“Maybe a nap would help!”*



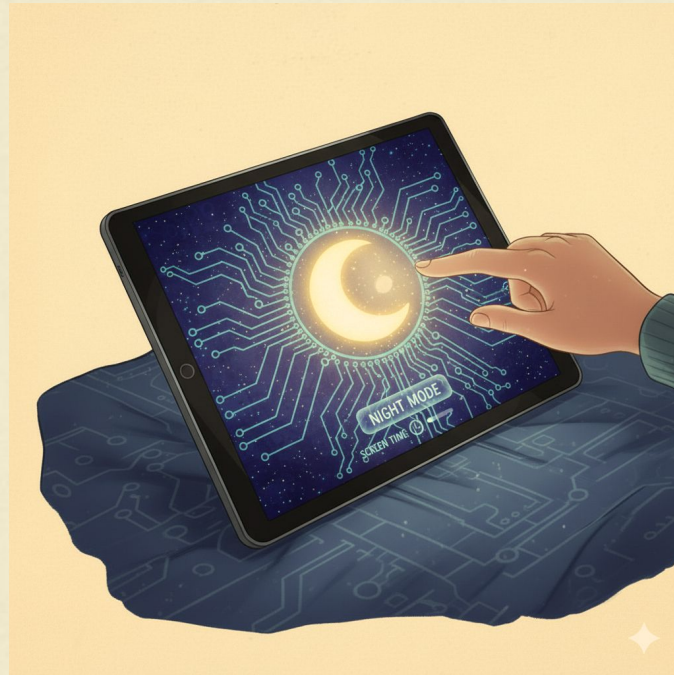
*But the tablet buzzed again—ding!

seemed to sleep.*



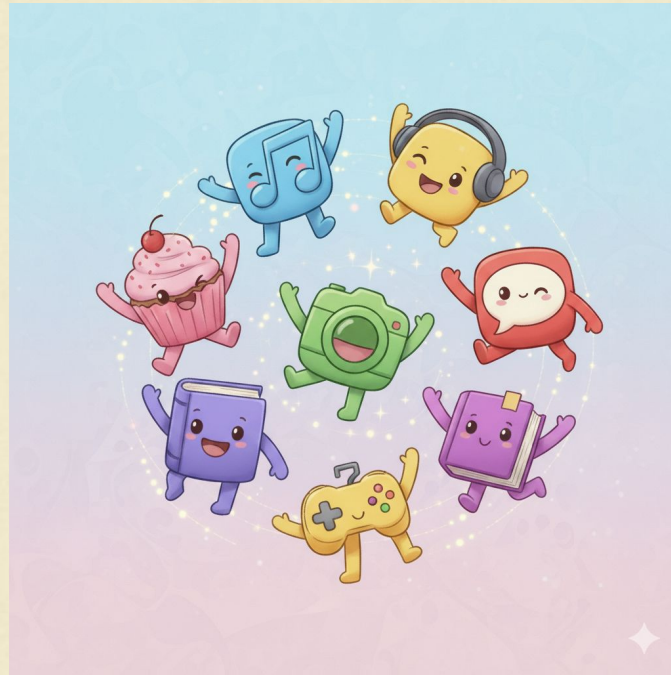
*The fairies sighed with relief.  
“Finally! She’s unplugged!”*



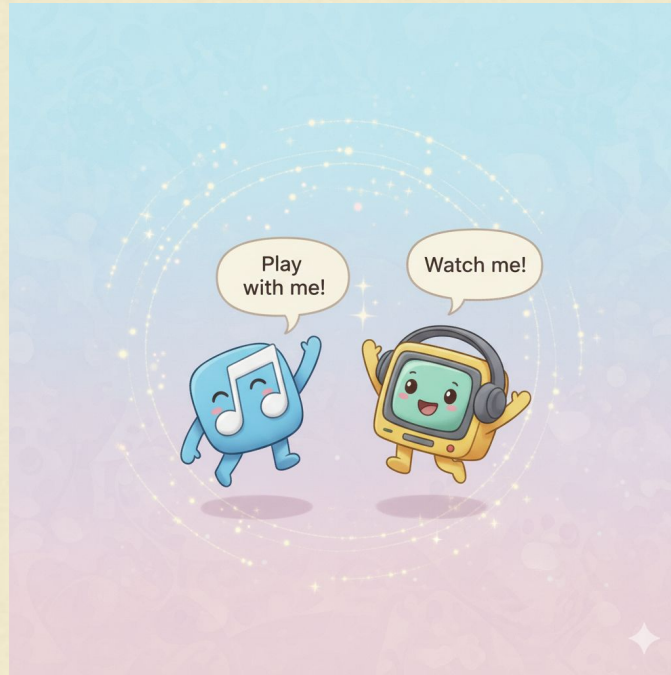
*Years passed—or maybe just a few
