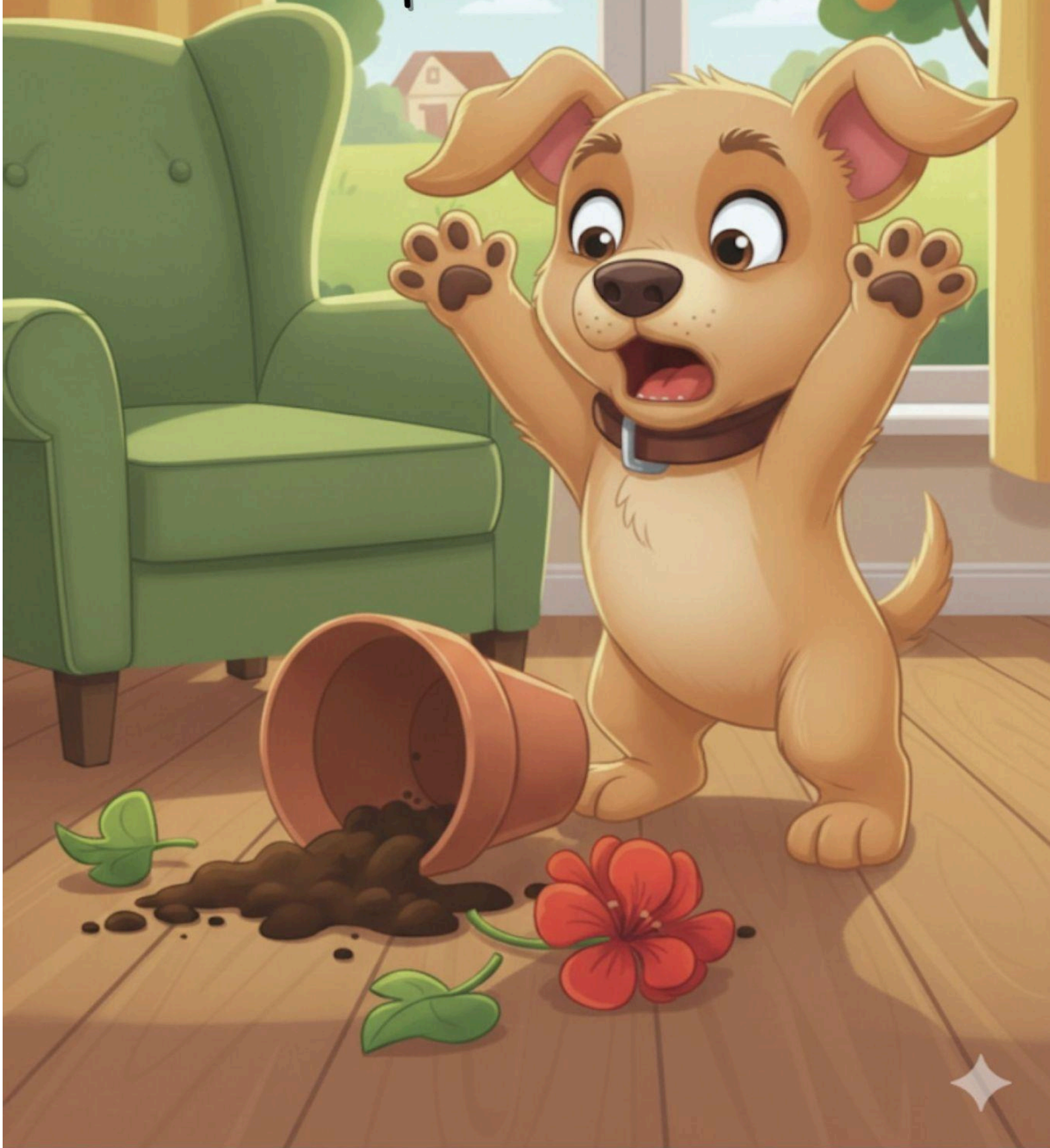

spilled dirt.



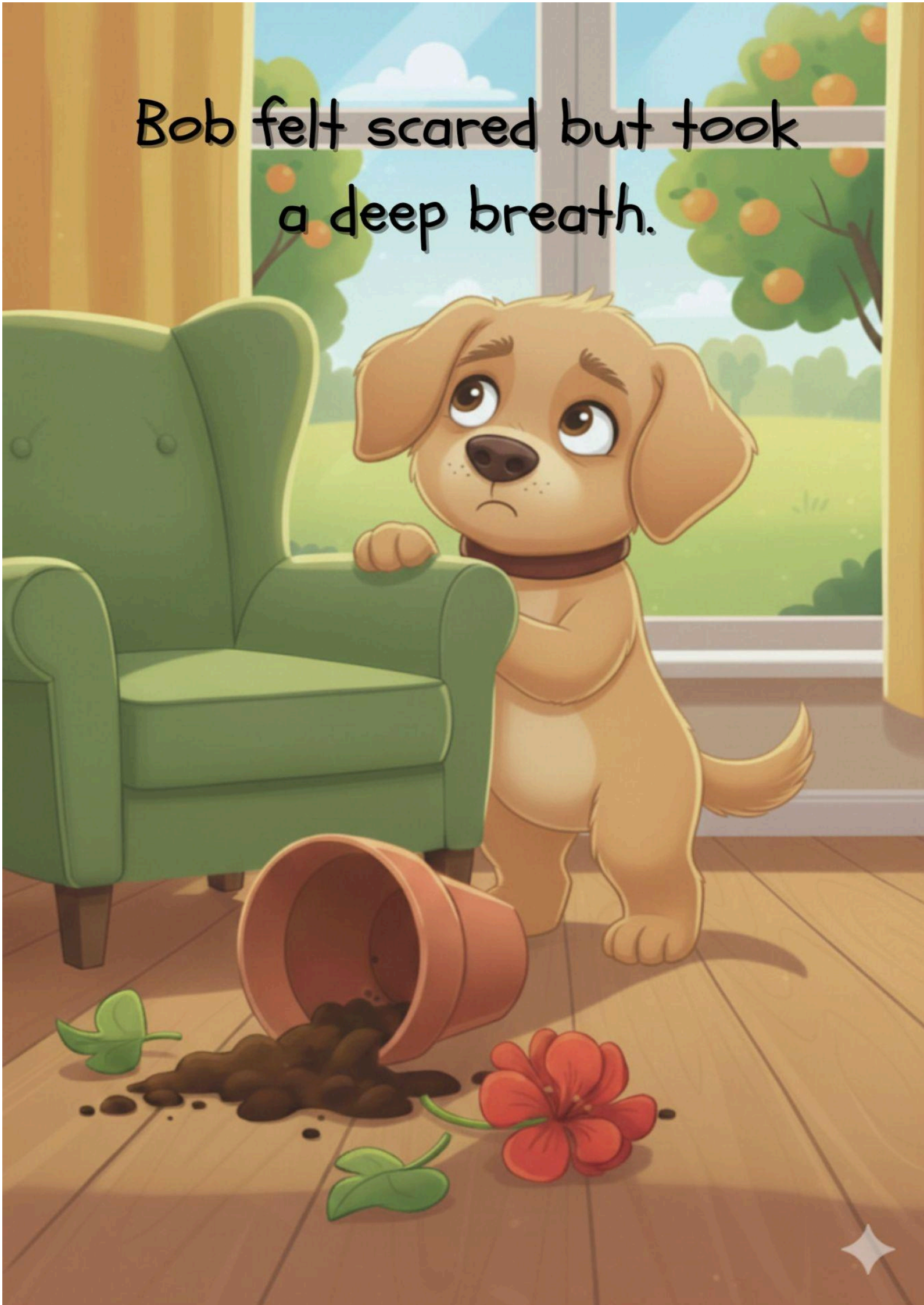
He quickly ran and hid
