A lot of questions!






Do stars

in the night sky.”**






Eli smiled. "You look beautiful, Venus! Why do you shine so much?"

of all.”

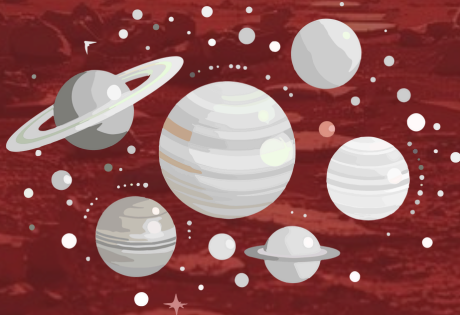




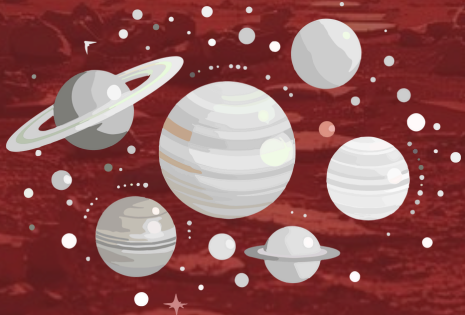
CHAPTER 7:

home’ for humans.”**

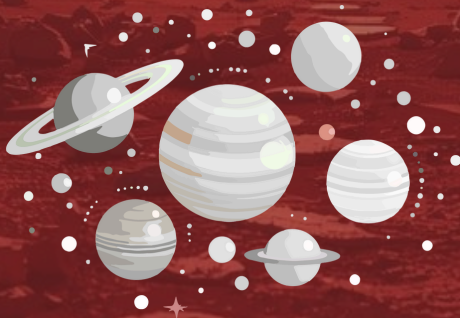


Eli's eyes widened. "Really?

day?"



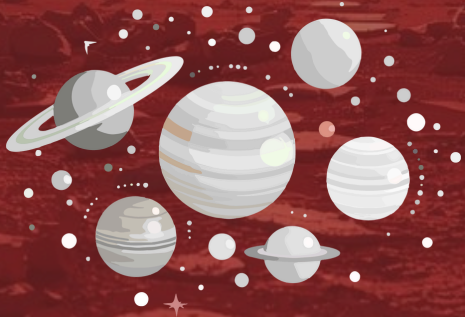
Mars chuckled.

Captain Eli.”

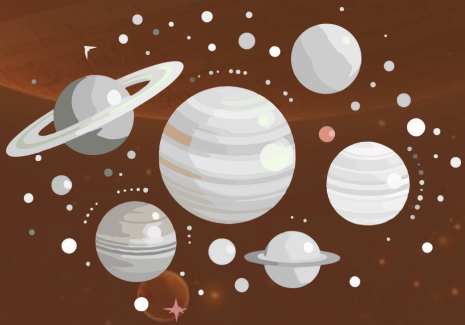




CHAPTER 8: JUPITER THE GIANT KING

big red spot.**

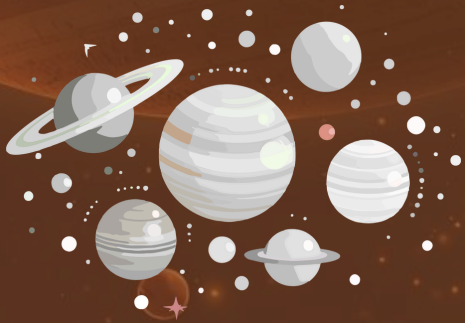


“Whoa! You’re huge!” Eli gasped.

years!”**

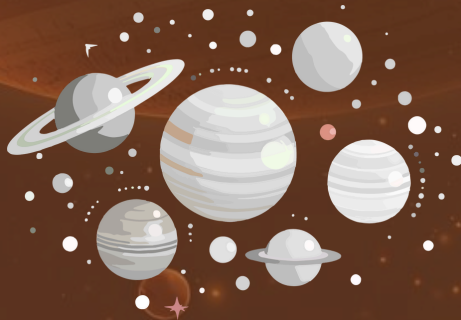





Eli whistled. “A storm that never ends? That’s amazing!”

Jupiter smiled proudly.

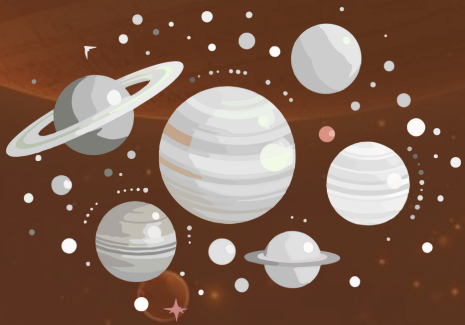
“I have many moons, over 80! They dance around me like a royal parade.”

rings.






**“Hello, Saturn!” Eli called.

CHAPTER 10:




URANUS AND NEPTUNE THE TWIN EXPLORERS

Constellations!**




“This one,” said a star,
