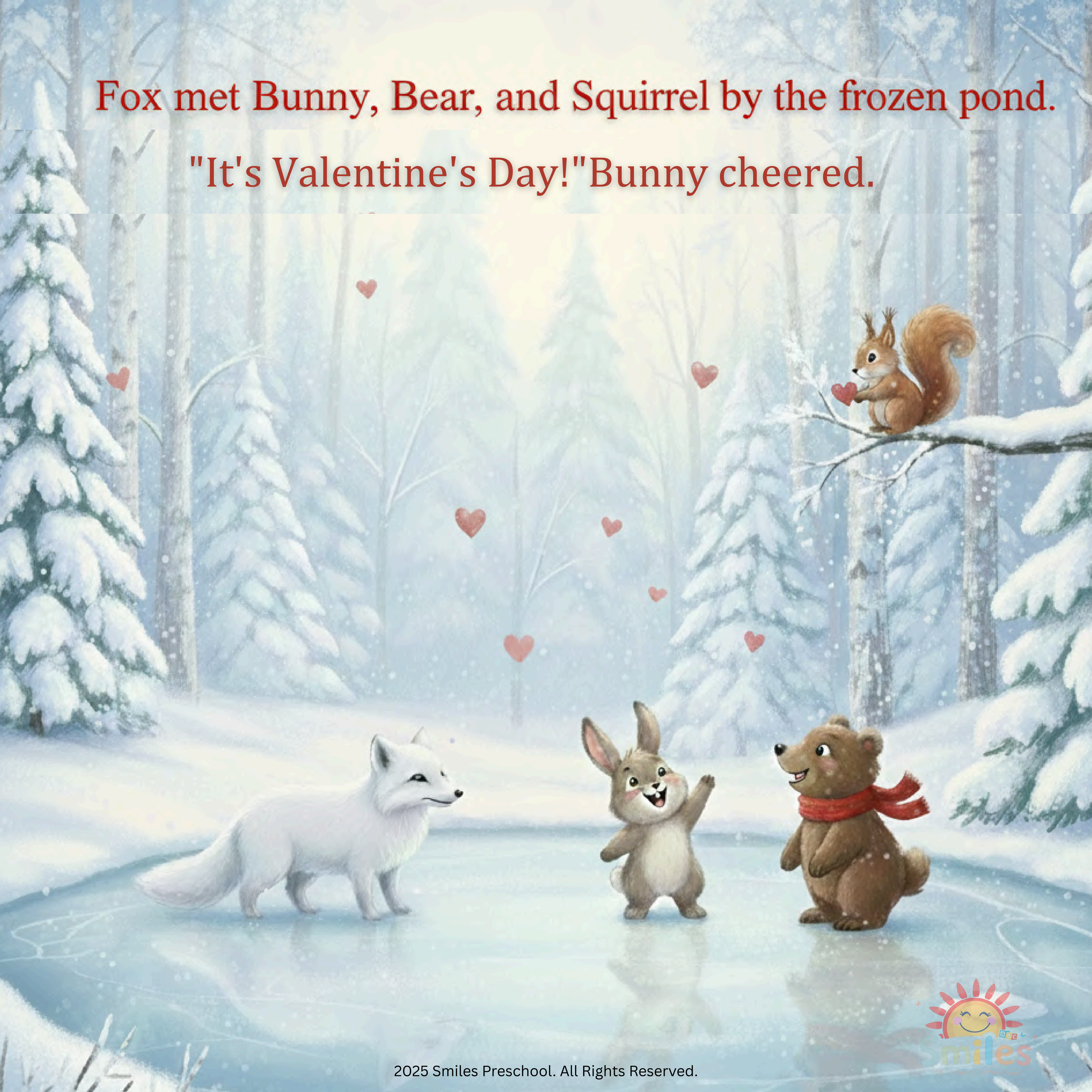

'Let's make something together', said Bear.



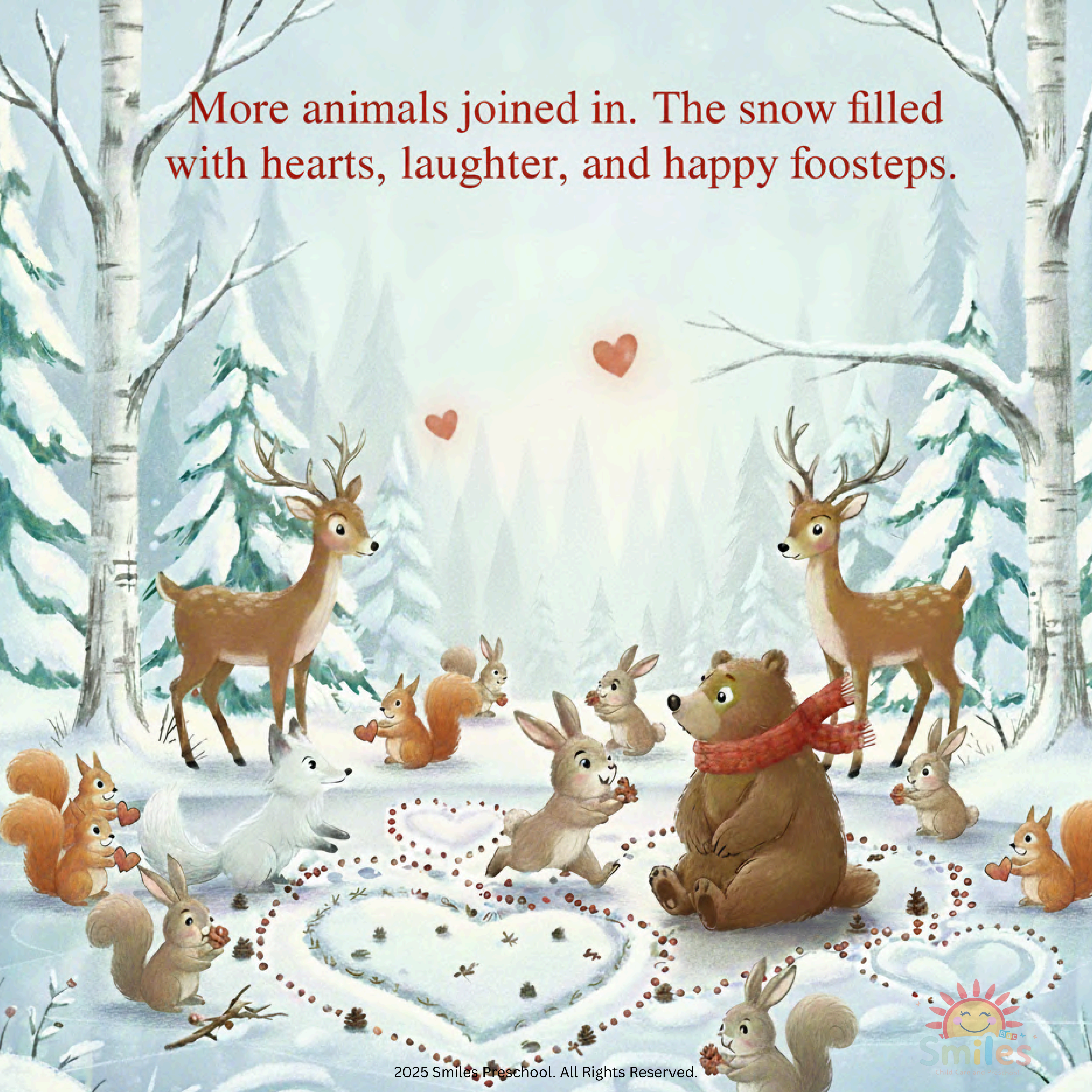
Fox had an idea. They used their paws to
