lunchtime adventures!"

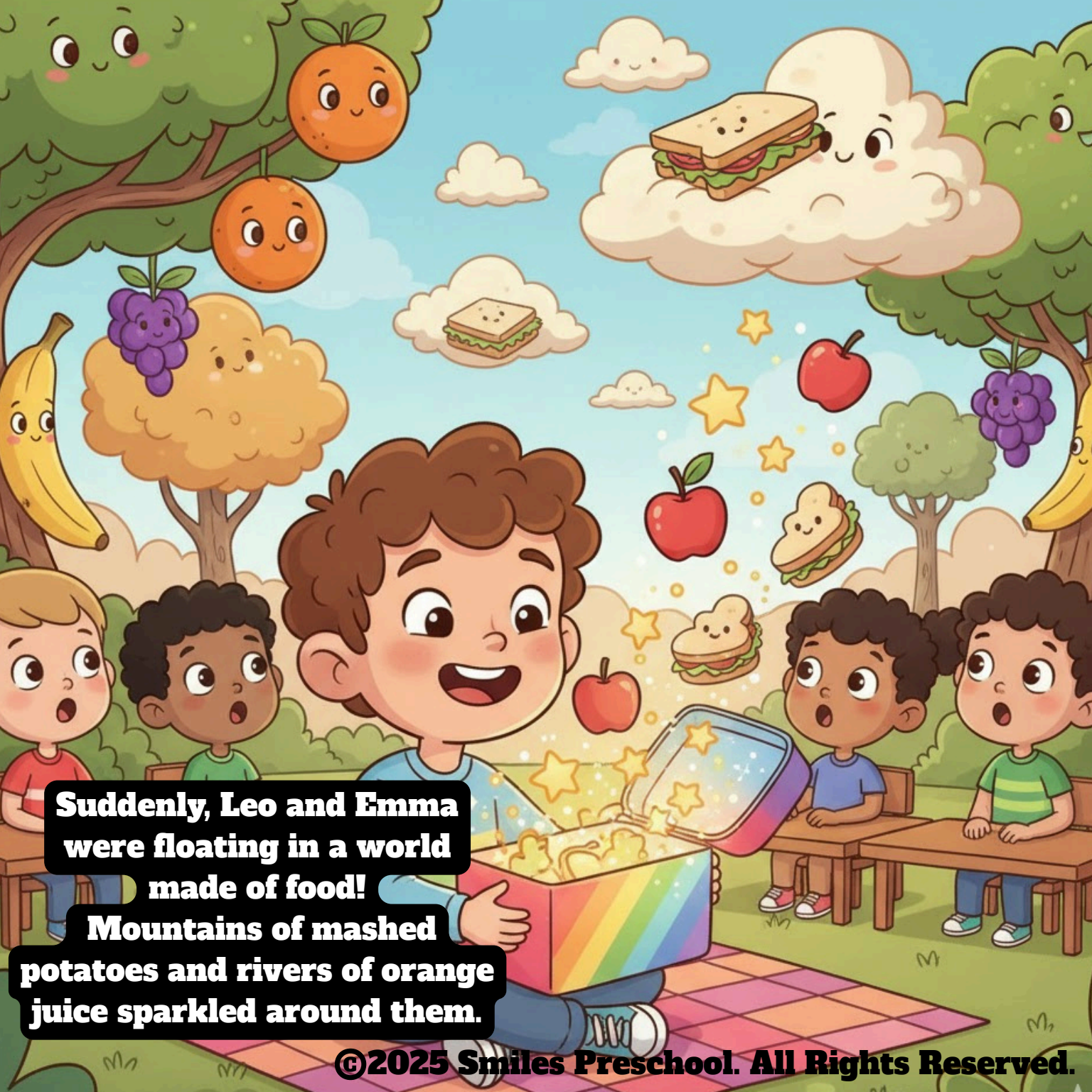


**Leo's friend Emma leaned closer. "Did your

Leo grabbed a banana boat and held tight!**






**When the storm stopped, everything
