"They're spicy and crunchy!" he smiled.

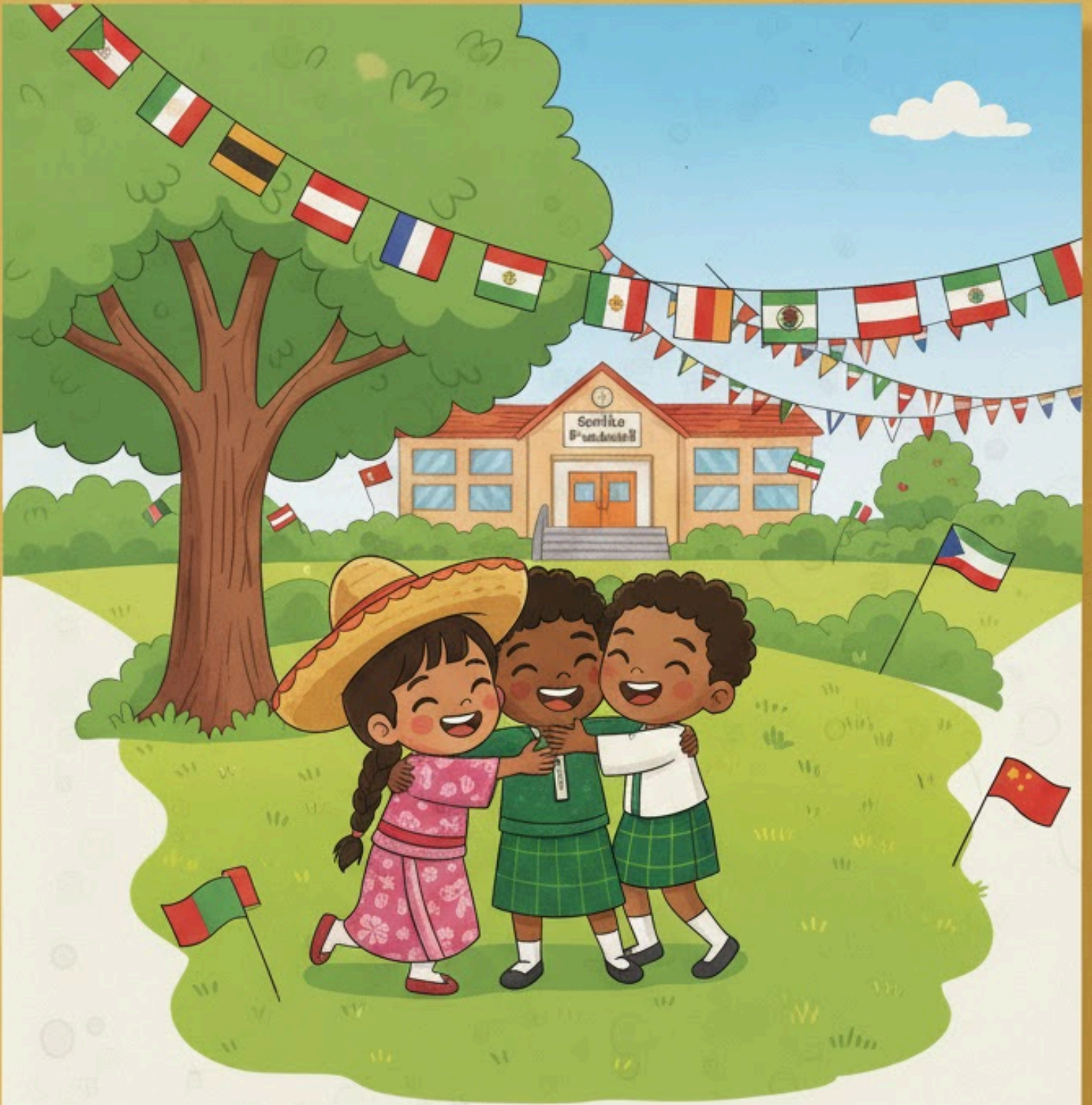




Zara brought jollof rice from Nigeria.
