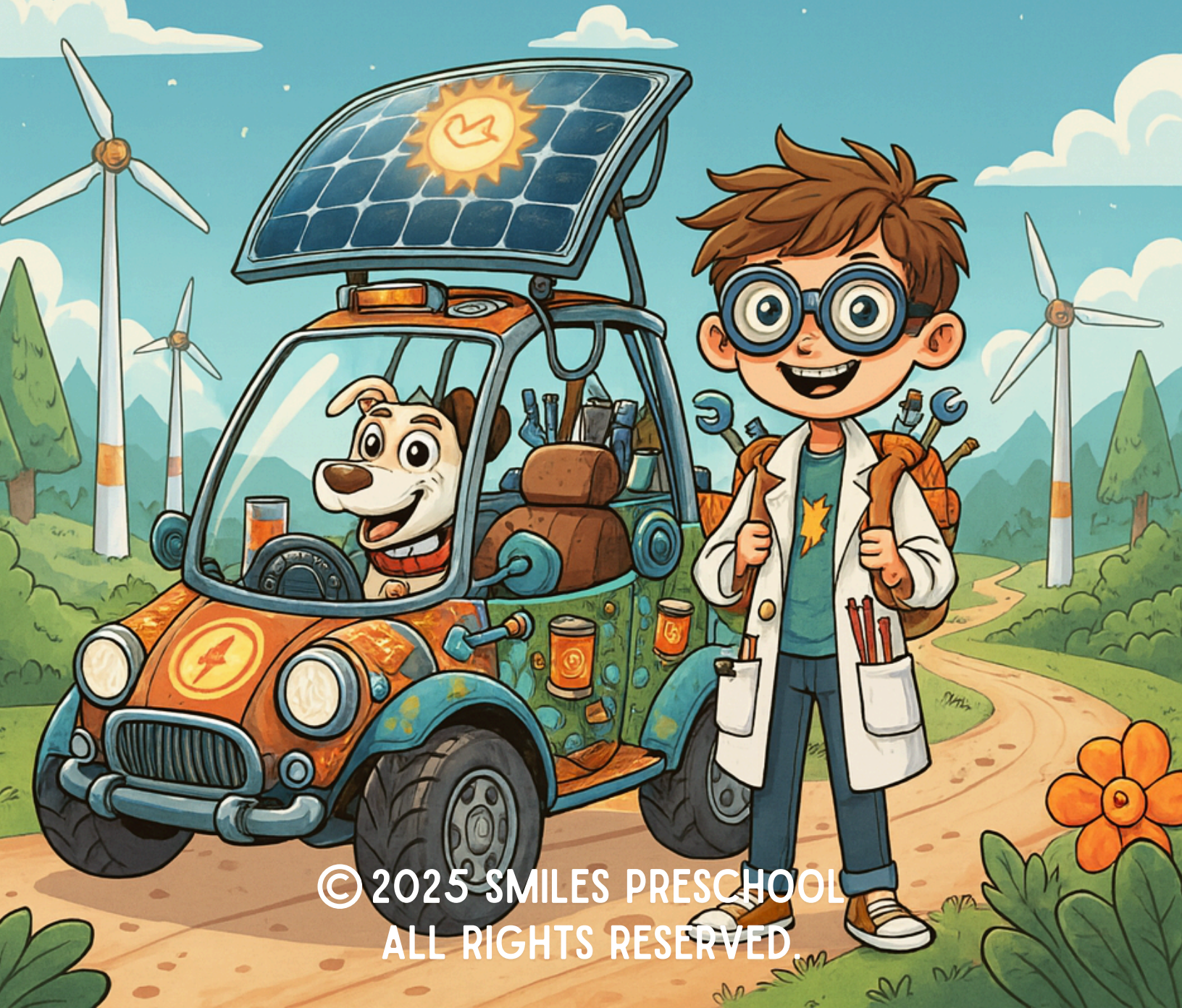




# LITTLE INVENTOR'S SOLAR CAR
