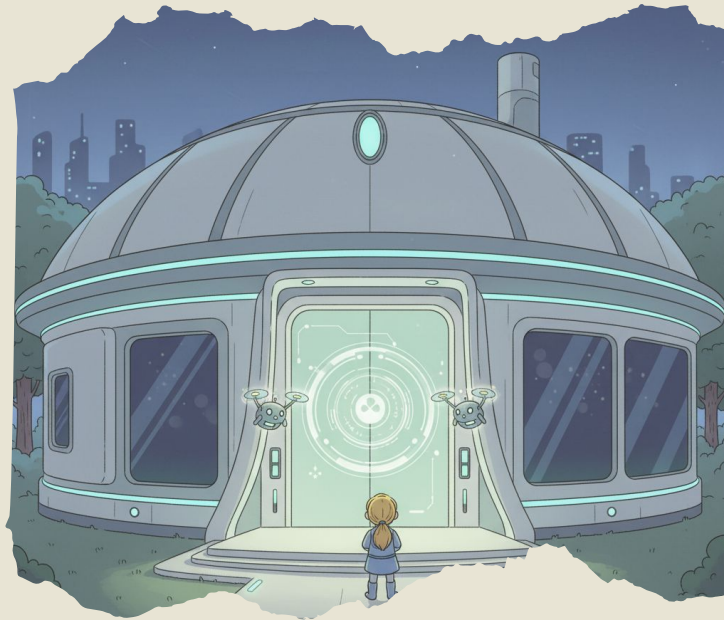

Goldilocks was walking through the forest when she saw a shiny, blinking house.

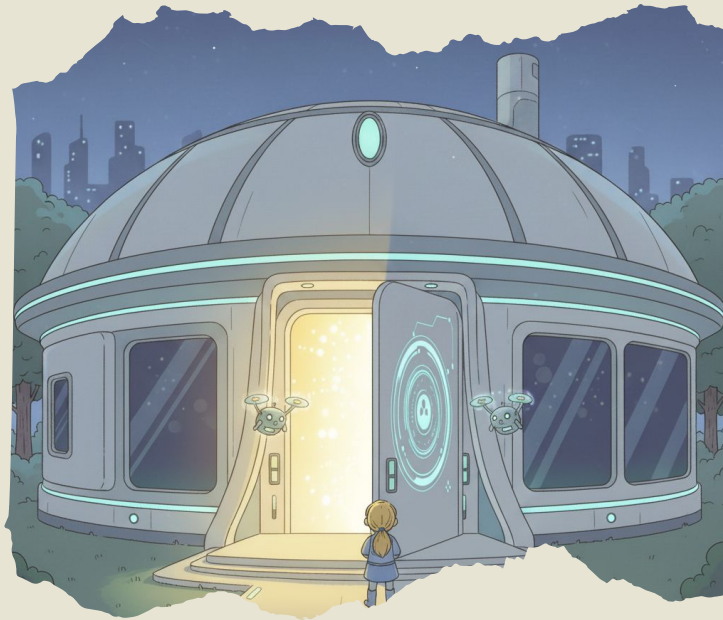
It said, "Welcome! Please scan your face!"

"Hello, guest detected!" said the Smart House.

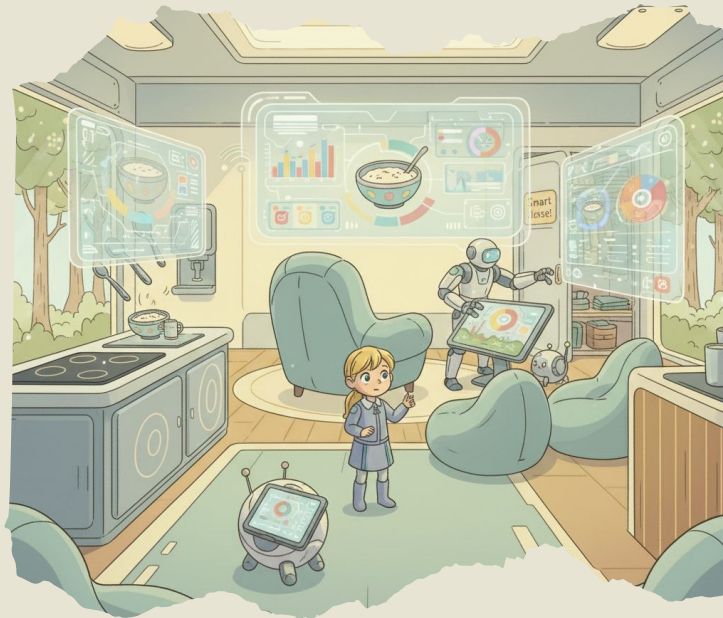


**PAGE 3**

“Wow, it even knows my name!” she laughed.



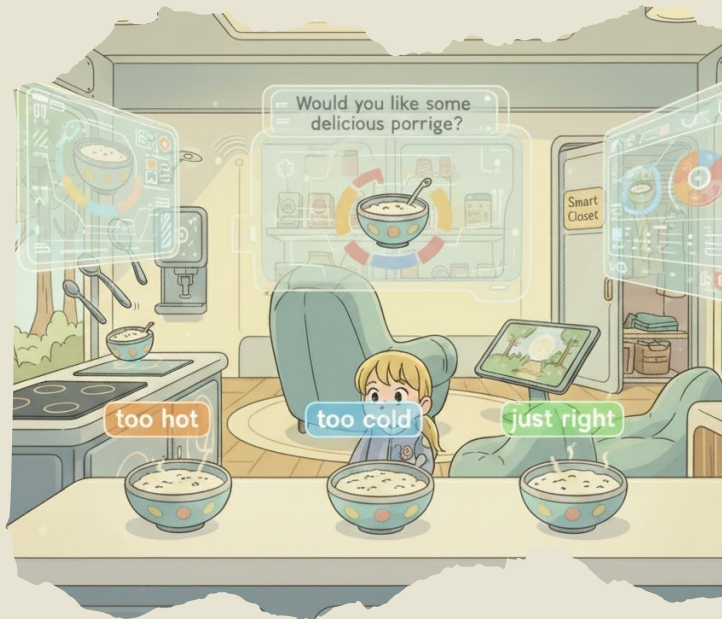
Goldilocks wandered into the kitchen.

She took a bite. “Mmm, this one is too hot!” said Goldilocks.

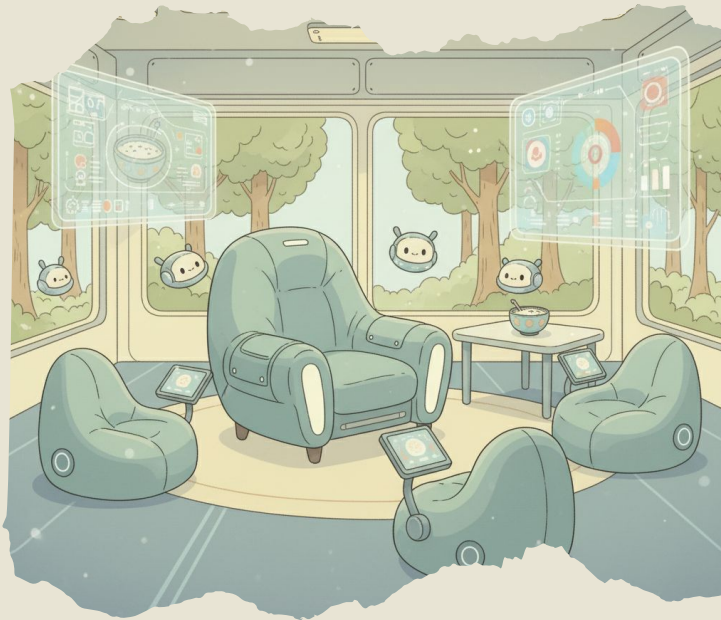
She tried another bowl. “This one is too cold!”

After eating, she saw three digital chairs.

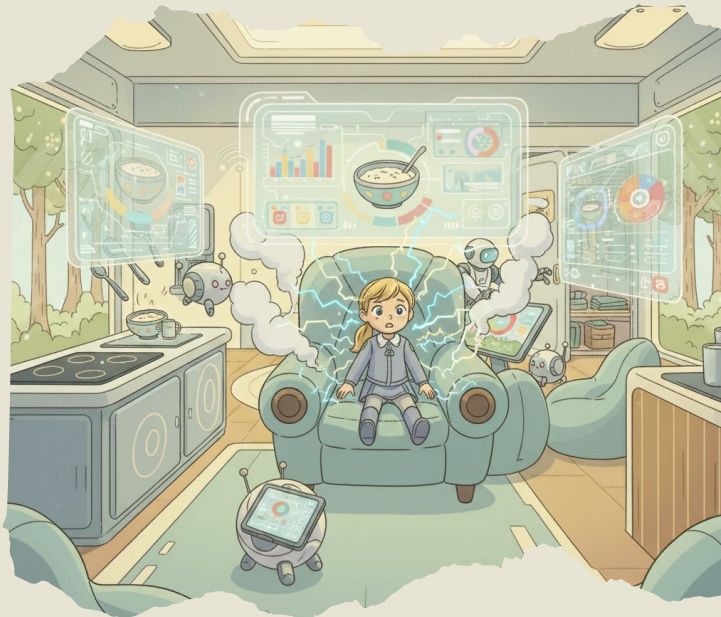
One had flashing lights, one shook like a robot,

The third was perfect... until it broke!

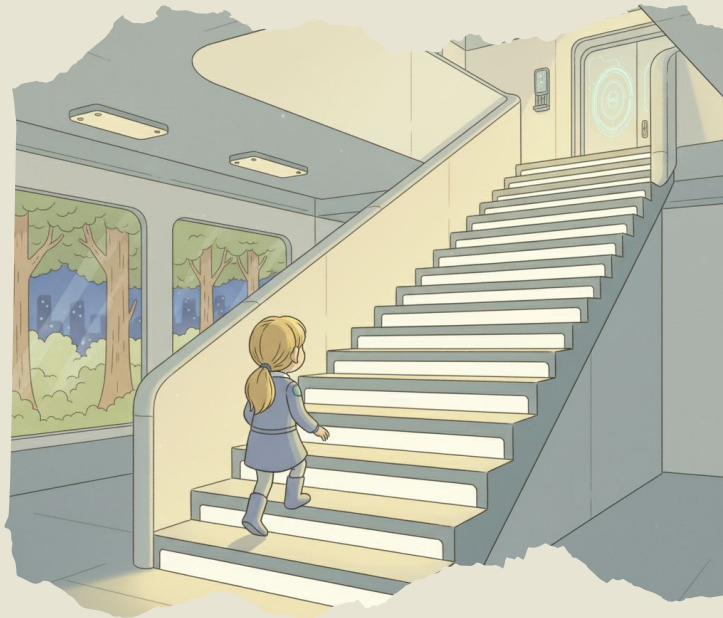

One was huge and loud, one was tiny and bouncy, and one looked soft and peaceful.



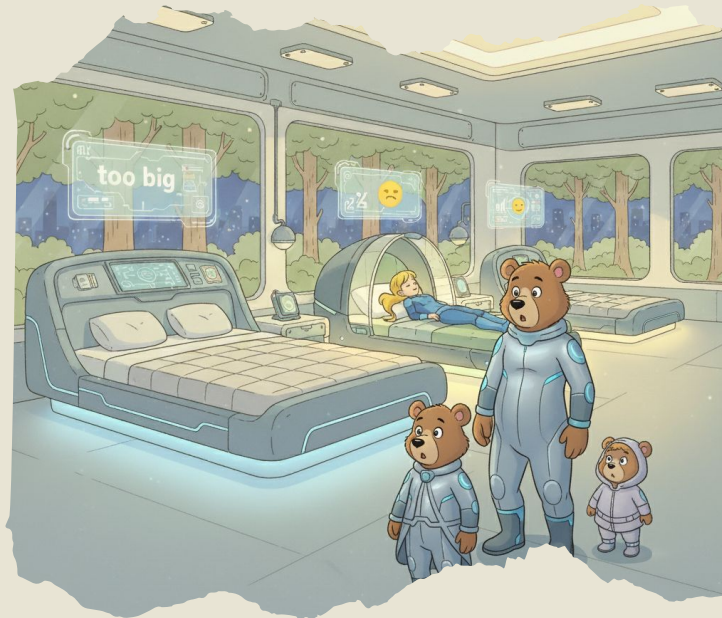
She tried the big bed. "Too noisy!"

“Someone sat in my chair!” said Mama Bear.

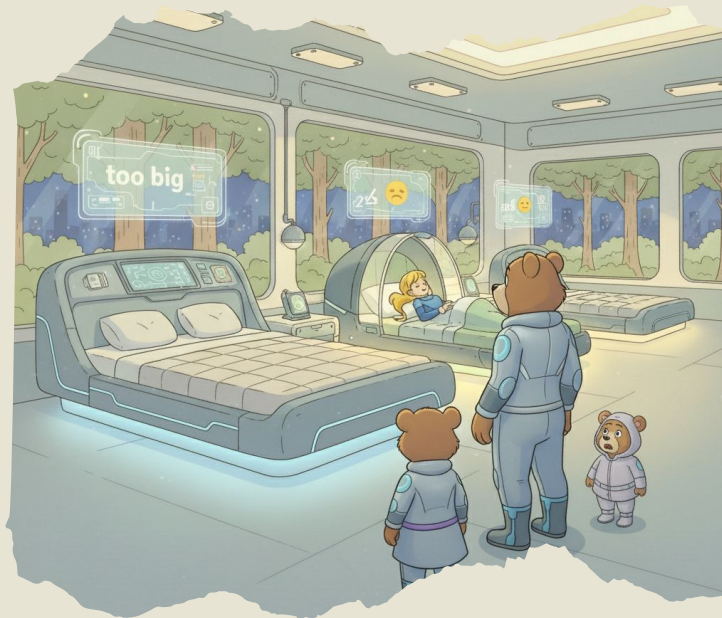
“Someone broke mine!” cried Baby Bear.



They walked upstairs.

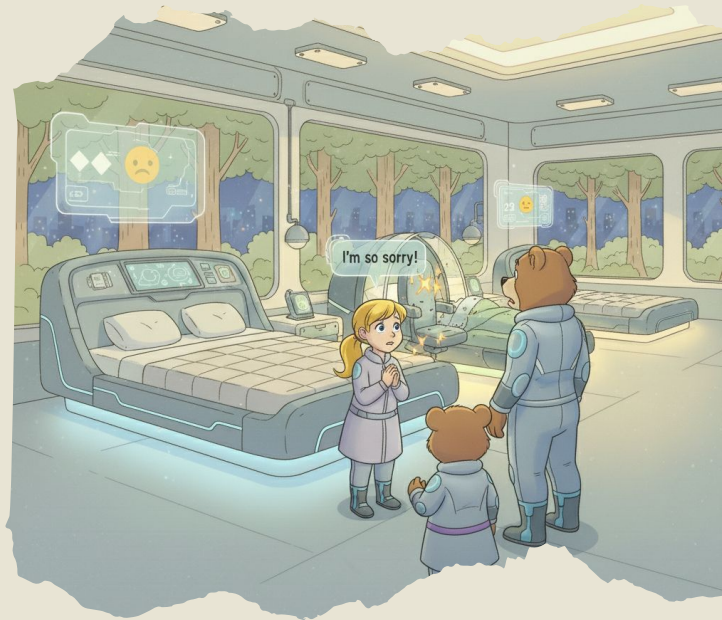
“Someone’s in my bed!” said Baby Bear.

“Oh! I didn’t mean to break anything!” said Goldilocks.

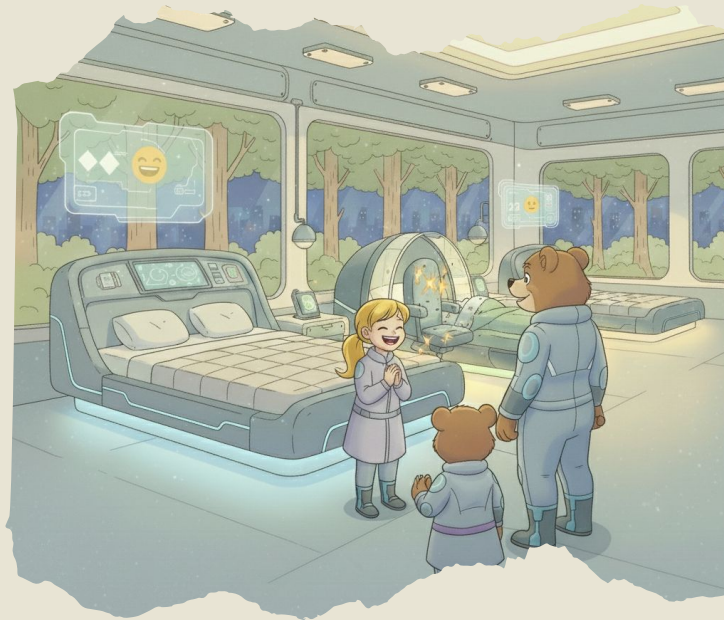
“I just wanted to see how it worked!”



Mama Bear smiled.

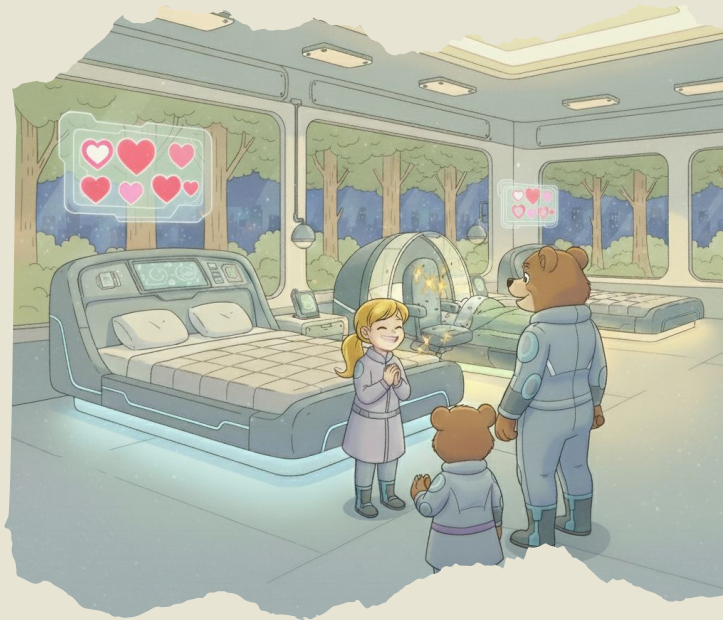
“Next time, just ask before entering, okay?”

The Smart House said, "Would you like to play music?"

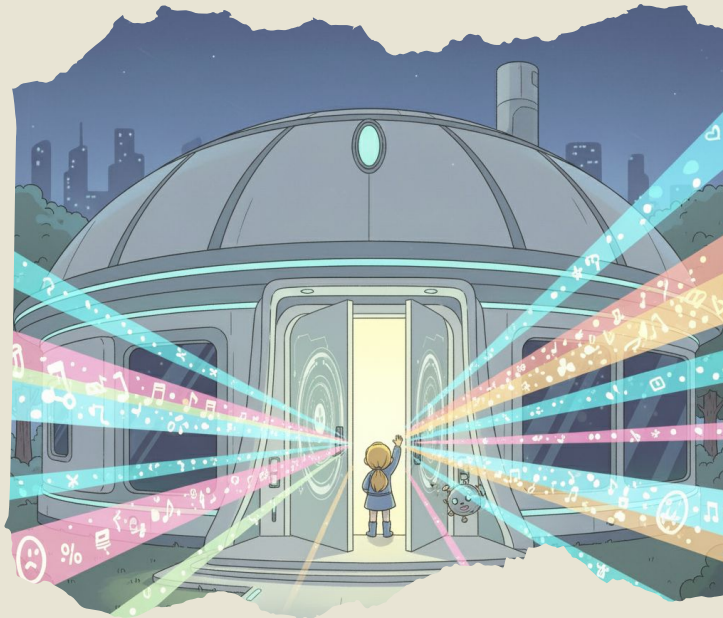
Soft songs began to play all around the room.



Goldilocks and the Bears danced around the living room, laughing as lights changed colors.

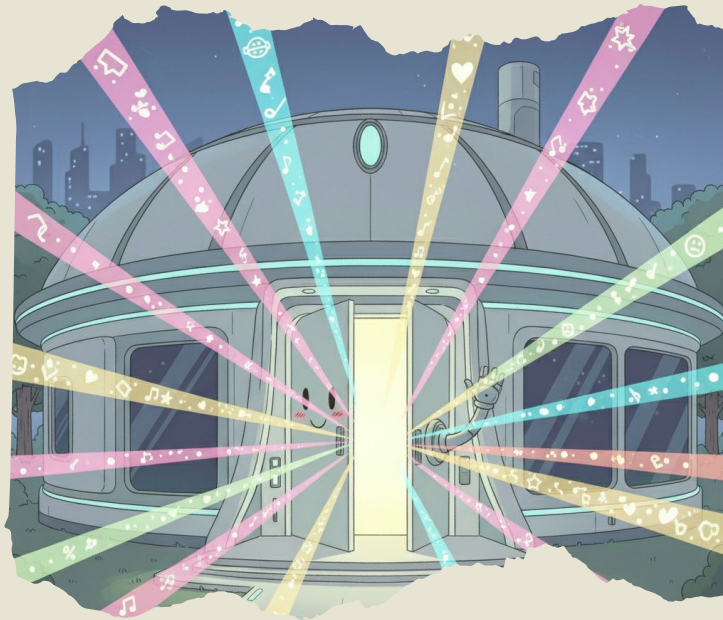


When it was time to go, the Smart House opened the door and said, "Goodbye, friend!"



Goldilocks waved back.

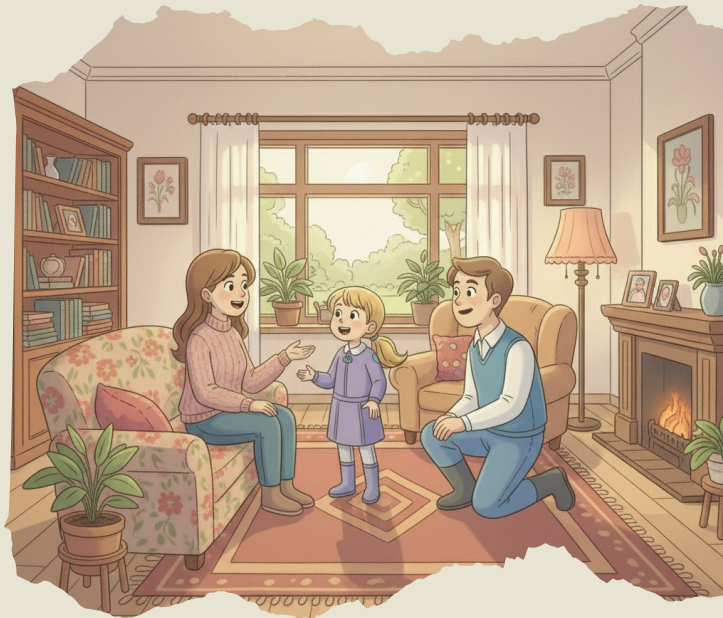
“Thanks for the adventure!” she said happily.

thinking about everything she learned.

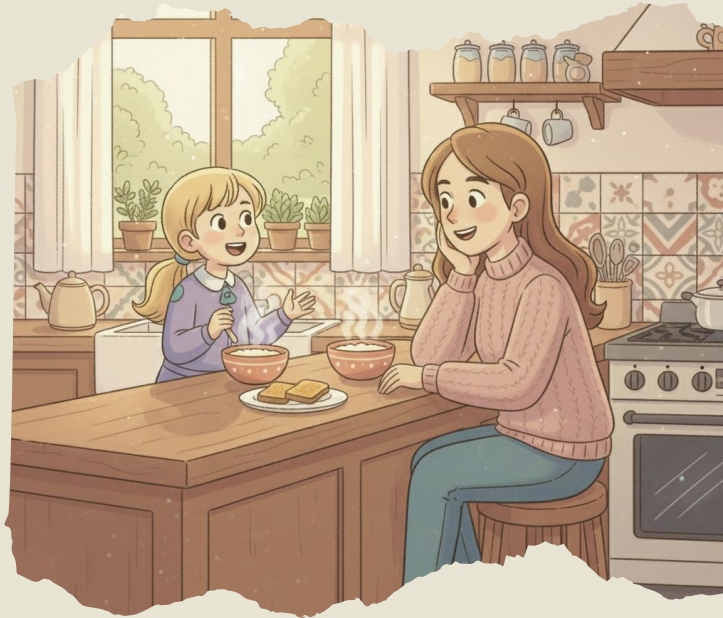


At home, she told her parents all about the Smart Bears and their high-tech home.

“That sounds amazing, dear! What did you learn today?”



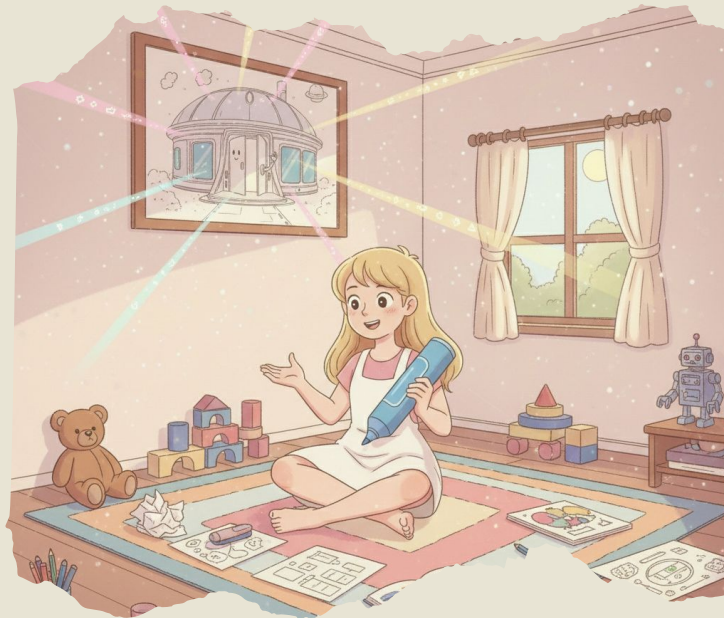
Goldilocks replied, “I learned to always ask before I enter someone’s space—and to be kind!”



That night, Goldilocks dreamed of friendly robots, glowing trees, and Smart Bears laughing.

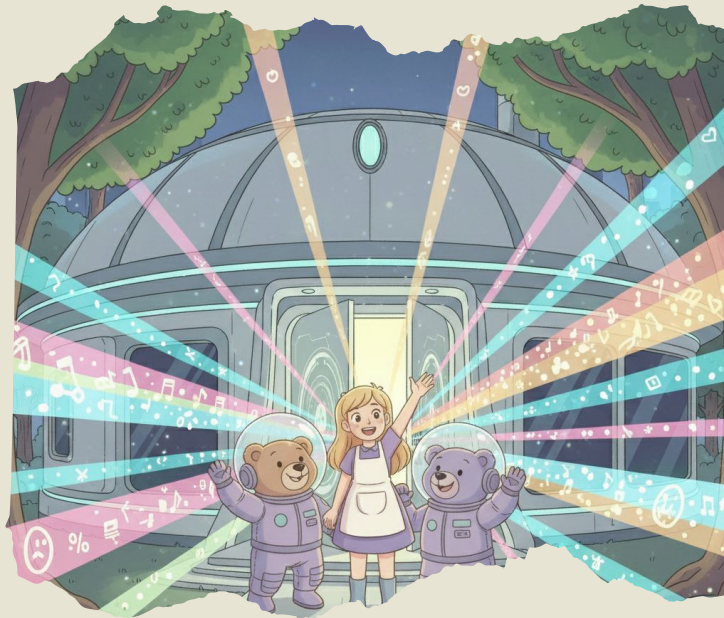


The next morning, she woke up smiling and said,
